Books Offered for Sale

88 Instruments – A boy can't decide which instrument to play, so he decides to try them all! **The Amazing Age of John Roy Lynch** – A picture book biography of John Roy Lynch, one of the first African Americans elected into the United States Congress.

Attack! Boss! Cheat Code!: A Gamer's Alphabet – An A to Z guide on the language of video gaming.

Book or Bell? – Engrossed in a book, Henry decides to ignore the school bell, which sets off a chain reaction.

The Day-Glo Brothers: The True Story of Bob and Joe Switzer's Bright Ideas and Brand-New Colors – An illustrated history of the discovery of florescent colors.

Dazzle Ships: World War I and the Art of Confusion – During World War I, British and American ships were painted with patterns and colors that "dazzled" or confused the enemy about each ship's speed and direction.

Mighty Truck – A muddy truck named Clarence reluctantly gets a truck wash, and transforms into a superhero.

Mighty Truck on the Farm – When Clarence's parents ask him to visit the family farm, he cannot wait to go romp with the sheep and play with the pigs. But mom and dad have other plans—they need Clarence to help out!

Mighty Truck: The Traffic Tie-Up – Stella is a news chopper who flies high in the sky and loudly reports what she sees. But sometimes her loudness makes Clarence crazy! When Stella learns to use her inside voice though, no one can hear the news!

Mighty Truck: Zip and Beep – Clarence babysits bulldozers Zip and Beep, but has trouble keeping up with them! **Mighty Truck: Muddymania!** – Clarence and Bruno go to a monster truck rally where Clarence needs to transform into Mighty Truck without revealing his secret identity.

The Nutcracker Comes to America: How Three Ballet-Loving Brothers Created a Holiday Tradition – An account of America's first full-length performance of *The Nutcracker* in San Francisco in 1944.

Shark vs. Train – A shark and train compete in a series of contests on a seesaw, in hot air balloons, bowling, shooting baskets, playing hide-and-seek, and more.

What Do You Do with a Voice Like That? – A picture book biography of lawyer, politician, and civil rights leader Barbara Jordan.

Whoosh!: Lonnie Johnson's Super-Soaking Stream of Inventions – A picture book biography of Lonnie Johnson, an engineer at NASA who is best known for inventing the Super Soaker water gun.
