### **Agenda Items:**

- 1. Approved February 27, 2019 minutes
- 2. Follow Up discussion and Tasks
  - School Community Safety Forum
    - o 30-40 people attended, but no parents attended
    - o It was advertised: tweeted, flyers posted at buildings and it was sent????? Town of Pittsford advertised, Any other way???
  - It would be nice if the whole staff could hear the presentations
    - o We have talked about doing a podcast
    - o Q&A will be posted on the website
    - o Will a summary and overview also be posted
  - A week later there was also an EducateU Night at Mendon High School
    - o Topics Include: Hidden in Plain Sight, Vaping, Practicing Difficult Conversations, Mental Health Panel
    - o About 40 people attended this event
      - ✓ Flyers were posted in buildings, sent out via email to parents???, Town of Pittsford also advertised this event
      - ✓ If anyone has more ideas of how to advertise let Pat know
- 3. April 8<sup>th</sup> Run, Hide, Fight training for Clerical Staff feedback
  - Training was very informative and had hands on training
  - There was training as to how to put on a tourniquet and how to pack a deep wound
  - Ideas were give as to how/where to hide, items to use to defend group/yourself in a classroom/or any location, we were also taught how to divert someone with a gun
  - Given explanations as to when it is best to run, hide or fight
    - o If possible run should be the first action
    - o If shooter is close, hide

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- o Fight is a last resort
- 4. Reviewed selection of Run/Hide/Fight videos
  - Selected a video to share with schools in September
  - The Sheriff's office and PayChecks is releasing a video but it is more around the corporate world
- 5. Next steps for ongoing training
  - Continue to review options for Monroe County Sheriff's Department training
- 6. Other Items
  - Entry doors and windows are being labeled at each building
  - The badges system is in the process of being updated
    - o Have to hold badge a bit longer at the reader when entering a building
    - The copier readers will also be changed
    - o New badges will be distributed to staff

- Update on door and windows labeling
- Staff badges updated to enhance safety
- DUI simulation
- Large scale evacuation drill at CRMS in May
