



Proposed 17.16% increase for 2024-25 school year




440- Career Internship Program

Recent change in staffing and oversight of the program to align with NYS CTE requirements


Proposed 3.97% increase for 2024-25




BOCES Summer School Program




2024-2025 Proposed Budget




510 – Curriculum and Instruction Proposed Budget by Category Total \$885,317

- Salary Admin and Clerk salaries; Curriculum Development and Steering Payments; Admin and Teacher in-service payments
- Textbooks Textbooks, consumable workbooks, and subscriptions to online resources essential to the delivery of curricular standards
- BOCES Services Software, professional learning, PLTW
- Professional Learning Travel and Conference, consultants
- Contractual Rentals, services
- Other Paper, printing, membership, mileage



511 – Standards Proposed Budget by Category Total \$735,159

- 92% of the budget code is allocated to Standards Leaders' salaries, stipends, and summer workdays
- Standards Leaders are teacher leaders who oversee curriculum and assessment development, support the implementation of best instructional practices, and offer embedded as well as formalized professional learning opportunities for teachers.

 - Current areas of significant work include elementary literacy, elementary social studies, middle school science, middle school world languages, high school English, high school Social Studies
- Significant work continues in the areas of English/Language Arts and Social Studies to better reflect NYSED Culturally Responsive-Sustaining Education Framework

Celebrations

- Revised curriculum template calls out the integration of the NYS Social Emotional Learning Benchmarks and the NYS Computer
 Science/Digital Fluency Standards into curriculum and instruction, K-12
- Protocols in use for the **review of all instructional materials**, which include comprehensive review for diversity and representation
- Students and teachers have embraced **instructional technology tools** and are using them effectively to support teaching and learning
- Critical conversations taking place regarding equitable grading practices, potential enhancements to our secondary reporting system.

Planning forward

- Identification of instructional resources and professional learning to support research-based literacy instruction (Science of Reading) in all elementary classrooms
- Identification of resources and professional learning to align elementary math instruction with NCTM-based recommendations from math ad hoc committee
- Continued work on English/Language Arts and Social Studies Curriculum to align with the NYS CR-SE Framework and our commitment to equity
- Continued work to align secondary science curriculum and instruction with NYS P-12 Science standards as they roll up through high school coursework

Planning forward

- Continued work to understand and integrate SEL Benchmarks and Computer Science/Digital Fluency Standards K-12, all disciplines
- Professional learning opportunities focused on culturally responsive pedagogy, experiences, and instructional materials
- Professional learning to support the embedding of Tier I interventions and differentiation into course work at all levels
- Professional learning revolving around the identified **high leverage instructional strategies** to support and integrate our Next Generation Skills into all areas of learning, K-12.
- Continued support for the **one-to-one device initiative**, grades 3-12
- Social/emotional and mental health support for students and staff
