Music Rehearsals TODAY:

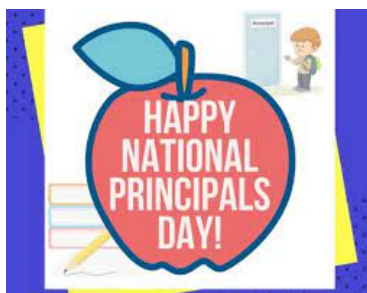
The **Science Club** will meet **TODAY!** Please sign up on the door. We will be doing a Chemistry Lab with chemicals & safety goggles!
