Medication Policy

With **written** approval from your student's medical doctor and **written** approval from their parent/guardian, a student is allowed to carry and self-administer medication or have medication pstored in the Health Office.

Medications include:

- Prescribed pills/tablets
- Over-the-counter pain relievers (e.g., Tylenol, Advil)
- Prescribed treatments for medical conditions (e.g., EpiPens, Diabetic medication and supplies, Migraine medications)

You may print out a Medication Authorization Form at our Millshigh.org site under Student Health or the forms are available in the Health Office. This form is also on the back side of the Medical Examiner's Statement which is also on Millshigh.org—Student Health

Medication Forms must be renewed every school year and all medication at school must be kept as follows:

- In the original pharmacy container
- Labeled with name of student
- Prescribing health care provider and medication
- Date of the original prescription
- Strength and dose of medication
- Directions for use
