

MPCS UNIFORMS

Mount Paran Christian School instills an organized classroom environment with the use of school uniforms. Our K-12 students are presentable, unified, and ready to learn without distractions every day. There is a direct relationship between dress, grooming, conduct, and success at school. All MPCS students are expected to dress in appropriate uniforms and groom themselves with the formality of school in mind.

MPCS DEPENDS ON PARENTS to work with the school in maintaining appearance standards by checking your child before he/she leaves for school to make sure he/she is dressed and groomed properly. It is understood that enrollment at MPCS means a pledge on the part of both parents and students to abide by this dress code. Please have your child(ren) read, understand, and agree to follow these dress code policies.

APPEARANCE STANDARDS

- Shirts, including spirit wear, must remain tucked in during school hours
- All clothing needs to fit appropriately, not too tight or too loose, no holes or fraying
- School-appropriate undergarments are required for all female and male students and staff
- Long-sleeve shirts or tights that are visible underneath must be solid colors of white, navy, or black without print
- Khaki bottoms are to be in the traditional khaki color
- Dresses and skorts should be below or at fingertip length with respect to decency, visible under outerwear, and is subject to administrative approval
- No extreme hairstyles or hair dyes of unnatural hair colors are allowed
- Boys' hair must be above the eyebrows, above the ears, and off the shirt collar without any form of "man bun" and they must be clean shaven
- Hoodies, MPCS spirit sweatshirts (large logo), and off-color jackets or pullovers are reserved for Fridays only.
- Preschool does not require uniforms

**The administration reserves the right to determine appropriate dress code and require students to change clothes if attire is deemed inappropriate. If you are unsure if an apparel item meets the criteria, please inquire.*

DRESS-DOWN DAY REQUIREMENTS

- On special dress-down days, attire must be modest and school-appropriate*
- Clothes cannot be worn too baggy, too loose, or too tight
- Tops must have sleeves and fully cover midriff (no crop-tops)
- Jeans and pants should be worn at the waist and fit appropriately
- Jeans with no rips/holes
- No cut-offs
- No political or social movement statements or logos
- No inappropriate logos or advertisements
- No PJs
- BOYS: Athletic shorts must have at least a 7-inch inseam
- GIRLS: No shorts or skirts, and leggings must be paired with a shirt that covers bottom
- If not adhering to these guidelines, student must be dressed in normal school uniform
