

## MVA & MPS:1 Device Return Information for Grades K-11

This document includes important end of year dates and FAQ's for both our MPS:1 as well as our Moore Virtual Academy (MVA) students. MPS:1 is the district's one-to-one device initiative that to date has provided one-to-one take home devices for grades 5th-12th.

**Please note: Senior information is NOT included in this document. A separate email has been sent addressing Senior Device Return.**

### GENERAL DEVICE REPAIR FAQ

#### What if the device is damaged?

Parents will be invoiced for missing or damaged devices. We would highly encourage you to purchase the [Device Protection Plan \(DPP\)](#) to help offset any damage to the device. **DEADLINE TO PURCHASE FOR 23-24 SCHOOL YEAR IS 6/30/24. PLEASE NOTE, FROM 6/15/24-6/30/24, THE DPP PLAN MUST BE PURCHASED IN PERSON (CASH ONLY) AT THE MPS TECHNOLOGY CENTER.** Please visit [Device Protection Plan \(DPP\)](#) for more information on what is/is not covered and how to purchase the plan for the 2023-2024 school year.

#### When is the deadline for repairing devices under the 23-24 DPP?

The deadline to have a ticket turned in for possible device repair under the 23-24 DPP is 6-30-24.

#### What if I need to purchase a replacement charger?

Chargers are NOT covered under the Device Protection Plan. See below for how to purchase a replacement charger.

### GRADES K-4 MVA ONLY FAQ

#### My student is using a district owned device for MVA. When/Where do we turn in the device?

You will turn in the device at the MPS Technology Center. **The deadline for device return is Friday, May 24<sup>th</sup>.** Please don't forget the charger! You are welcome to return the device before the deadline. See the close of this document for location and office hours.

#### Can my student keep the device over the summer?

All students in grades K-4 **MUST turn in** all equipment (device, charger, hotspot etc...) to the MPS Technology Center by Friday, May 24<sup>th</sup>.

## GRADES 5-8 MPS:1 & MVA FAQ

**Do students in grades 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> keep their device over the summer?**

5<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> grade students will KEEP their device over the summer and continue to use through their 8<sup>th</sup> grade year.

8<sup>th</sup> grade students will keep their device over the summer and exchange it for a new Windows device during 2024-2025 High School device deployment.

**If your student withdraws from MPS during the summer, the device will need to be turned in to the MPS Technology Center.**

**Is my student eligible for the Path to Ownership (PTO)?**

The Path to Ownership (PTO) allows 5<sup>th</sup> grade students (as of school year 2021-2022 and onward) who participate in the [Device Protection Plan \(DPP\)](#) through their 8<sup>th</sup> grade year to take ownership of the device upon completing 8<sup>th</sup> grade. You must renew the DPP each year (total of 4 years) to complete the path and take ownership of the device. If you skip a year or move out of district, the Path to Ownership (PTO) is terminated.

## GRADES 9-11 MPS:1 & MVA FAQ

**Do students in grades 9<sup>th</sup> through 11<sup>th</sup> keep their device over the summer?**

9<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> grade students will KEEP their device over the summer and continue to use through their 12<sup>th</sup> grade year.

**If your student withdraws from MPS during the summer, the device will need to be turned in to the MPS Technology Center. Please don't forget the charger!**

**Is my student eligible for the Path to Ownership (PTO)?**

The Path to Ownership (PTO) allows 9<sup>th</sup> grade students (as of school year 2020-2021 and onward) who participate in the Device Protection Plan (DPP) through their 12<sup>th</sup> grade year to take ownership of the device upon completing 12<sup>th</sup> grade. You must renew the DPP each year (total of 4 years) to complete the path and take ownership of the device. If you skip a year or move out of district, the Path to Ownership (PTO) is terminated.
