JOB SUMMARY:

Under general supervision of the Deputy Superintendent of Human Resources, and the direction of the Health Services and Employee Wellness Lead, the Site-Based Wellness Facilitator will promote wellness activities and opportunities by assisting in the scheduling of classes and seminars, coordinating wellness competitions, encouraging participation, promoting teamwork, and fostering a health-conscious atmosphere at the designated site.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Facilitate Wellness Program events for your site in conjunction with the HR Department.
- 2. Develop site schedule of wellness activities.
- 3. Organize logistics for site initiatives and events.
- 4. Recruit and interview fitness class instructors and secure facility usage for wellness classes.
- 5. Organize employee on-site biometric screenings and health risk assessments.
- 6. Coordinate Wellness Program information and communication to staff members.
- 7. Encourage employees and students to participate in wellness related activities.
- 8. Cultivate teamwork and camaraderie in fitness and friendly wellness competitions.
- 9. Attend District Wellness Program meetings.
- 10. Assume a leadership role that promotes health and wellness to students and employees.
- 11. Submit at least one article highlighting wellness activity and/or achievement to the Savvy Source.
- 12. Survey site employees regarding the wellness program and submit a proposed plan that encompasses the feedback.
- 13. Summarize your achievements at the end of the year.
- 14. Create wellness events that promote inclusivity for all staff.
