

## THIRD FIVE-YEAR REVIEW

Burlingame High School

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) will conduct the Third Five-Year Review of the effectiveness of the remedy for the Burlingame High School site (Site) located at 400 Carolan Avenue, Burlingame, California 94010. The remedy includes covering limited portions of the Site with hardscape, clean soil or landscaping, creating a cap barrier to prevent exposure to arsenic in on-site soils.

The purpose of the Five-Year Review is to make sure that the remedy remains effective, continues to function as designed and is maintained appropriately to protect human health and the environment.

The hardscape caps consist of concrete and/or synthetic turf material. Other caps consist of decomposed granite, and/or crushed rock. Landscaping consists of plants and wood chips covering bare soil. The San Mateo Union High School District completed these mitigation measures in January 2009.

On April 27, 2023, the San Mateo Union High School District conducted a Site inspection. The purpose of the inspection is to identify: any changes in Site condition or usage; any construction activities that could have affected the caps; any required repairs; and, other significant information relating to the caps. The inspection included measurements and evaluation of cap.

A Five-Year Review Report documenting the inspection results and resolutions will be submitted to DTSC for review and approval within 60 days of the inspection. If needed, the current Operations and Maintenance Plan for the Site will be updated to reflect any changes required since completing the mitigation measures.
