- Facilitate trainings on an array of areas and topics.

Mentors help answer questions you may have and provide support for you and your child so that he/she may have a better opportunity to succeed in their education.

Mentors attend many trainings throughout the year to stay current on Special Education issues as it relates to both Federal and State areas. Many of these trainings are facilitated by the Georgia Department of Education and/or experts in their subject areas.
