 - If a teacher gets sick contact tracing how does contact tracing occur

 - Internal Testing should as person who has had the first dose of the COVID 19 vaccine be tested
 - The vaccine doesn't alter the test results
 - When you get the COVID vaccine it can trigger some COVID symptoms in some people
 - When feeling ill what time should we take? Staff will be notified of process
- 2. Updates from Jeff B.
 - When wipes gloves, placemats arrive, supplies are sent to schools
 - When they get the wipes, gloves, placements they are sent to the schools
 - Annual Visual Inspection Report will be brought to Safety Council
 - Building Condition Survey is due in December
 - Engineers are going through the buildings doing assessments and analyses
 - Lead water testing needs to be completed by the end of June
