
“From which Pittsford school did you graduate?”

Skipped = 48




Overall, this represents a 21% response rate.









“Have you changed majors since your acceptance into college?”




Historical comparison of the survey question “Have you changed majors since your acceptance into college?”






“Based on your high school experience, how well prepared do you feel in your current endeavors as compared to your peers?”










































