- I. Meeting Called to Order at 3:49 p.m.
- II. Change / Additions to Agenda - None
- III. Approve Last Month's [Minutes](#) - After review, a motion to approve last month's minutes was made by Allison Timaji and seconded by Casey Voissard. None opposed.
- IV. Audience of Citizens - N/A
- V. Review Budget and Finances - Kristy Ludeker reviewed the current budget. After discussion, a motion to approve the budget was made by Allison Timaji and seconded by David Payne . None opposed.
- VI. Review SIP and Gap Progress - James shared the data from the final round of MVPA. CMS finished 1st in the district in every grade level and subject.

- VII. Old Business -
 - A. None
- VIII. New Business
 - A. Allocation update - James shared that our request for an additional allocation from the district to make our schedule workable with all classes under state cap size was denied. Furthermore, he shared that he then requested an additional .5

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allocation increase, but he does not anticipate the request being approved either. James informed the council that he will move forward planning for next year with the allocations we have been provided.

- B. UA Schedule Change for 24-25 - James shared the recommendation of changing the current red/black schedule where students have UA courses for 90 minutes every other day to a daily schedule having two 45 minutes UA classes daily. After discussion, a motion to approve the schedule change was made by Allison Timaji and seconded by Natalie Miller. Note: The next step will be sending the proposed schedule change to staff for a vote. If approved by a majority of staff, the council will make final approval at the May meeting.
 - C. Schedule [Options](#) - James presented two schedule options to the council based on the 42 allocations. After discussion, James recommended option one using 10 allocations in 6th, 9 in 7th, 12 in 8th, and 11 in UA. A motion to approve schedule option 1 was made by Natalie Miller and seconded by David Payne.
 - D. UA course offering - James shared that we are looking at some changes in our UA course offerings. Students were provided a survey to get feedback on current offerings and about potential offerings. Based on the feedback, we will be revamping offerings for the 24-25 school years. Courses offered will be determined at the May meeting.
