What is one adjective (describing word) that explains your person's belief system/activism?	

Agents of Change Poster Activity

TASK: After reading about your assigned Agent of Change, as a group, your task is to create a poster to represent your Agent of Change. **EVERYTHING should be in your own words!!!!**

Your mural should include:

1. Name of Agent of Change
2. Image(s) that represent your agent of change (their mission, ideals, history, etc.)
3. Include:
 - a. Who are they?
Include: Where were they born? When is their birthday? Any other important details
 - b. Personal Life
Include: 3 important details
 - c. Activism
Include major features of their activism (What did they do? How did they create change?)
 - d. Interethnic solidarity (showing up for other ethnic groups)
Name the person/group that your agent of change is connected with.
What did they accomplish together

Group Roles & Responsibilities:

Each group member will take on one role listed below. This is your responsibility for the group poster.

Role	Explanation of Role	Part of poster assigned
Facilitator	Help the group get started, clearly go over/read the task to the group, make sure everyone knows their task/part and hold them accountable for the work.	- Name of Agent of Change - Interethnic Solidarity
Materials Manager	Responsible for gathering and returning all materials used by group	- Image(s) that represent your agent of change (their mission, ideals, history, etc.)
Timekeeper	Keep time for your group to ensure the project is fully complete by the deadline	- Who are they? - Personal Life - Adjective for Agent of Change
Group Analyst	Ensure the accuracy of your information, fact checking details from the reading, this info will be presented to your peers!	- Activism - Images
Support Staff (only if 5th group member!!)	As needed - support the facilitator and group analyst (big jobs!) - You're the only person who is able to ask questions of the teacher.	Support the timekeeper and group analyst with their parts of the poster
