 - Working on \$6 million capital project
 - Most of the project updates came off the Annual Visual Inspection
 Emergency generators, roofing etc.
 - NYSER Inspections March 31st
 - Safety Button inspection is planned for April 30th
 - Fire inspections are scheduled for May
 - Lead water testing will be in June early morning hours
 - Looking at having the senior parade to go by Nazareth College on June 5th, a fire truck will lead the parade
 - June 11th MHS and SHS outside ball/prom
 - June 19th graduations will be in the stadiums
- 3. Follow Up to Elementary Recess Question
 - Protocol for elementary recess have been put in place
 - Pat will send them out to the committee
- 4. Check in Survey
 - People who filled out the survey
 - o 1,859 parents
 - o 2,419 students
 - o 1,176 staff including remote, food service, custodial
 - o Students, parents, staff fell as though students need more socialization
 - o Survey was taken mid to late January
 - Secondary students state they feel as though they are able to organize school work, stay engaged and able to work independently
 - Some do report they are more distracted at home vs. being at school
 - Students report they feel as though their sleep is disrupted and can't turn off their brains at night
 - Staff stress management additional supports that would help
