Supt. Student Advisory Council (SSAC)

* Supt. Pero shared out on the work that has been done in meeting the goal of establishing the Supt. Student Advisory Council and the work that has been done since its creation. Advisory Council members shared the work currently being done around creating an International Day celebration at all secondary schools, as well as the work in establishing a vision and a five-year strategic plan for where the SSAC envisions PCSD.

"I am Pittsford" Video Update

PCSD has created a **media campaign**, including a video montage, showing PCSD students discussing inclusion and belonging. REN was created as a way to build equity resources and to help be a form of support in elevating student voice.
