- Kids are not supposed to be snacking in class at this time- pre- COVID kids ate all day long in class except for science and teacher discretion
- Elementary students have a snack time built into the schedule

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5. Other Topics

- Food as a celebration
 - o Kelly Klein the Department of Health is extremely strict.
 - ✓ Condiment packages, napkins, plastic ware has to be handed to each individual while social distancing
- Teachers would have to write up a description of what is in the food item
- Elementary was hoping to have some sort of celebration prepackaged snack and drink
 - o Not much different than it used to be accept for prepackaged items (commercially packaged)
 - o Some teachers will be interested others will not be comfortable
 - o Perhaps parents could supply their child's own snack
 - Pat will send out written requirements for a snack/Halloween asking for committee to send back comments
- Papers on teachers desks
 - Teachers have been concerned about papers on desks curling from the spray.
 Desks will only be wiped down/sprayed if cleared
