






### PUSD LCAP

# Review of 2021-2024 LCAP Targets (ELA)




The District Literacy Proficiency Rate will increase by 2% points each year from a baseline of approximately 46% (45.58%) in 2018-19\* to 52% or higher by 2023-

### Review of 2021-2024 LCAP Targets (Math)




The District Math Proficiency Rate will increase by 2% points each year from a baseline of approximately 33% (32.87%) in 2021-22\* to 37% or higher by 2023-24.

#### 4-Year Graduation Rate:

Overall district results will increase by 2% points each year from a baseline of 82.2% (2019-2020) to reach 88% or higher by 2023-2024.
