- 2. Shout out to the Safety Committee from the Board of Ed for the weekly meetings and hard work the committee has done.
- 3. AVI Report Summary
  - Buildings are in good shape
  - Transportation and Maintenance need more paved area for buses
  - Lomb building could use many updates but it is safe for people to work in
  - Our priorities are buildings with students
  - The committee was in agreement to submit the report to the State
- 4. Path Question
  - We do have paths to get to schools, fields and playgrounds
  - The paths are paved
  - There are 10-12 back paths from school to the neighborhoods
  - Some of the paths connect to the playground, some don't
  - Normally there is a steel post blocking the sidewalk so cars can't drive on them
  - During the summer there is more walking and biking traffic
  - We have had signage up in the past but they have been vandalized
  - Spraying caution or slow down on the pavement would be difficult to maintain
  - There is no code or requirement for us to put up signage or a gate
  - Town has put out a bike/walk safety flyer/newsletter, this could be sent to the PTSA for them to distribute or the building principals could distribute
  - Town will also send something out
  - Communication's office could also send something out
  - The Town is exploring way to encourage outside activities
  - Kelly will mention the safety share the discussion about the Paths with the Town

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- 5. Gender Neutral Bathrooms
  - Harris Beach Notice shared outlining the requirements
  - We will establish a policy and procedure for some guidance to building
- 6. Drinking Fountain Question
  - Drinking fountains cannot be used at this time
  - Bottle fillers are operational
- 7. Volunteer Policy Question
  - We are mostly looking at volunteers
    - For athletics
    - For field days at the elementary schools
  - The volunteers should be trained on protocol/requirements and assigned duties
  - Volunteers could use the QR code for the screening
- 8. Other
  - Exploring Pod combination or grade level activities at elementary schools
  - How we determine maximum occupancy of a room?
    - Administrators use 6 feet guidelines to determine
  - Spring Break Travel Guidelines
    - o Self-administered rapid COVID-19 tests are not valid
    - o Requirements will be updated when additional information is received

  - Gender Neutral Bathrooms
  - Path Safety
  - Drinking fountains are still blocked off except for water bottle feeders
