Mandatory Female Dress Code:

1. Dresses should comply with school dress code requirements.
2. The shoes should be of medium heel and no athletic shoes or flip flops permitted.
3. Do not wear flowers or ornaments of any kind
4. Do not carry a purse.
5. No bandanas, headwear, or sunglasses are permitted.

Mandatory Male Dress Code:

1. A light dress shirt is required. (A tie is optional.)
2. Dark trousers are required. No shorts
3. Dress shoes are required. No athletic shoes, sandals, or flip-flops
4. No bandanas, headwear, or sunglasses

All female graduates are required to report to Mrs. Reyes' room (207) by 5:45

All seniors will report to line up in the proper hall at 6:50 pm

Commencement will begin promptly at 7:00 pm
