 Shana shared the training teachers and staff underwent during Supt. Day April 8, 2022 Provided timeline of the Board Approval of Code of Conduct. The initial training staff received highlighted the restorative component of the Code of Conduct. The training was designed to meet teachers on the continuum of implementing the code of conduct and restorative practices. The intention was to get the adults to think differently about situations; to consider things that they may not readily see in the case or on the surface. The idea was shared on rolling this same training out to PCSD Parents/Community members. Substitute teachers often derail progress around restorative practices. Therefore, PCSD is looking for ways to offer training for adults new to that space. We continue to identify barriers to training and systematic implementation of the Code of Conduct and Restorative Practices. 	Shana Cutaia
