



This is Snowflake, A white cat.

This is Oreo, A black cat.










Then all of a sudden, Coco asked,




"Don't you know?"

Coco was also confused.


She seemed scared,

And then she accused,




"Black cats are dangerous, Very violent too. You should get away Before it hurts you"








"I'm sorry," said Coco.

I misplaced my blame."






And with that apology,

Words to Know:

Microaggression - Small insults, actions, and comments that show bias (what Coco had said)

Stereotype - an often incorrect assumption about everyone in a particular group (black cats)

Prejudice - a preconceived, unfair bias or opinion without a good reason (that black cats are bad)

Upstander - Someone who takes action against bullying (in this case, Cheeto, but anyone can be an upstander)
