


ASPIRING LATINO LEADERS FELLOWSHIP

The **Aspiring Latino Leaders Fellowship** through Latinos for Education is a 9-month program that supports 50-75 Latinx education leaders in Massachusetts, Houston, and the Bay Area to advance in their leadership journey and ultimately expand their sphere of influence in the education sector, so more of our students succeed. We support our Fellows through culturally responsive professional development and a strong network of Latino professionals locally with the ultimate goal of strengthening the following leadership competencies:

- Translating and communicating values into action through the Public Narrative framework.
- Understanding and leveraging Latino identity to develop professionally and increase influence in education.
- Growing as a Latinx educator leading DEI in education.
- Building knowledge of a complex policy world to advocate for positive change for Latino students and families.
- Learning and using data-driven and research-based frameworks that can help improve educational outcomes.
- Advancing and empowering one's career to positively impact more students.



IDEAL CANDIDATE

Personal Characteristics:

- Identify as Latino/a/x/e
- Minimum 8 years of professional experience
- Commitment to education equity for Latinx students within their local ecosystem and nationally.
- Desire to learn, grow, and expand their sphere of influence.
- Personification of Latinos for Education's core values.
- Openness to new ideas and alternative perspectives of education leadership.

Possible Professional Backgrounds:

- Employed by a Public School District, CMO, or Private K-12 education organization
- Currently in a mid-level leadership position (campus or central office)

PROGRAM TIMELINE

PROGRAM FEES AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Tuition for the program is \$7,000 and includes all trainings, retreats, and materials. We are committed to keeping tuition costs accessible to applicants, and as such, the out-of-pocket expenses for fellows is capped at \$300 to participate in the program. The fee is due when fellows accept their offer to participate in the fellowship around early-mid June. The remainder of the tuition is subsidized through the fellow's employer and Latinos for Education scholarship support.
