ADA vs Funded ADA

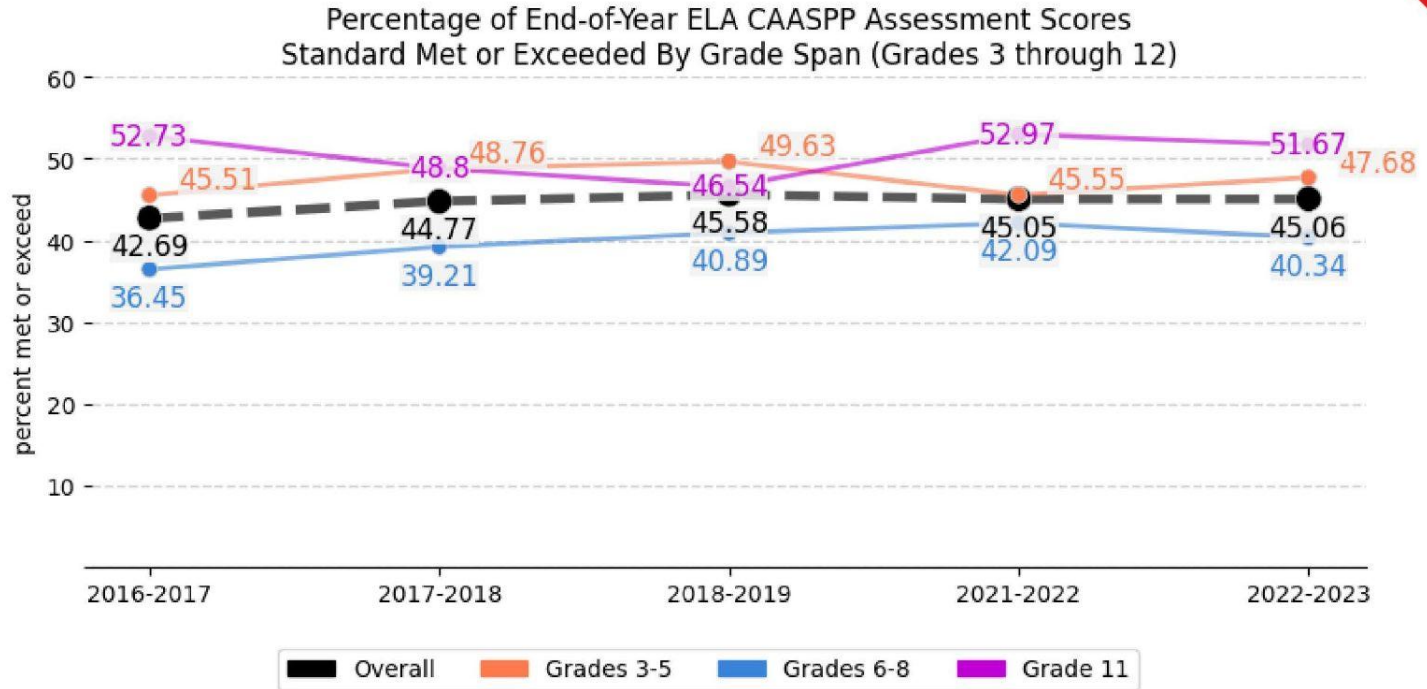

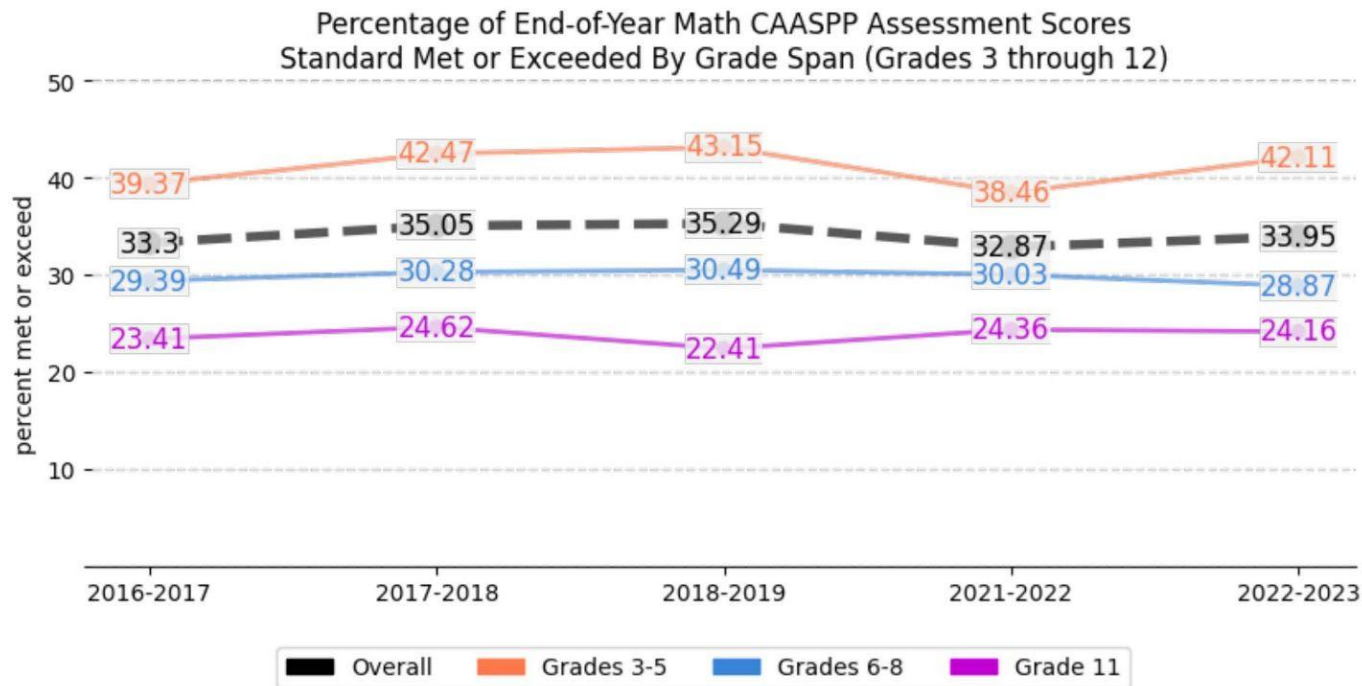
Review of 2021-2024 LCAP Targets (ELA)



The District Literacy Proficiency Rate will increase by 2% points each year from a baseline of approximately 46% (45.58%) in 2018-19* to 52% or higher by 2023-24

Review of 2021-2024 LCAP Targets (Math)

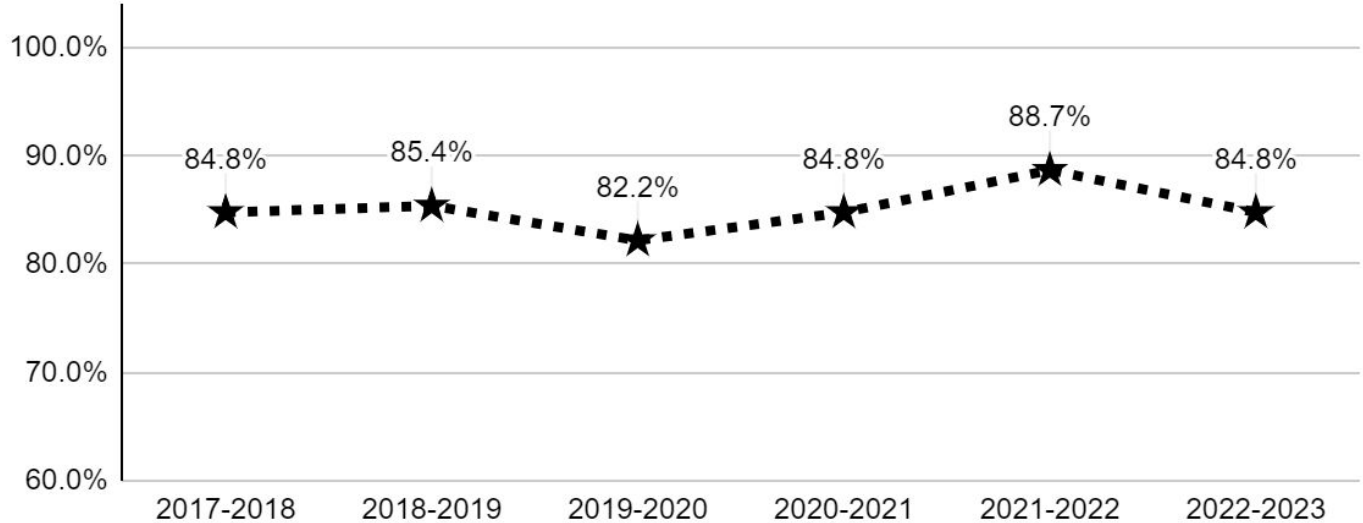

4-Year Graduation Rate:

Overall district results will increase by 2% points each year from a baseline of 82.2% (2019-2020) to reach 88% or higher by 2023-2024.

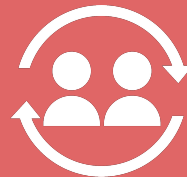

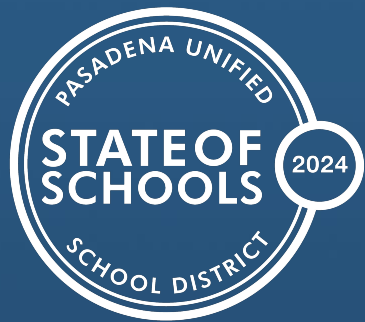
