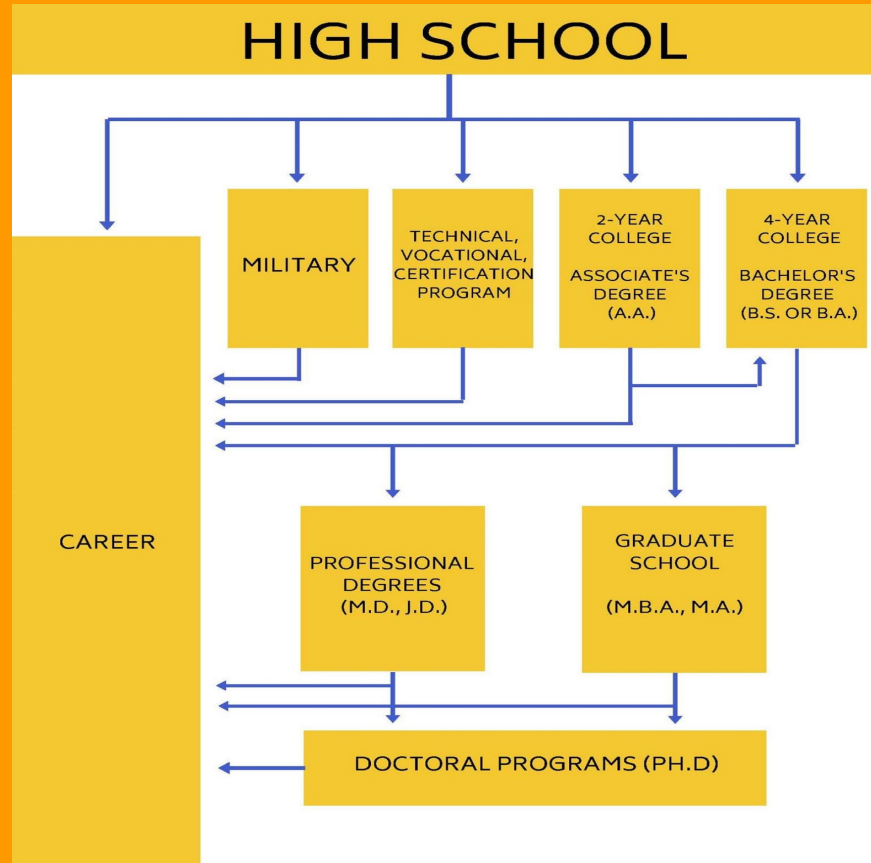

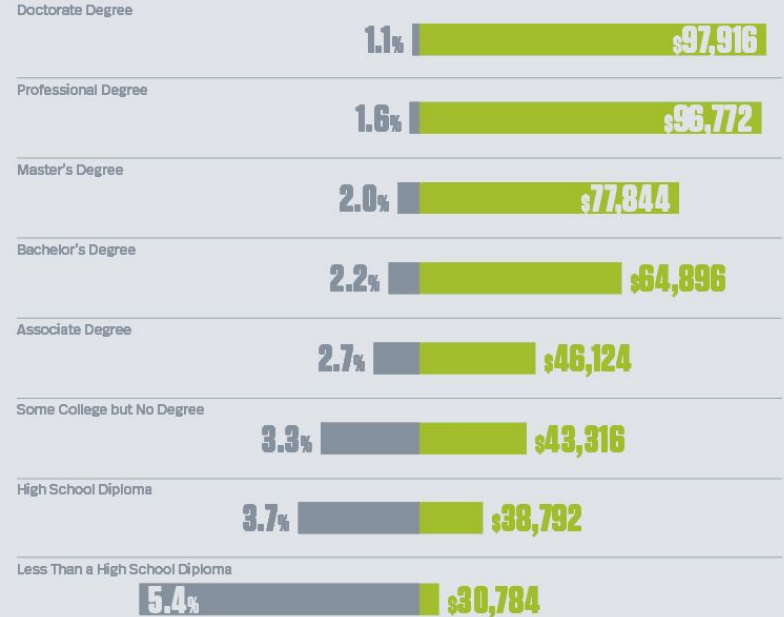
- Entry-level positions

Military



Requirements:

- At least 17 years of age
- US Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Complete the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB)
- Pass a physical exam
- Complete Basic Training

Benefits:

- Specialty Training
- Housing stipend
- Tuition reimbursement
- Early retirement (as early as 20 years of active service)
- Travel Opportunities

Apprenticeship Programs

- Must be 18 years or older
- Usually require High School Diploma or equivalent
- Paid on-the-job training and classroom instruction that often lead to full-time employment.
- Typically lasts 1-3 years
- Electrician, HVAC, Plumber, Welder, etc.



Community College

- Certificates
- Associate's degrees
- Prepares students to transfer to UCs/CSUs/Independent & Private Universities
- **Tuition:** \$2,173 per year (average)
- **Admission requirements:** HS Diploma and/or be 18 years old
- Open access = 100% acceptance rate

4-Year Universities

California has three different types of 4-year colleges:

1. California State Universities (CSUs)
2. University of California (UCs)
3. Private and Independent Colleges

Offer Bachelor Degrees and advanced degrees.

California State University (CSU)

- 23 Diverse Campuses
- Prepares students for professional work through *real world application*.
- **Tuition:** \$6,782 per year (average)
- **Admission requirements:** A-G coursework and 2.0 minimum GPA (** Currently test blind)
- Accepts the top 33% of high school students



University of California (UC)

- 9 campuses award undergraduate degrees
- Focuses on *research and theory*
- Prepares students for graduate and professional school in addition to work
- **Tuition:** \$14,226 per year (average)
- **Admission requirements:** Admission based on **14 factors** including A-G coursework, 3.0 minimum GPA, Personal Insight Questions, Extracurriculars, etc. (** Currently test blind)
- Accepts the top 9% of high school students



Private/Independent Colleges

- Over 75 unique private and independent colleges and universities in California
- Many more out-of-state
- **Tuition** is usually more expensive but varies; must consider out-of-state fees
- **Admission requirements** vary but many follow the A-G requirements.


