BUILDING & CONTRUCTION TRADE PRE-APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM

This 500 hour, two semester pre-apprenticeship program prepares students for a career in Carpentry for the Building & Construction trades. Learn shop safety, construction math, blueprint reading, measuring and cutting, material preparation, framing and layout, and other essential skills for future carpenters. This program is aligned with the Western States Regional Council of Carpenters Apprenticeship program.



CURRICULUM

Students will learn:

- · Importance of safety on the job site
- · Shop math: measuring, marking & cutting
- · Blueprint reading
- Layout and framing
- How to use common hand and power tools

Students will complete projects in:

- · Footing & foundations
- · Floor, wall, ceiling & roof framing
- · Installing and finishing drywall
- · Doors and windows
- Acoustical ceilings
- · Flooring, stairs, and trim
