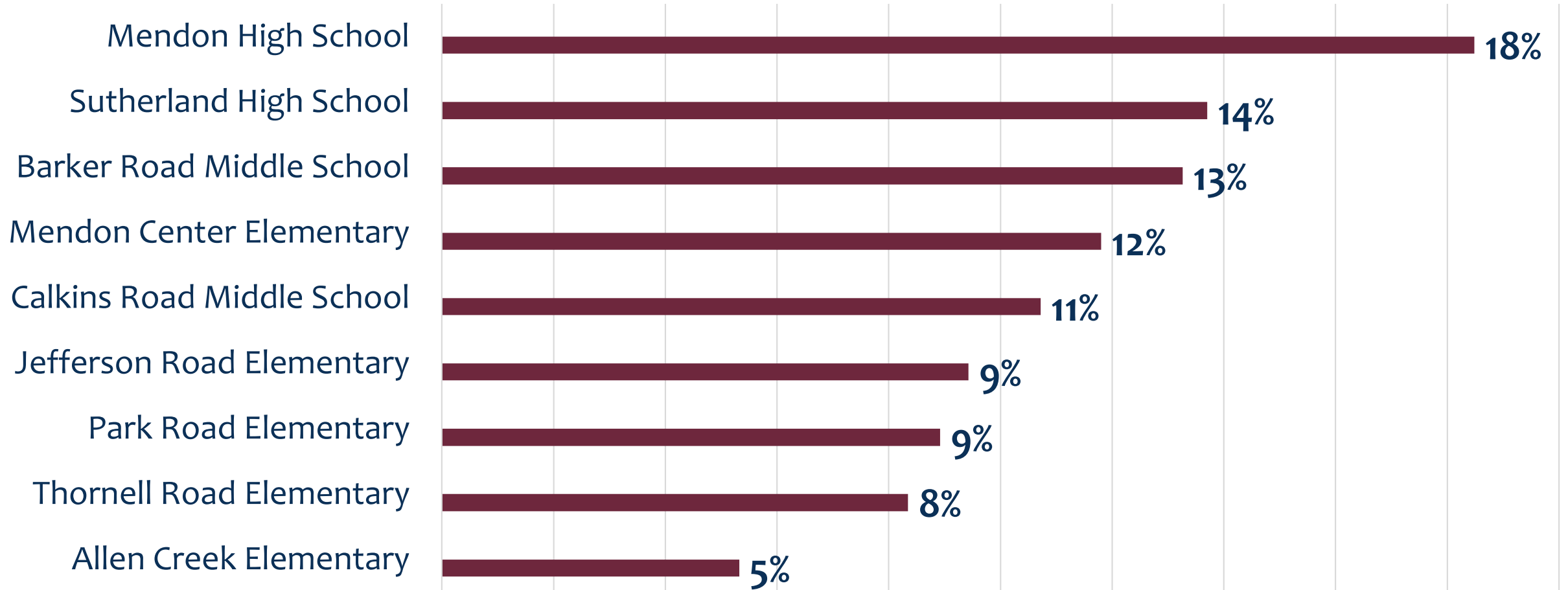
# “For the child this survey response applies to, which PCSD school will your child attend in 2020-2021?”

Number of Survey Responses by School



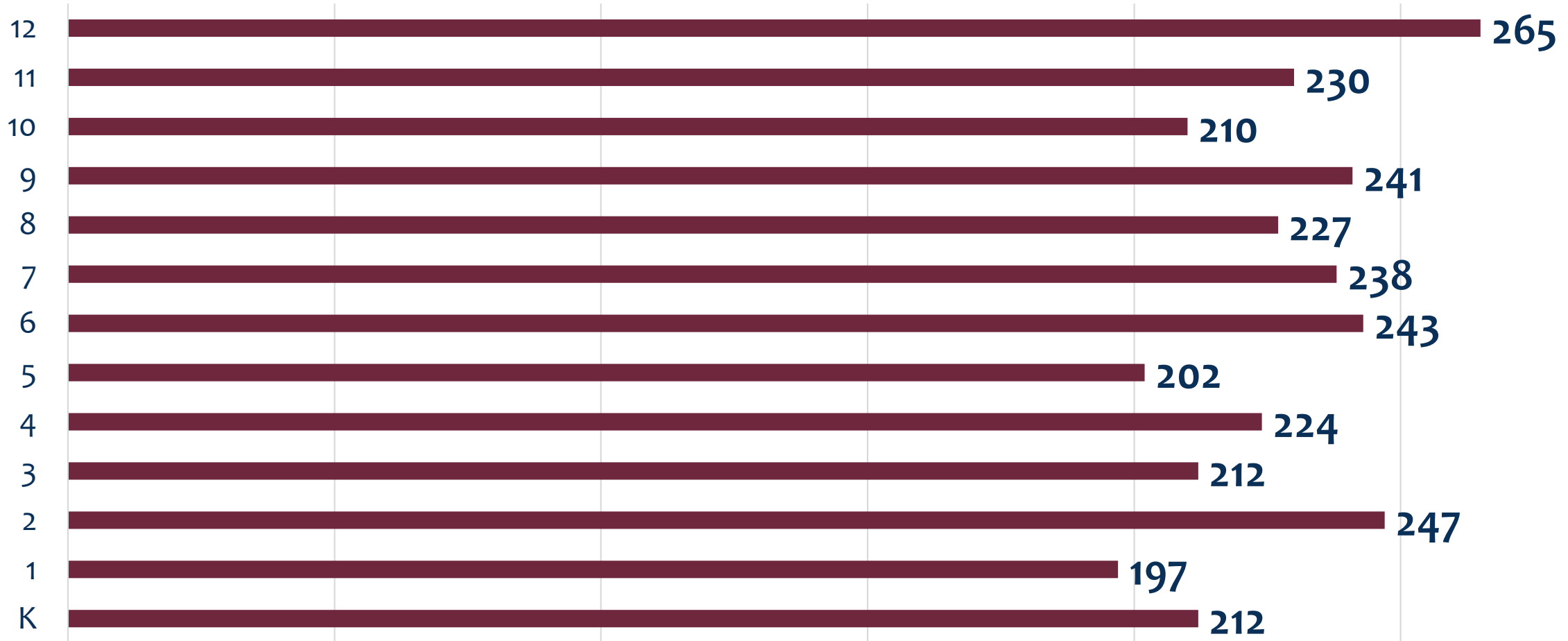

Number of Survey Responses by Grade

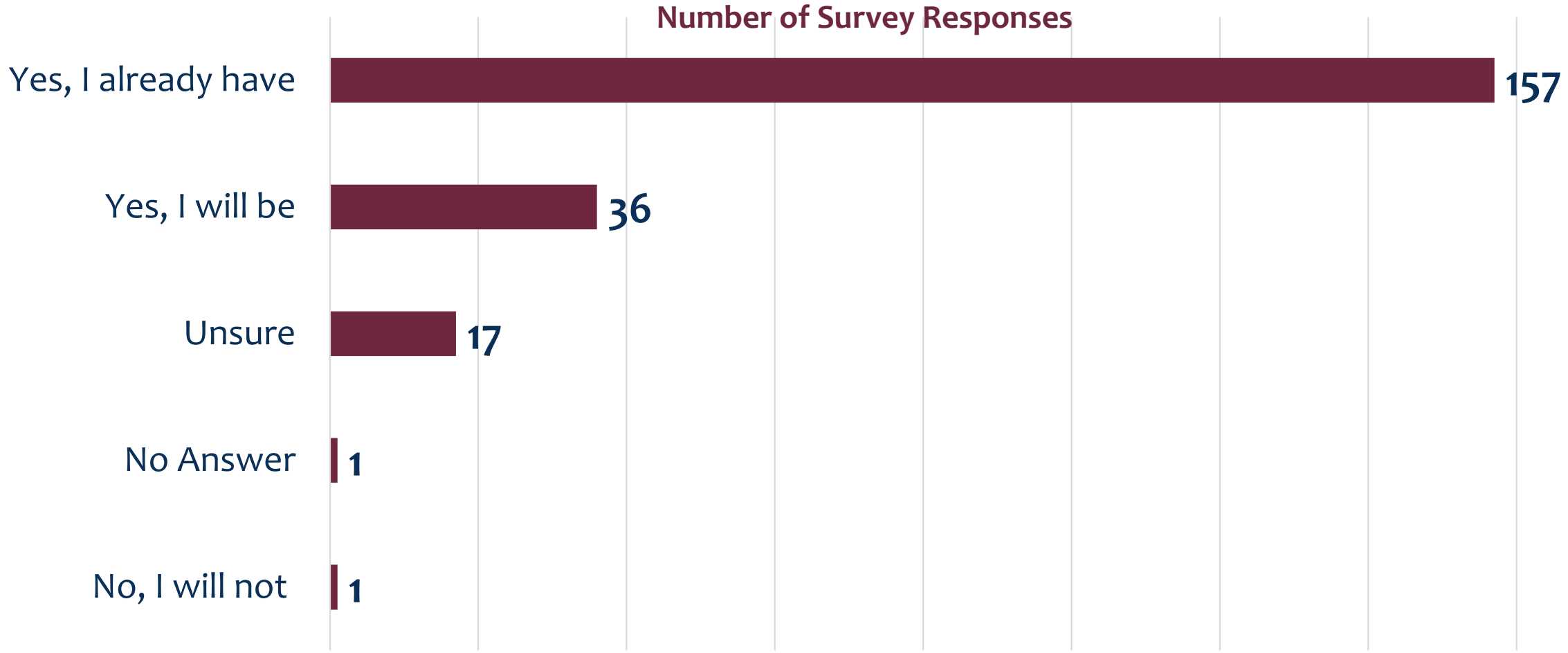

Percent of Responses by Grade Based on All Survey Responses

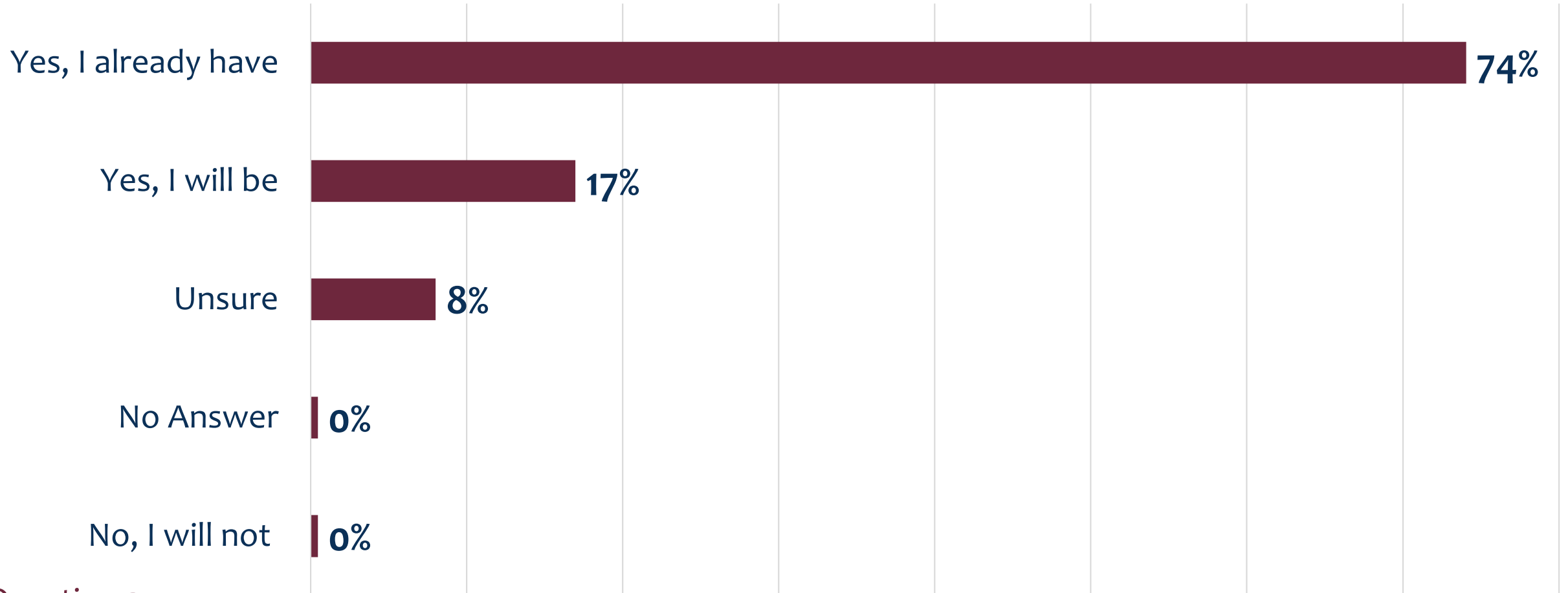

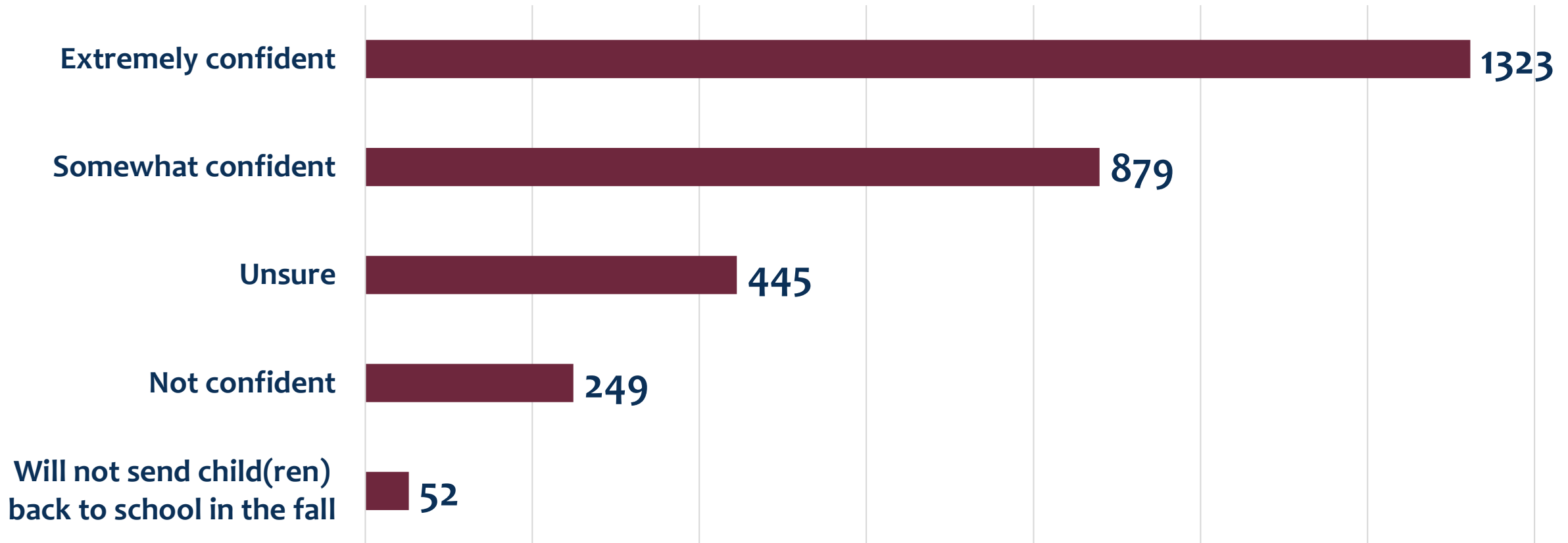

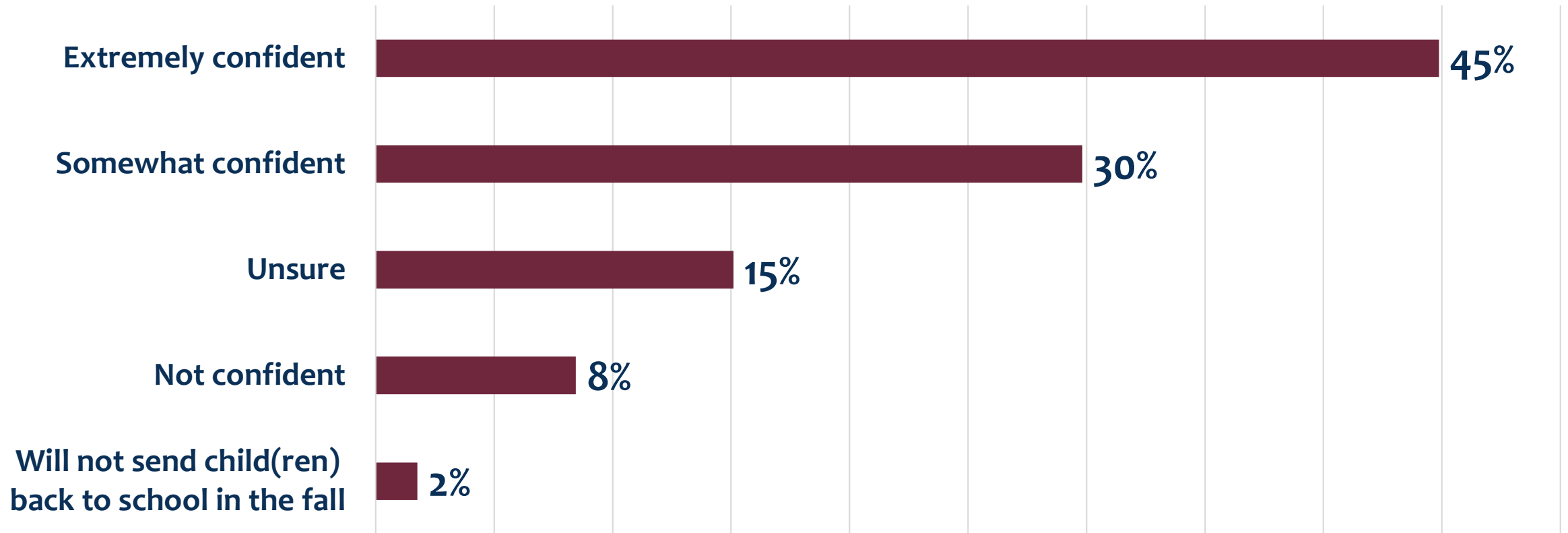

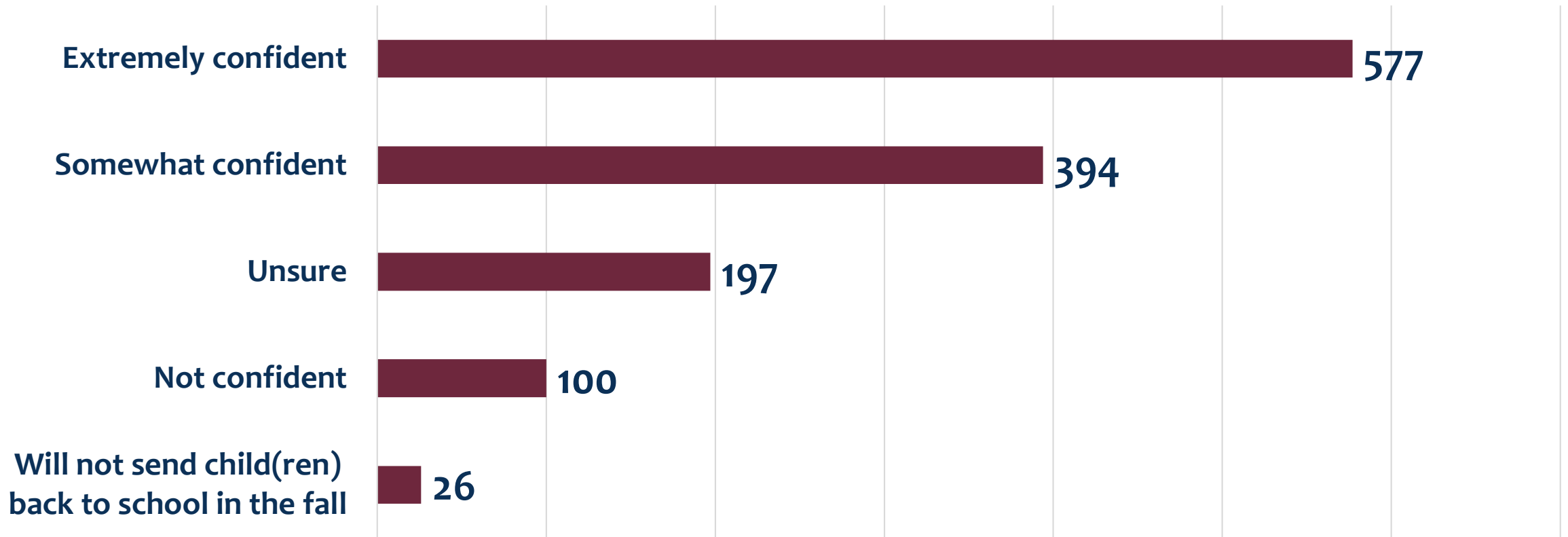

**Overall Results - Percent of Responses Based on All Survey Responses**



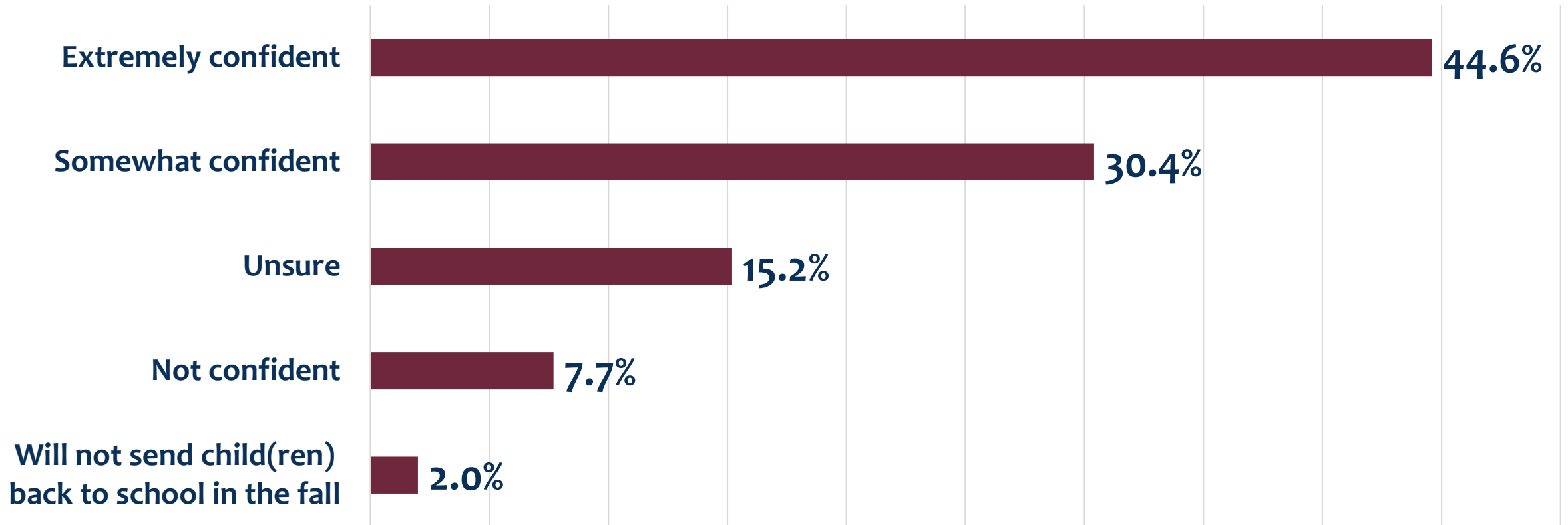

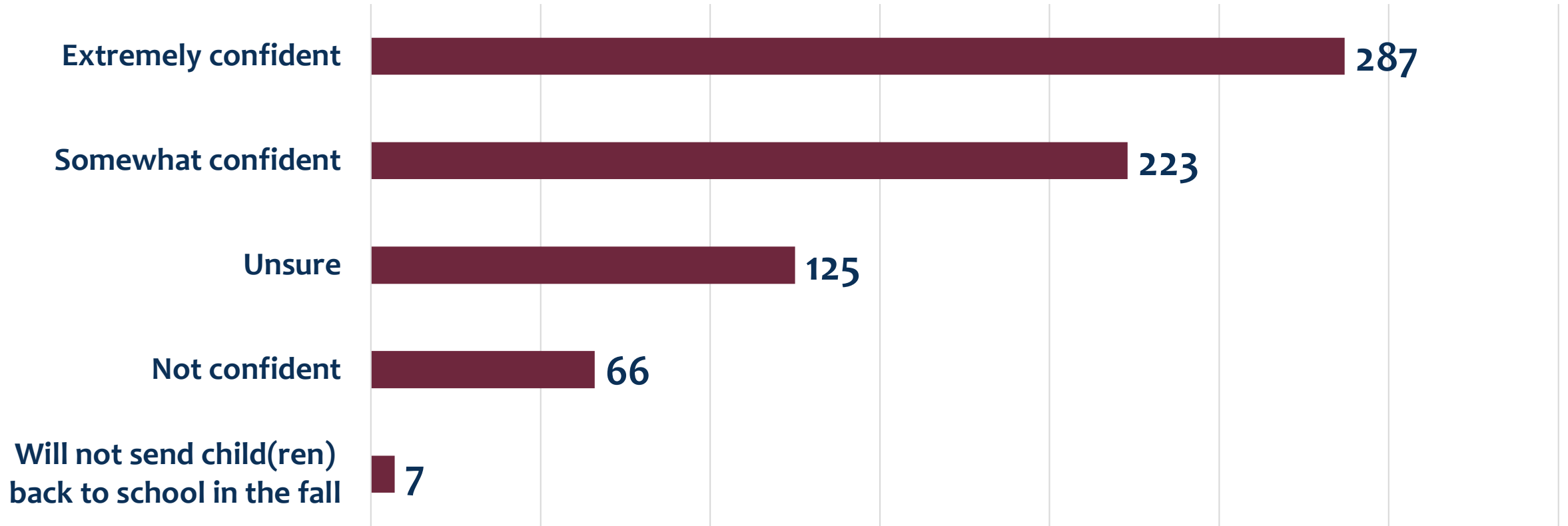

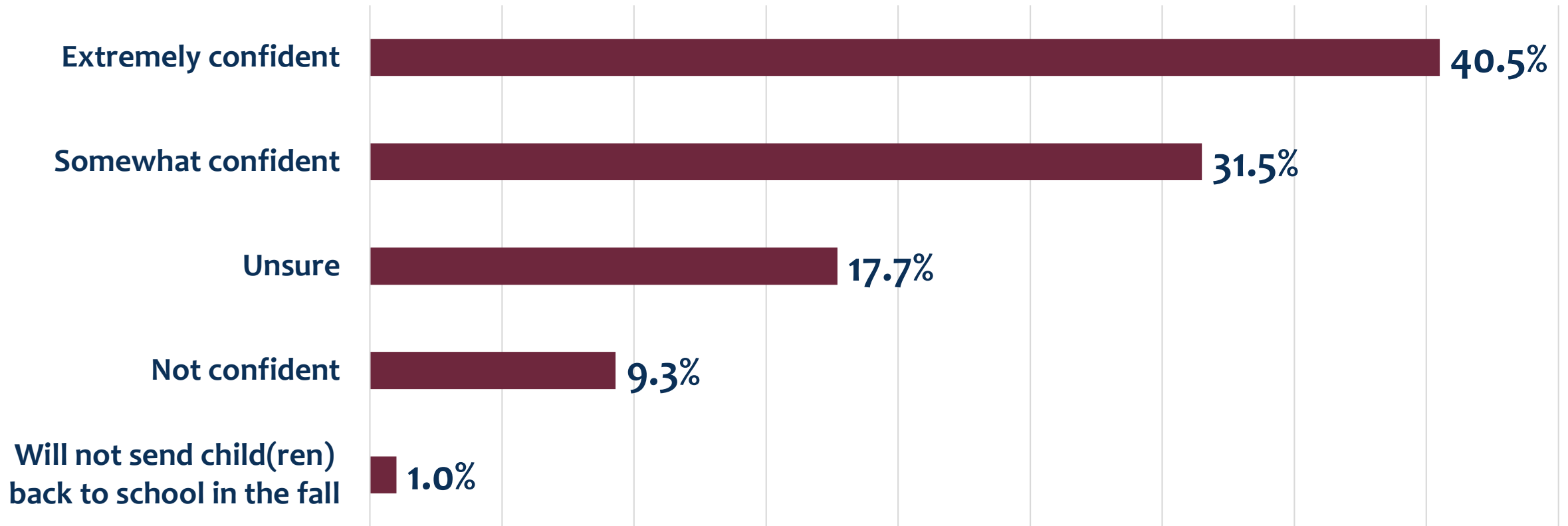

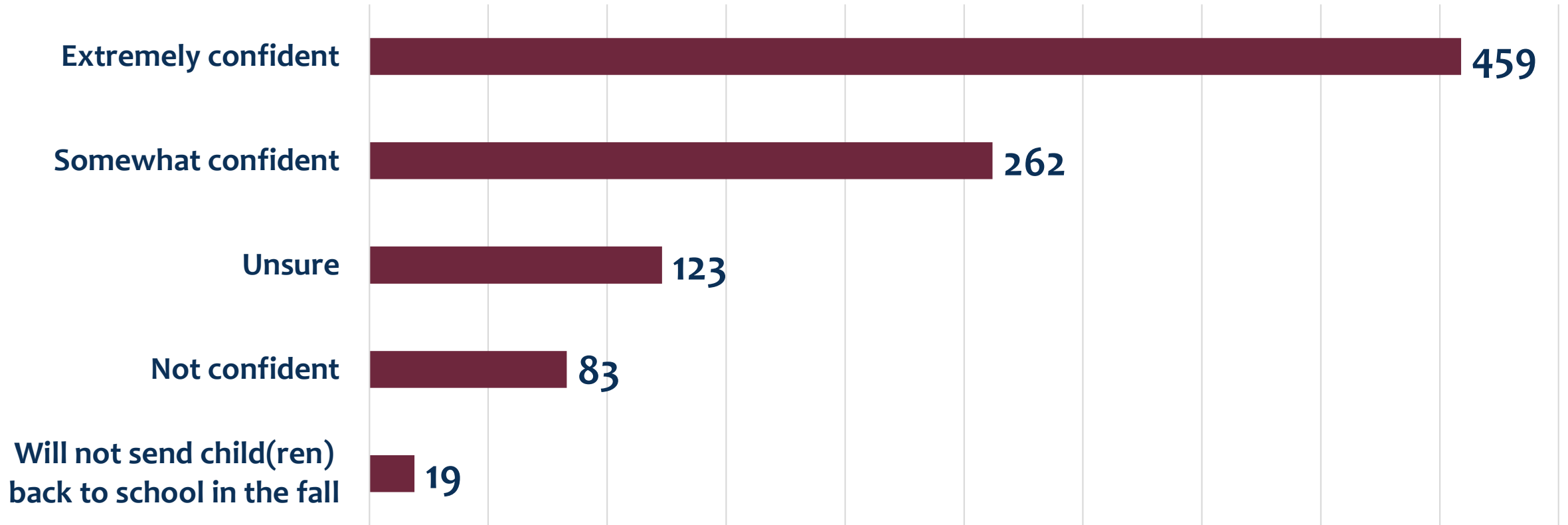

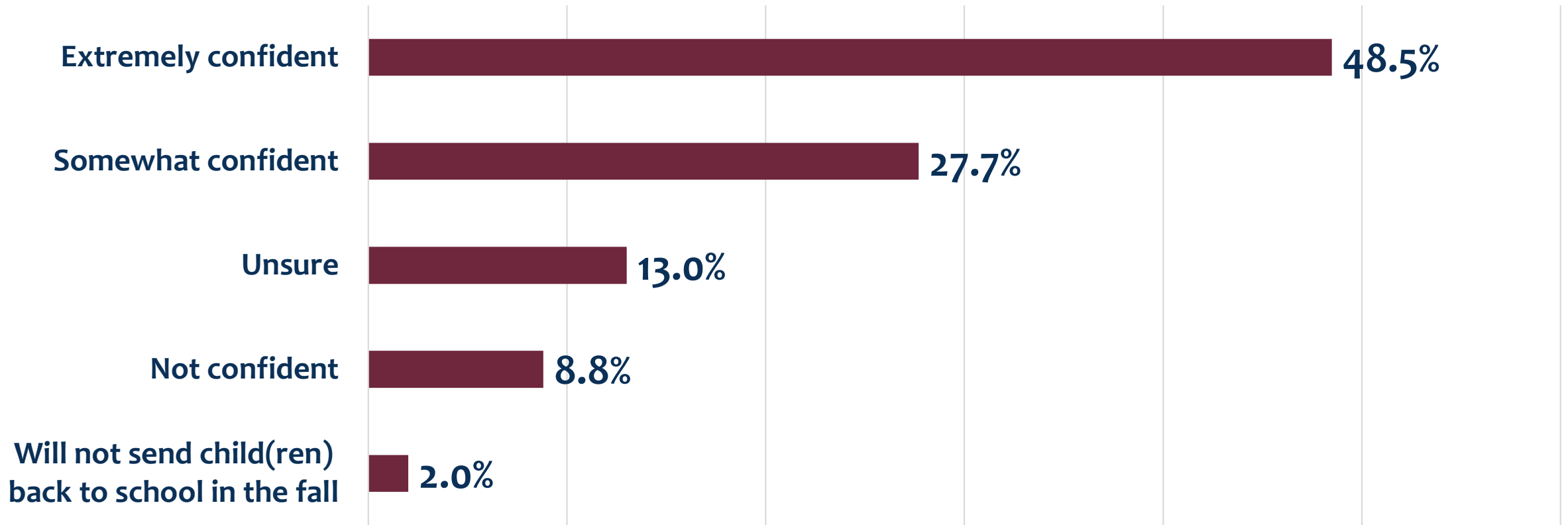

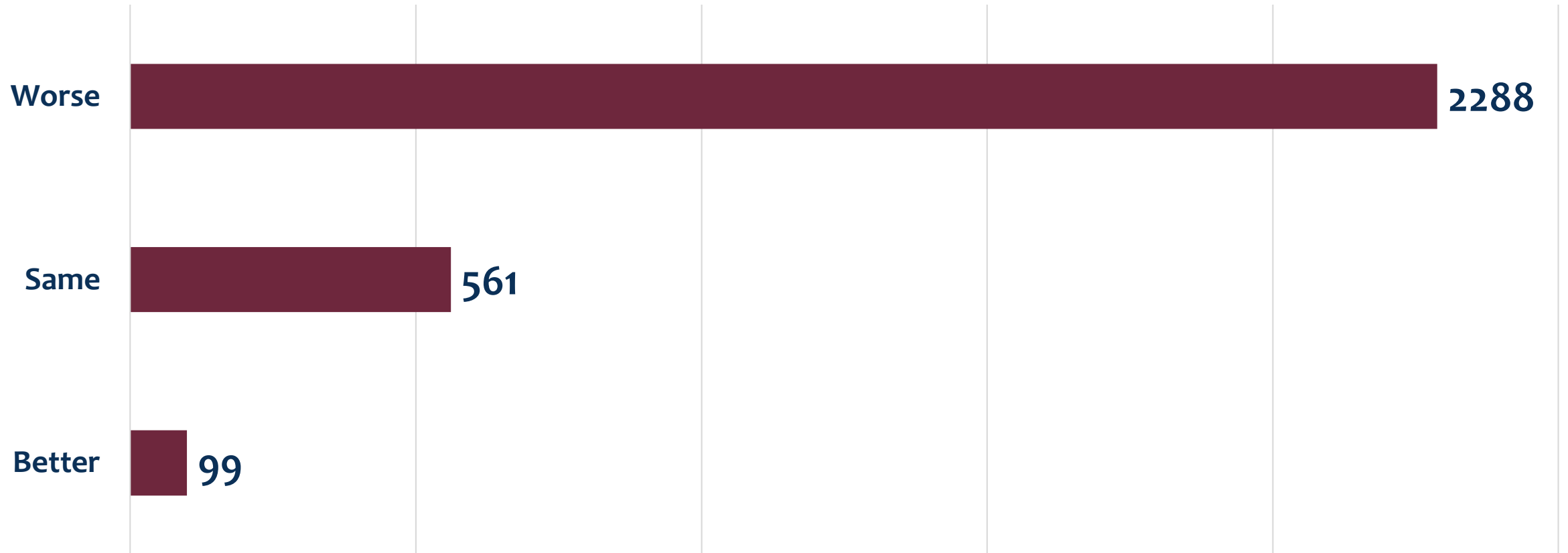

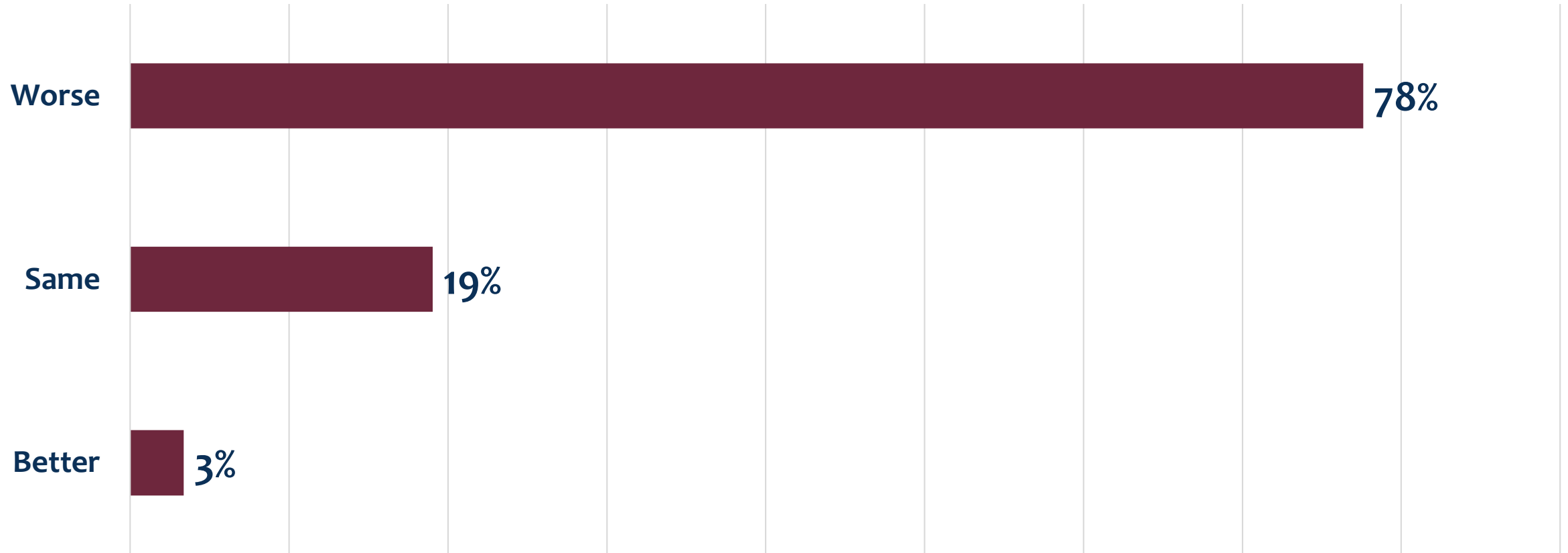

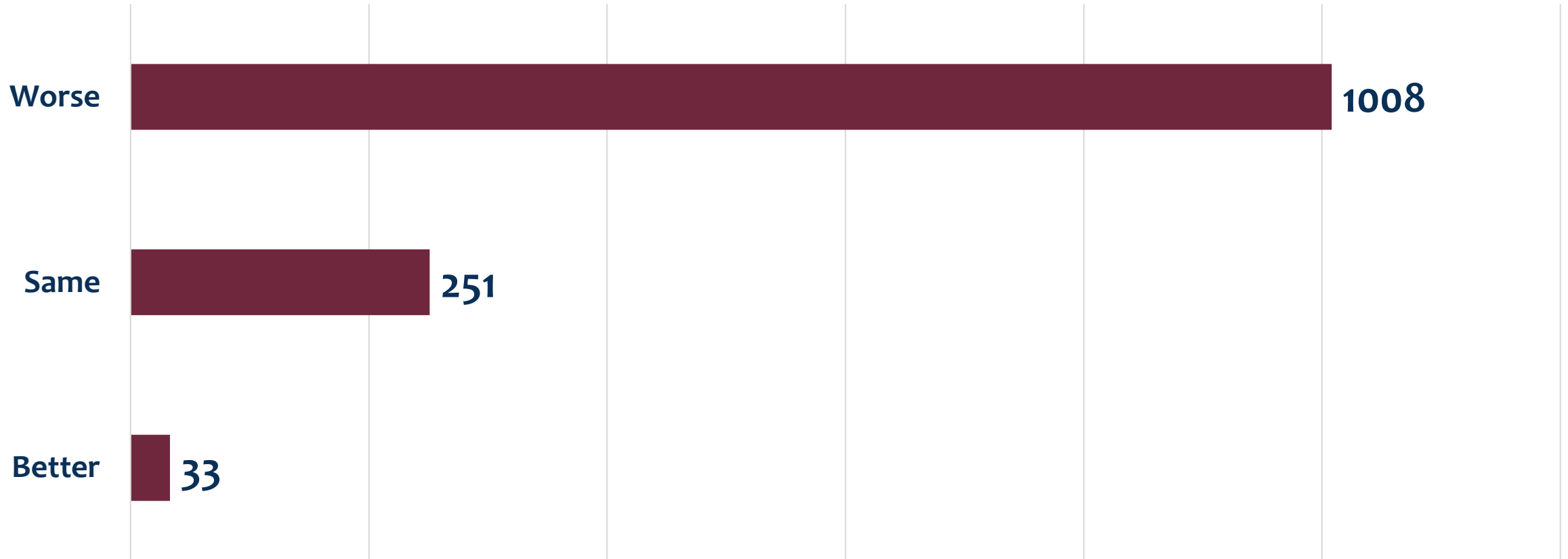

Overall Results - Percent of Responses Based on All Survey Responses



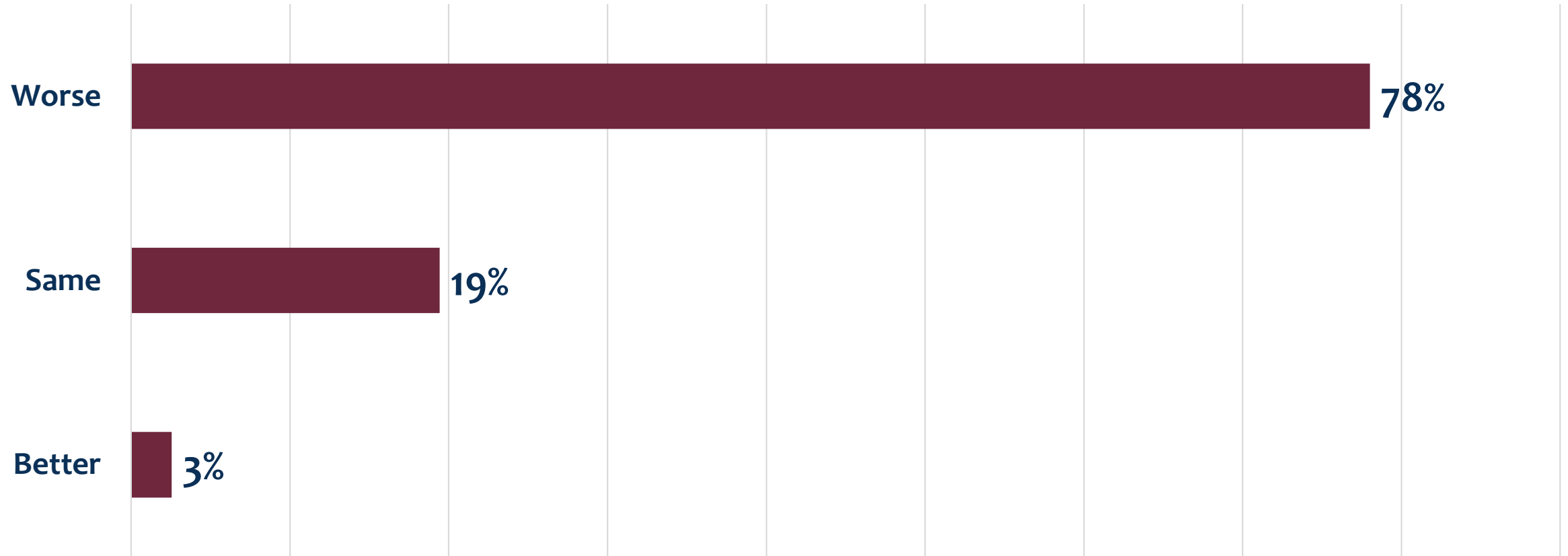

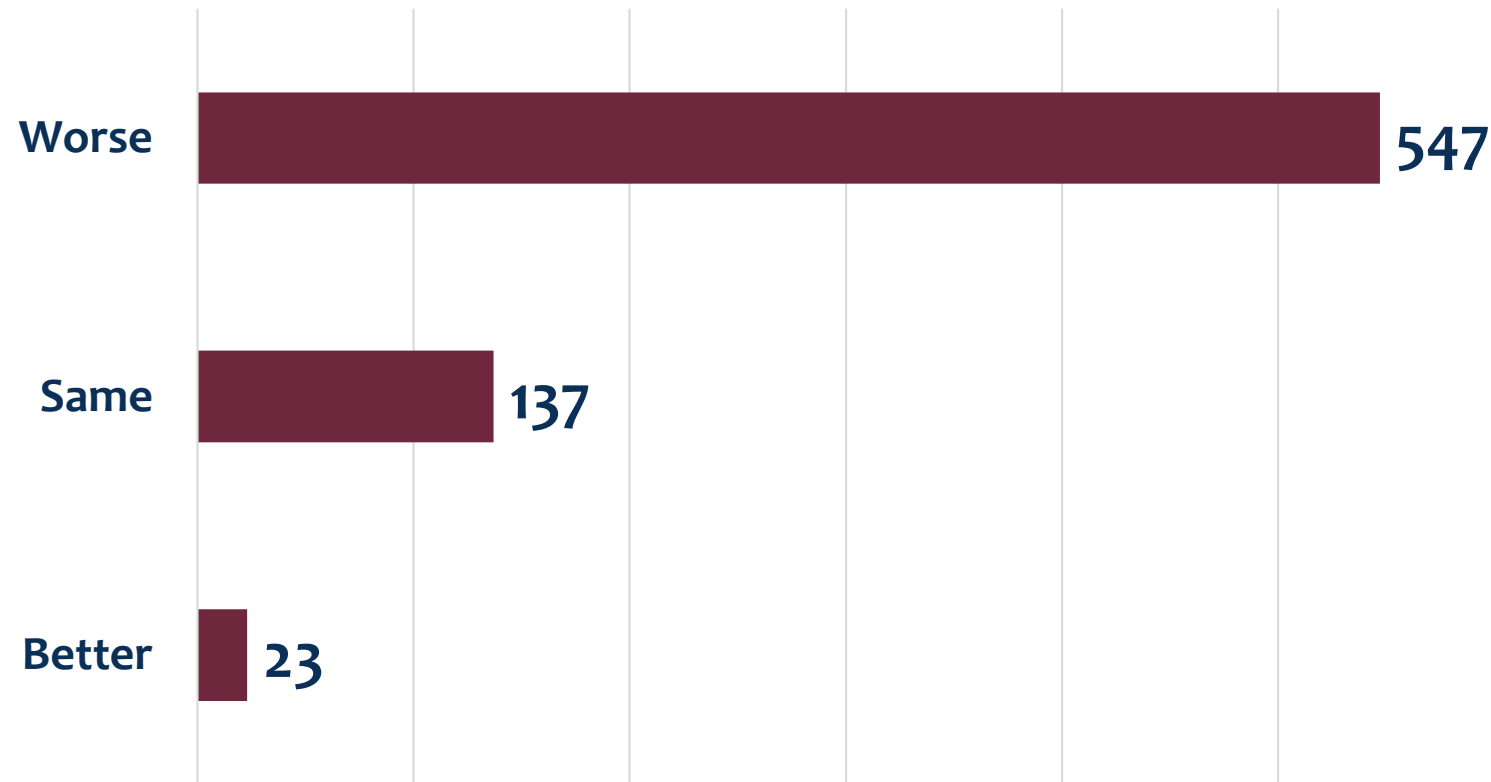

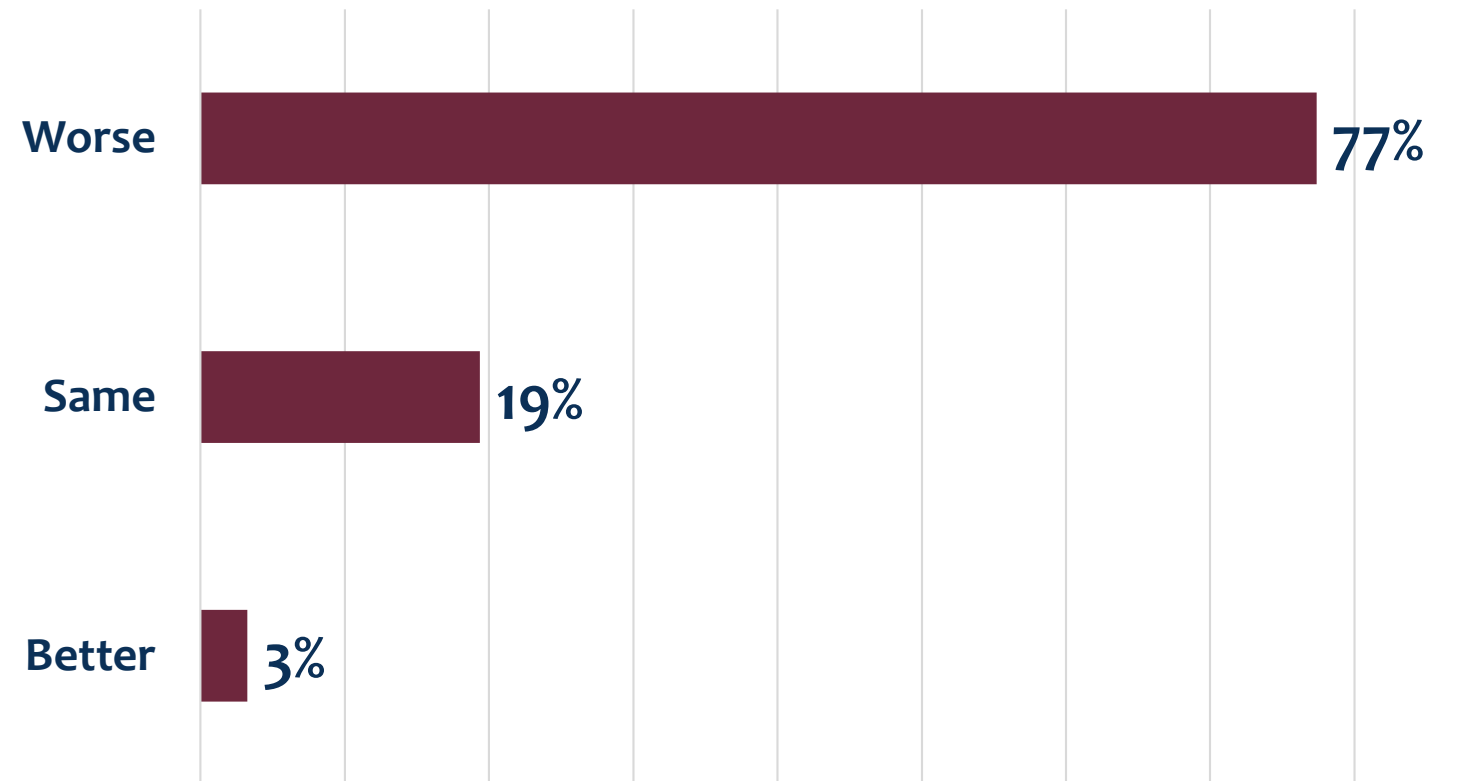

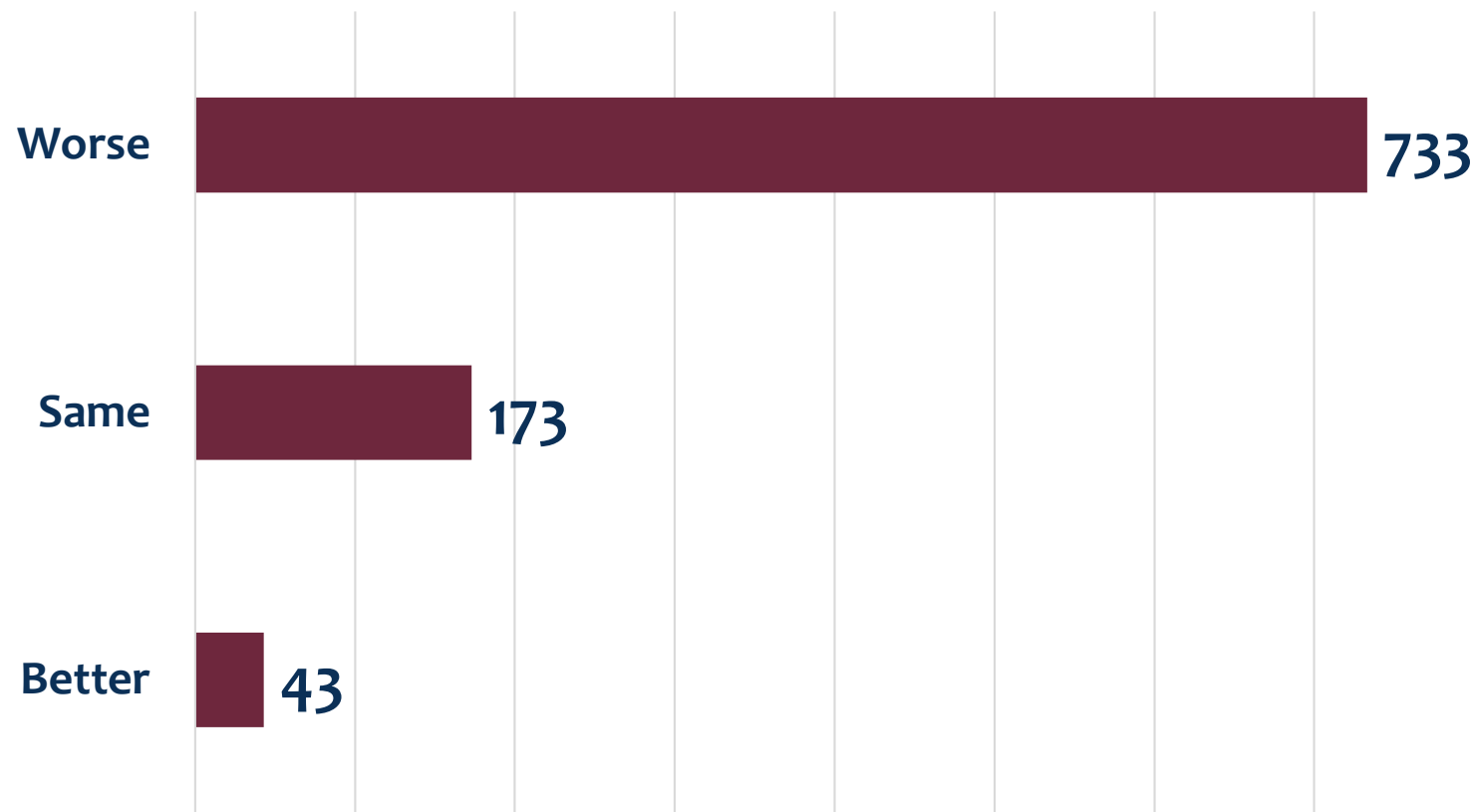

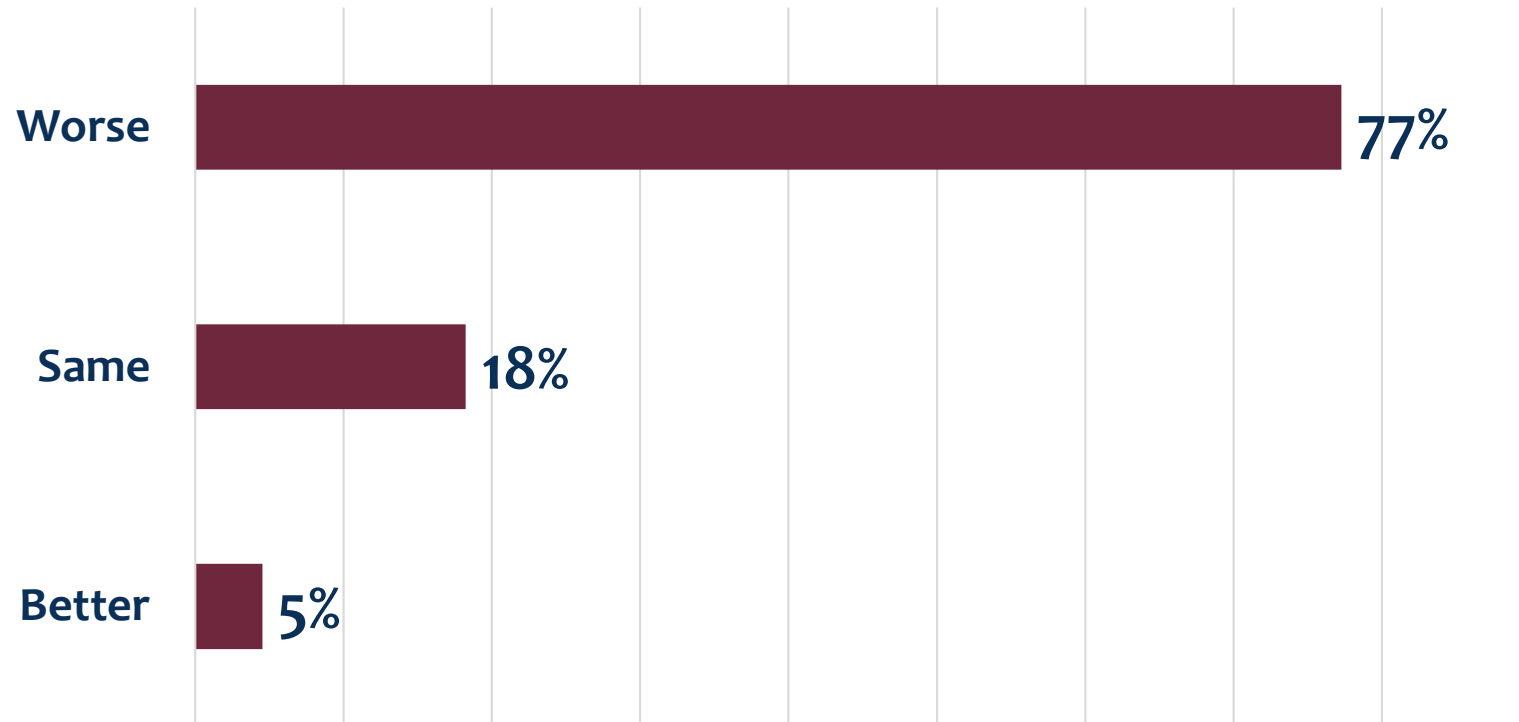

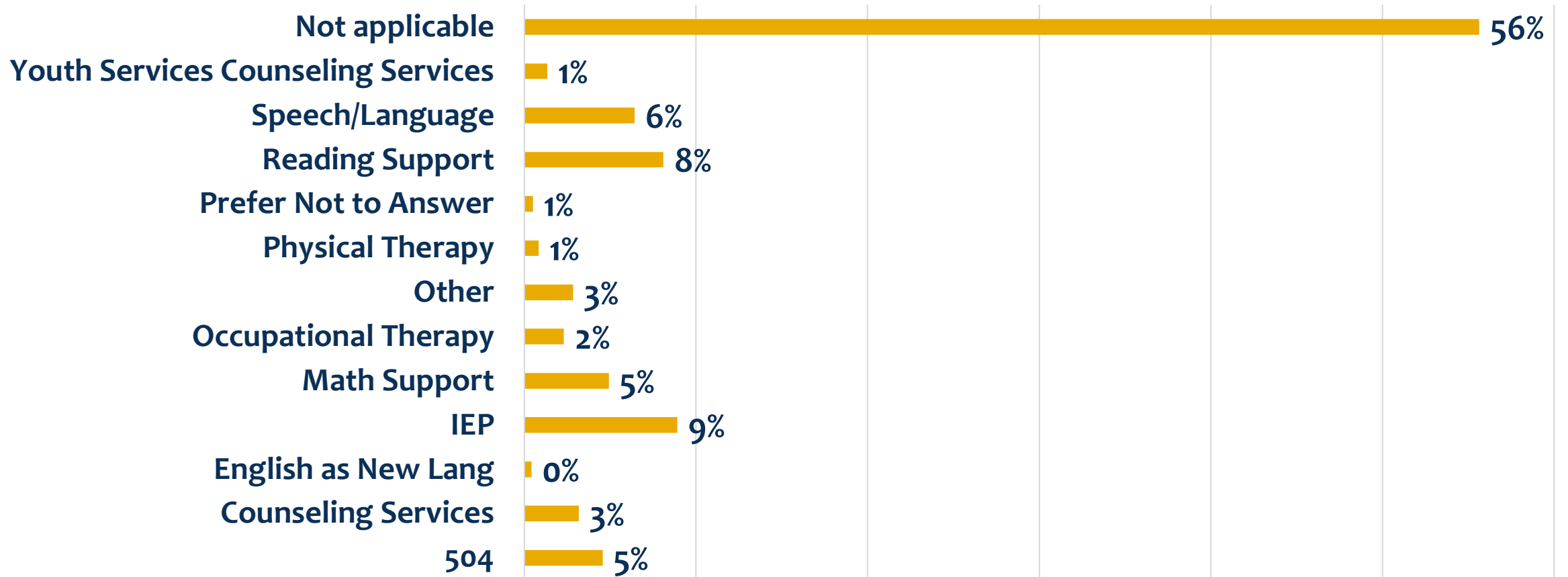

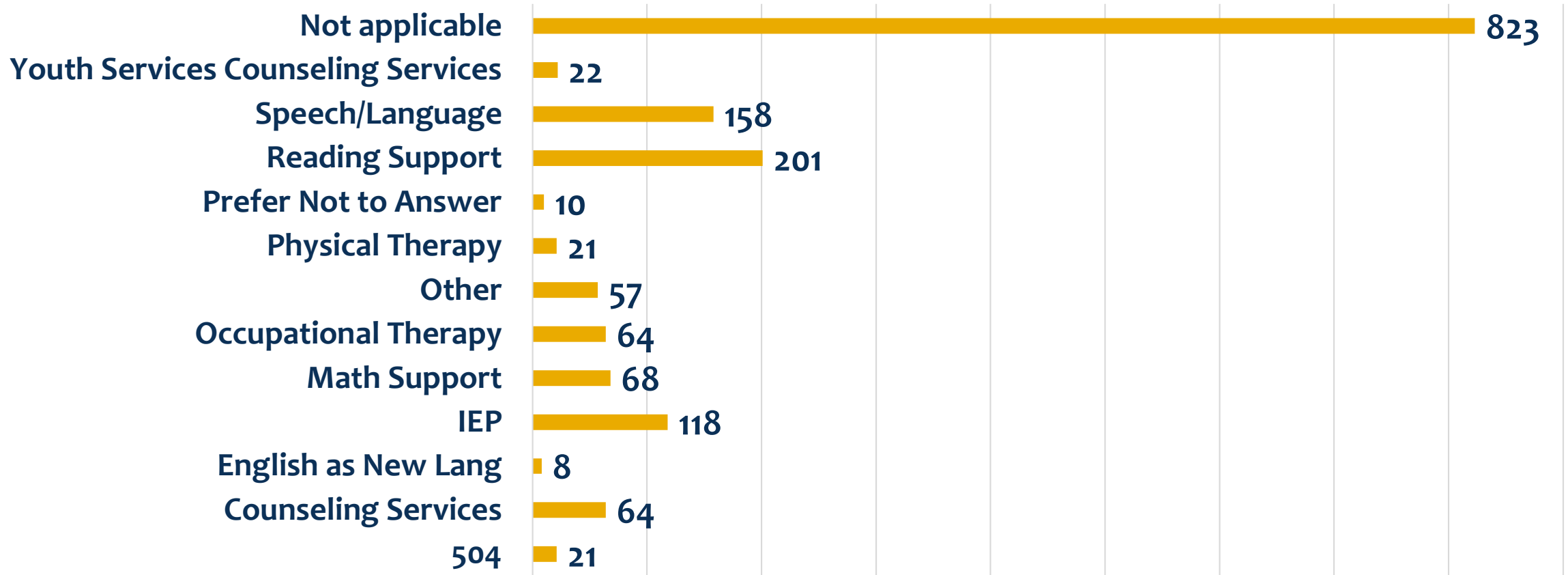

Overall Results - Percent of Responses Based on All Survey Responses



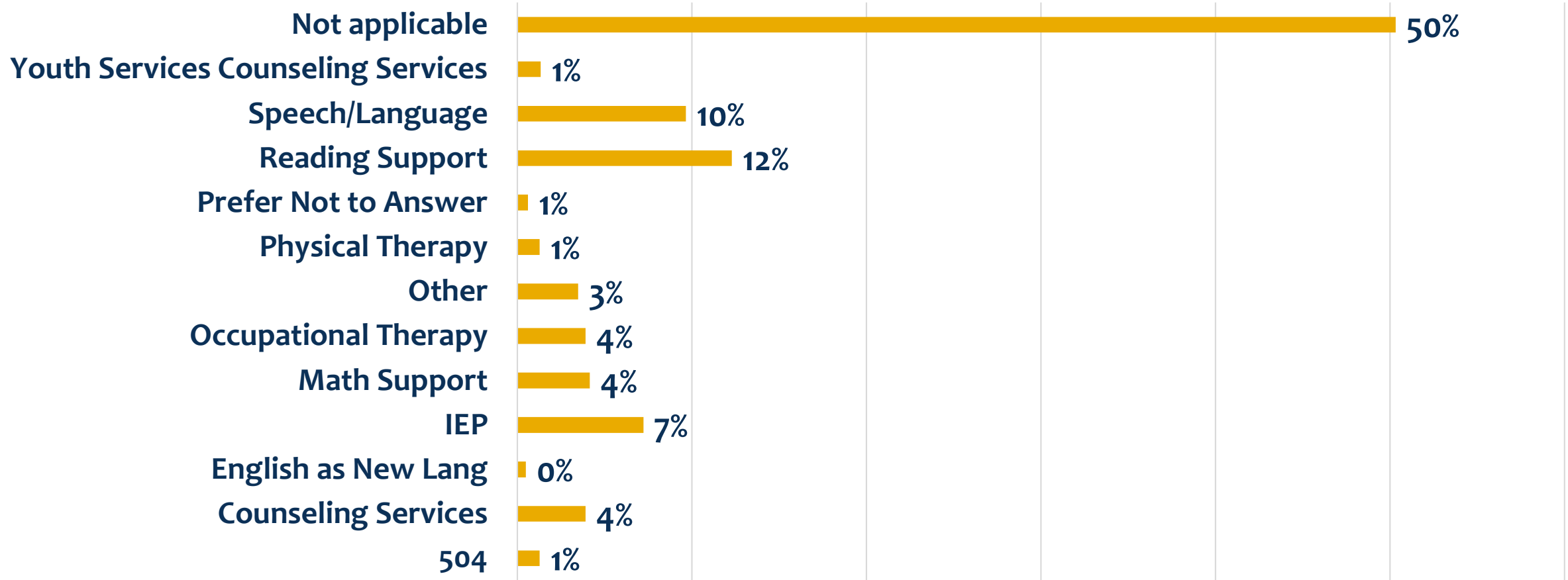

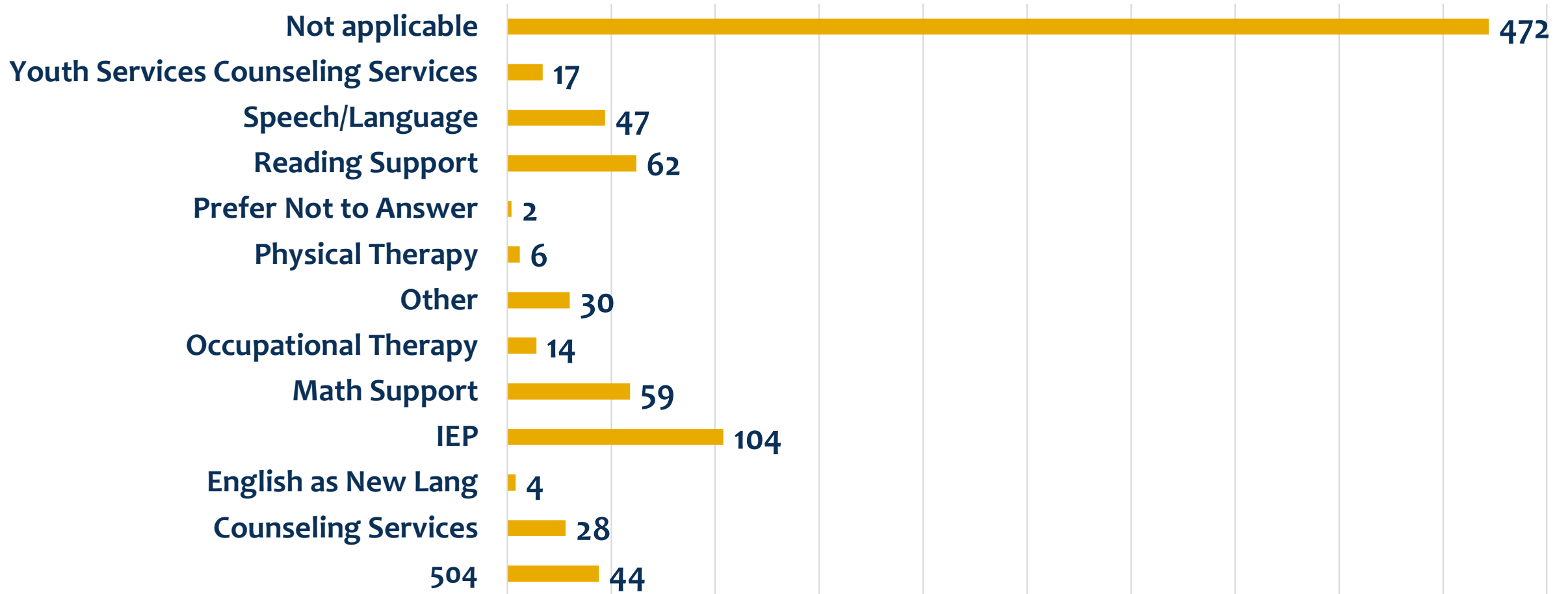

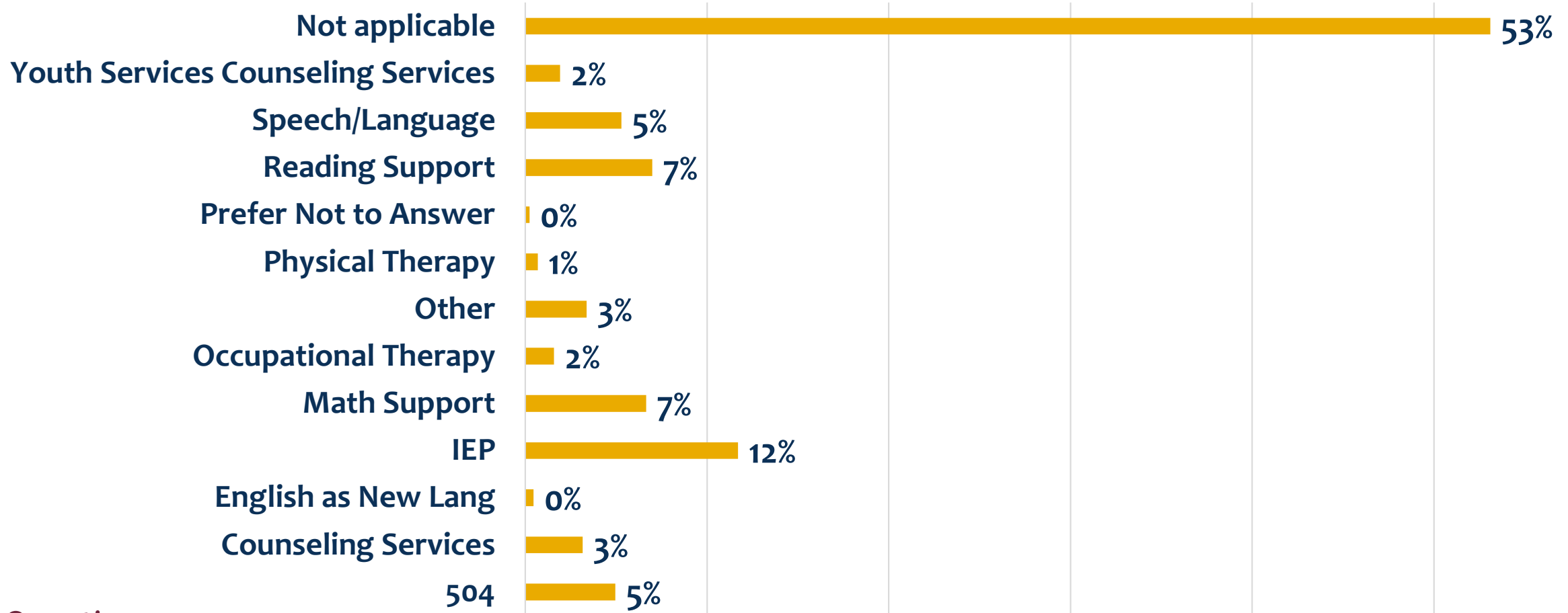

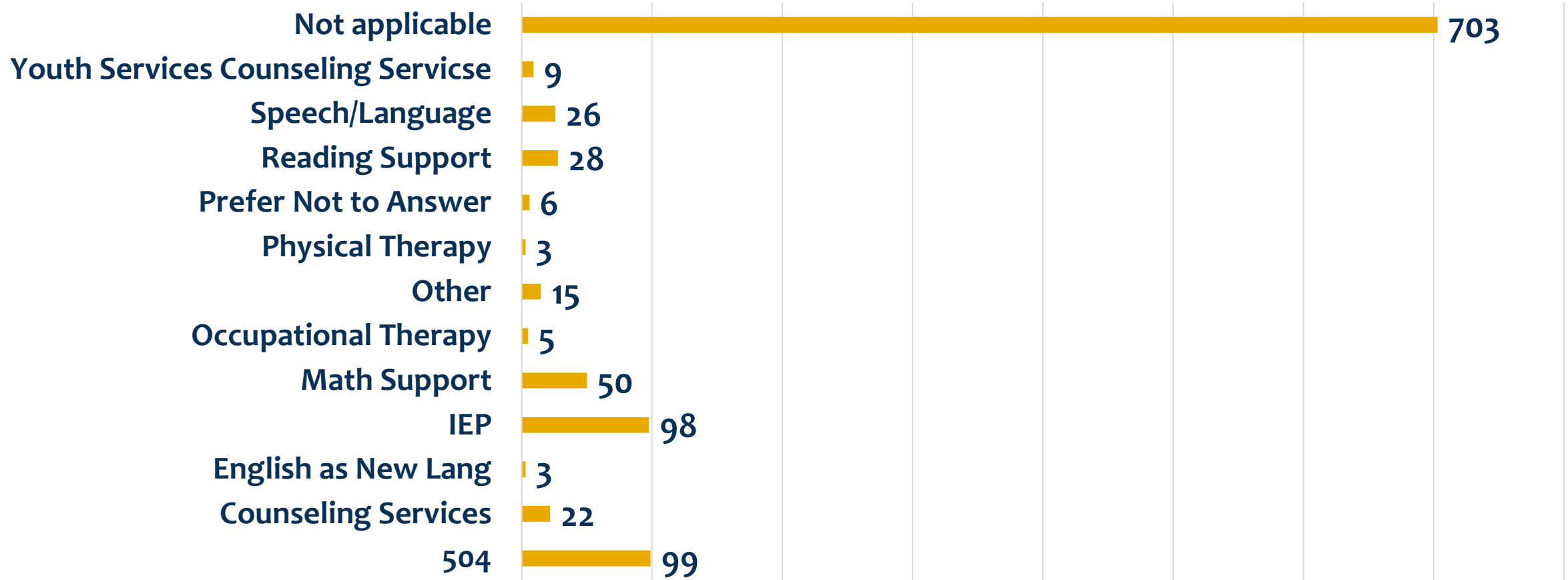

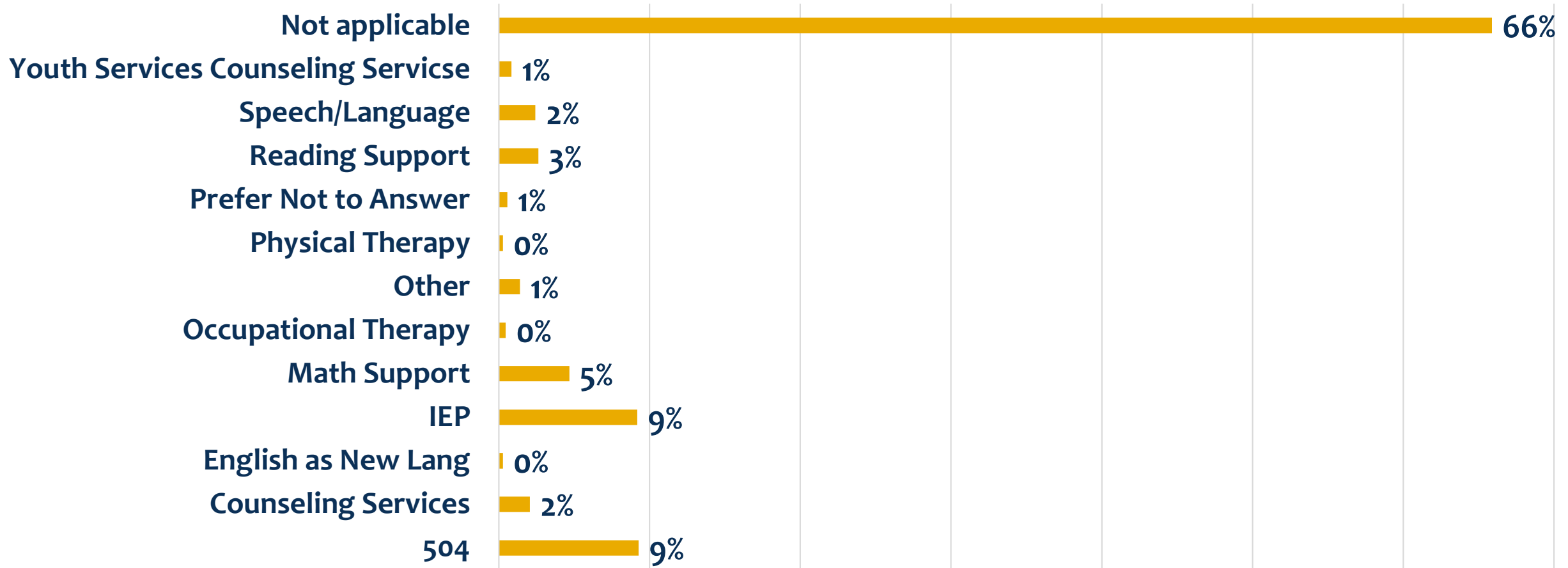

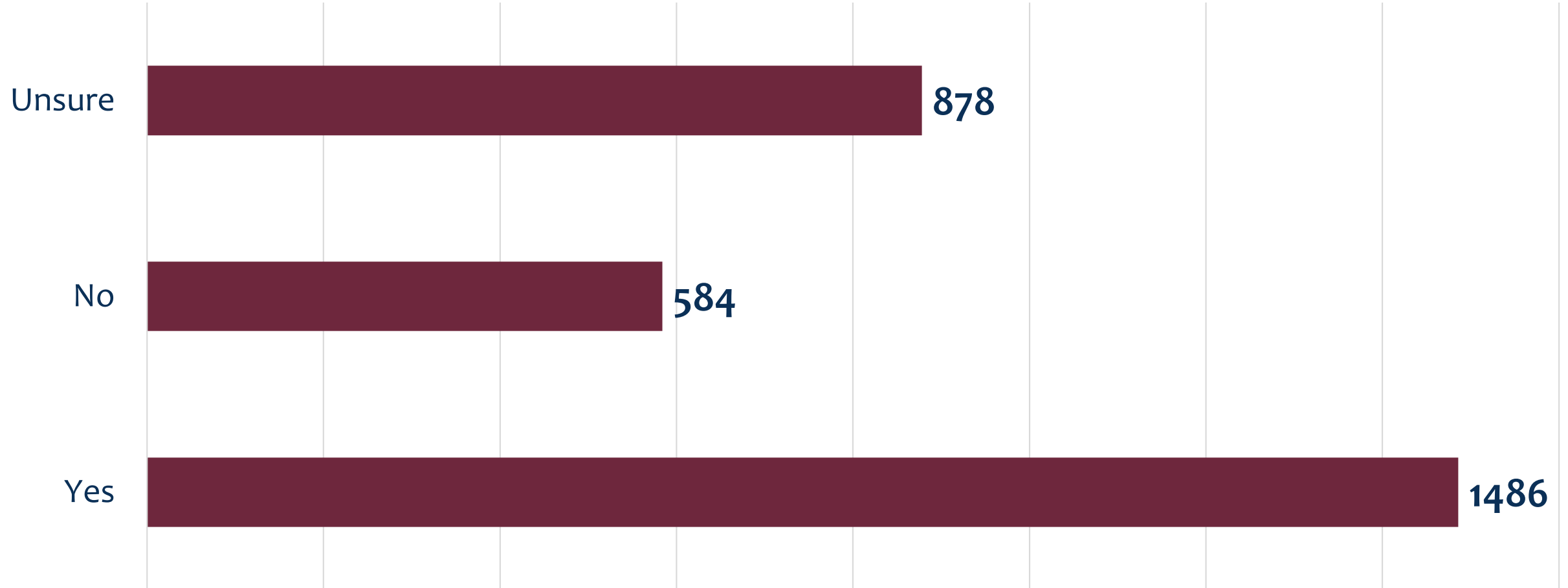

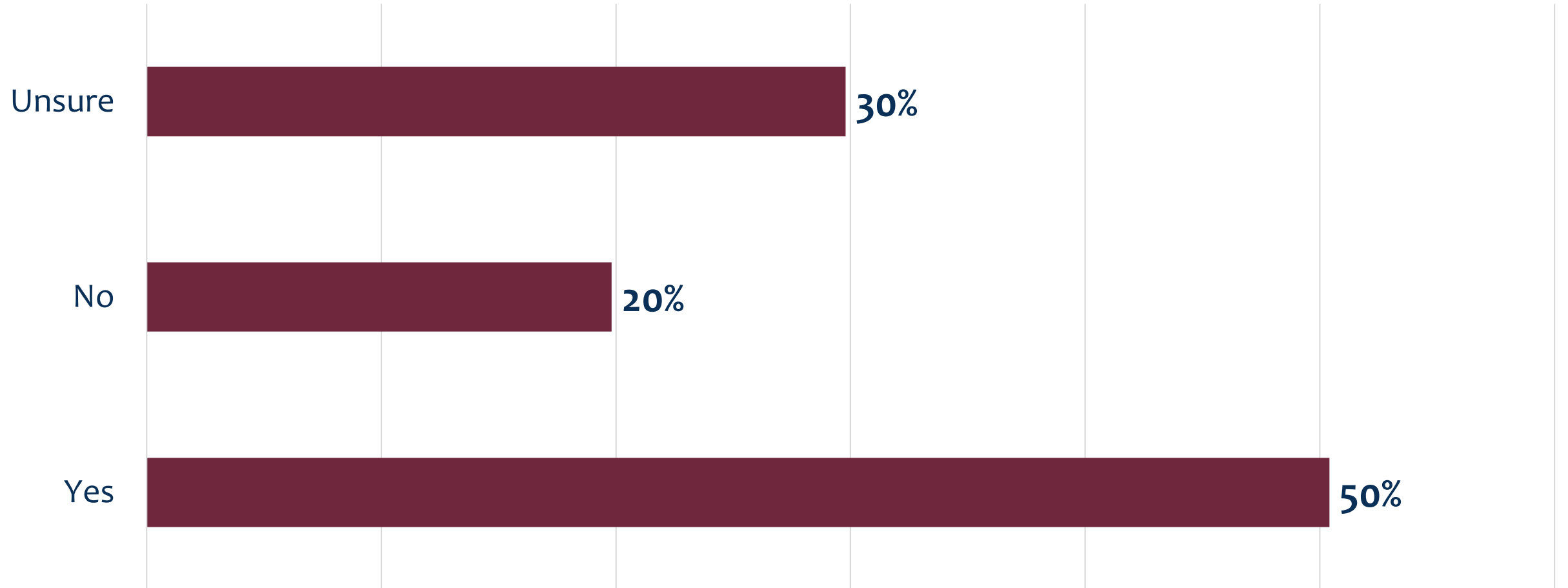

Overall Results - Number of Survey Responses



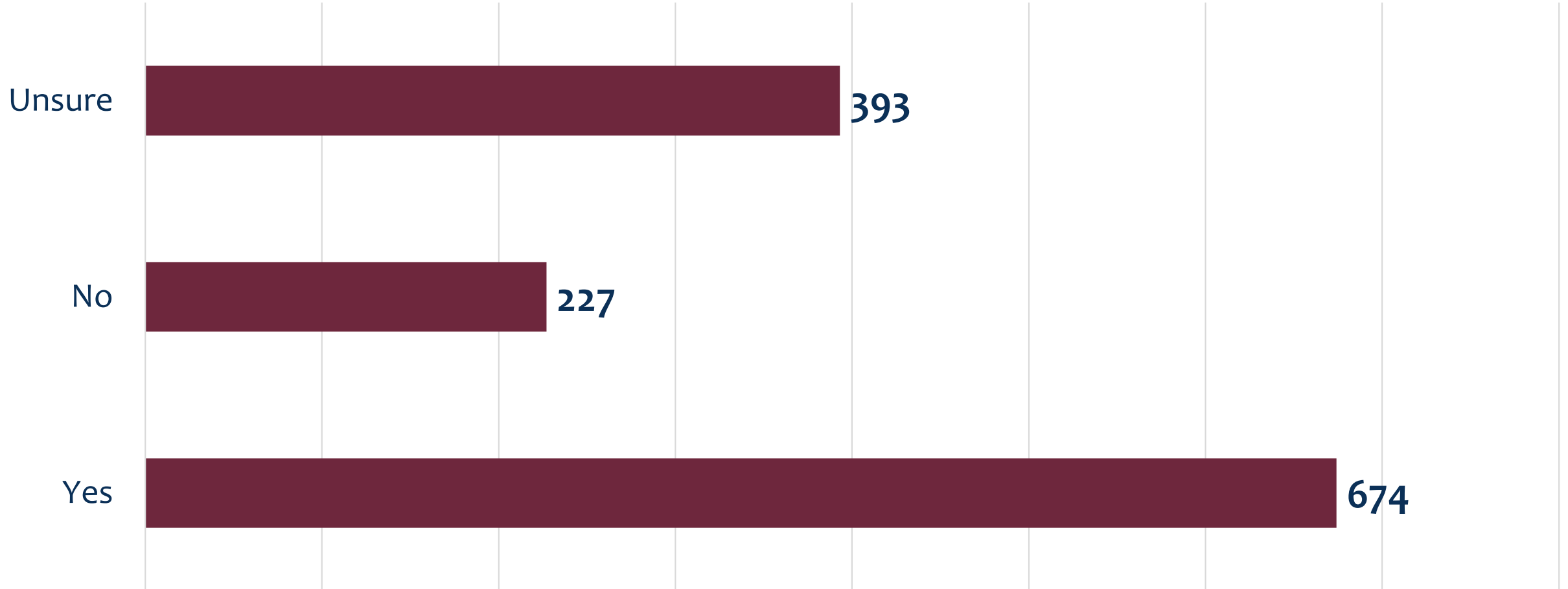

**Overall Results - Percent of Responses Based on All Survey Responses**



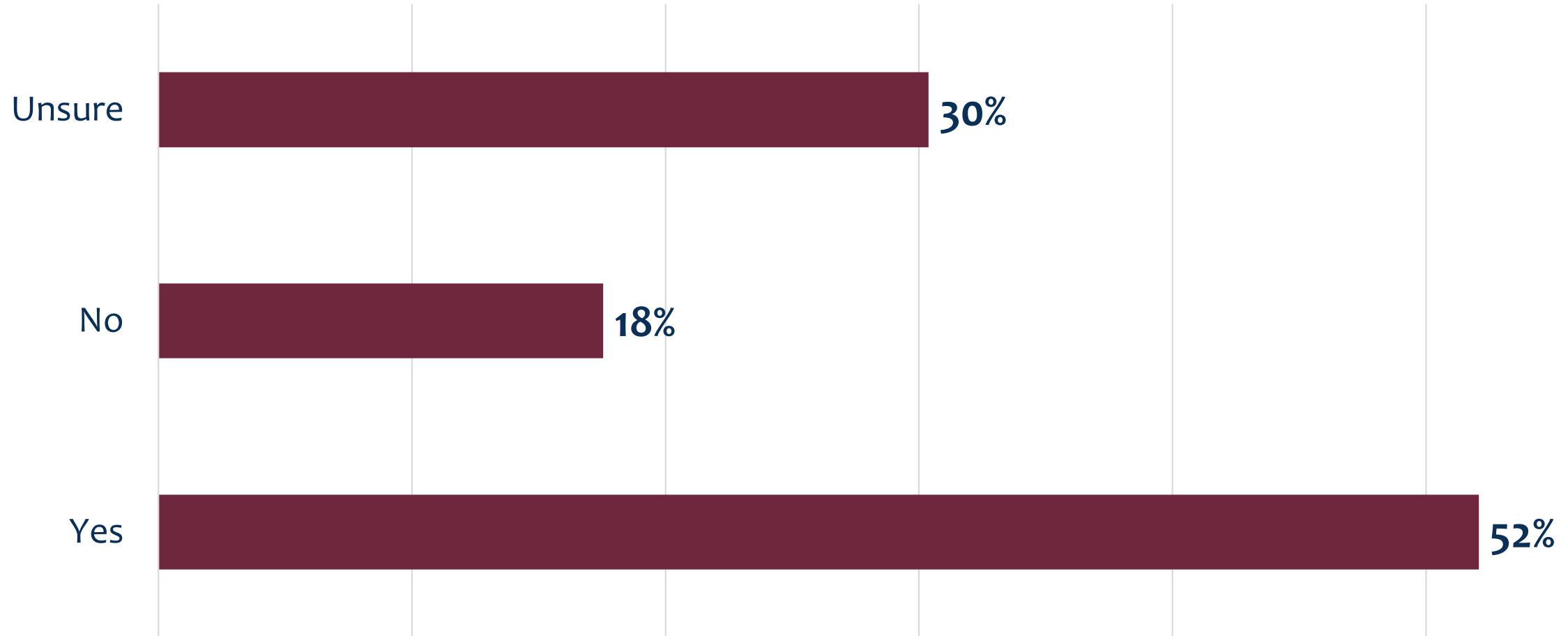

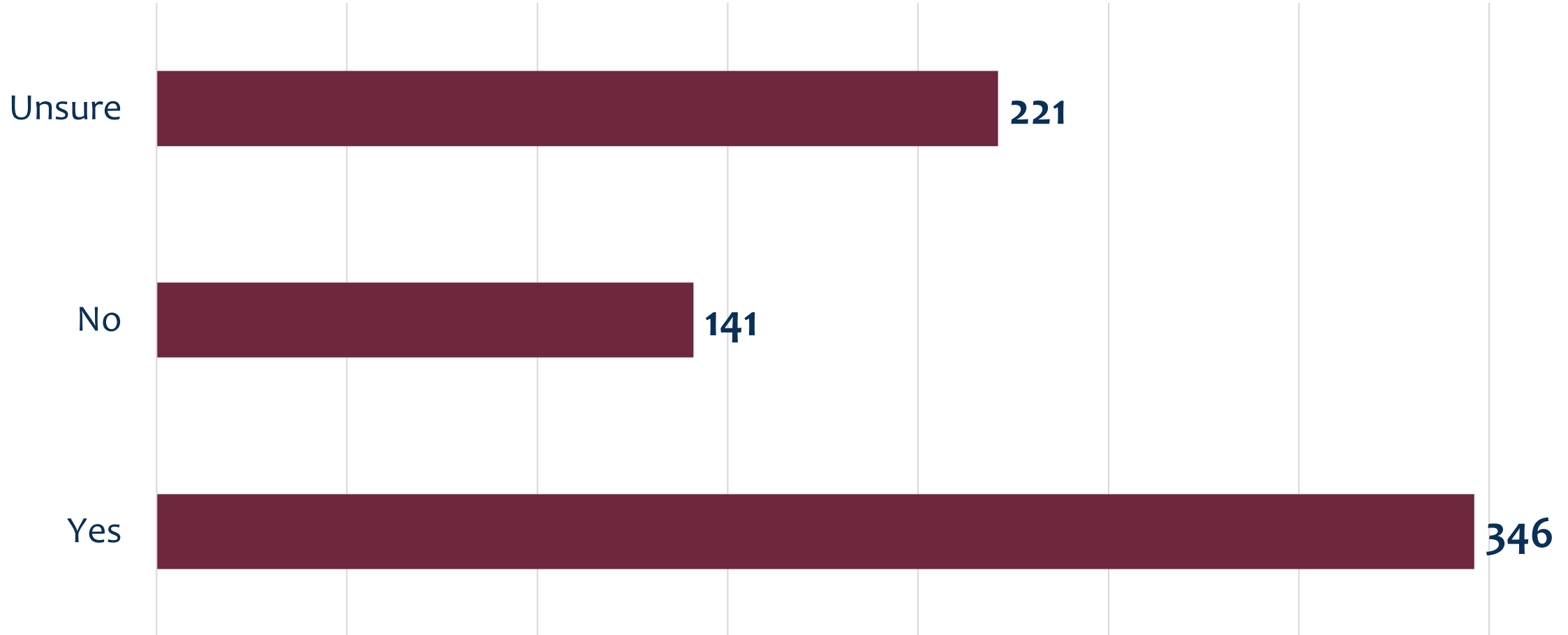

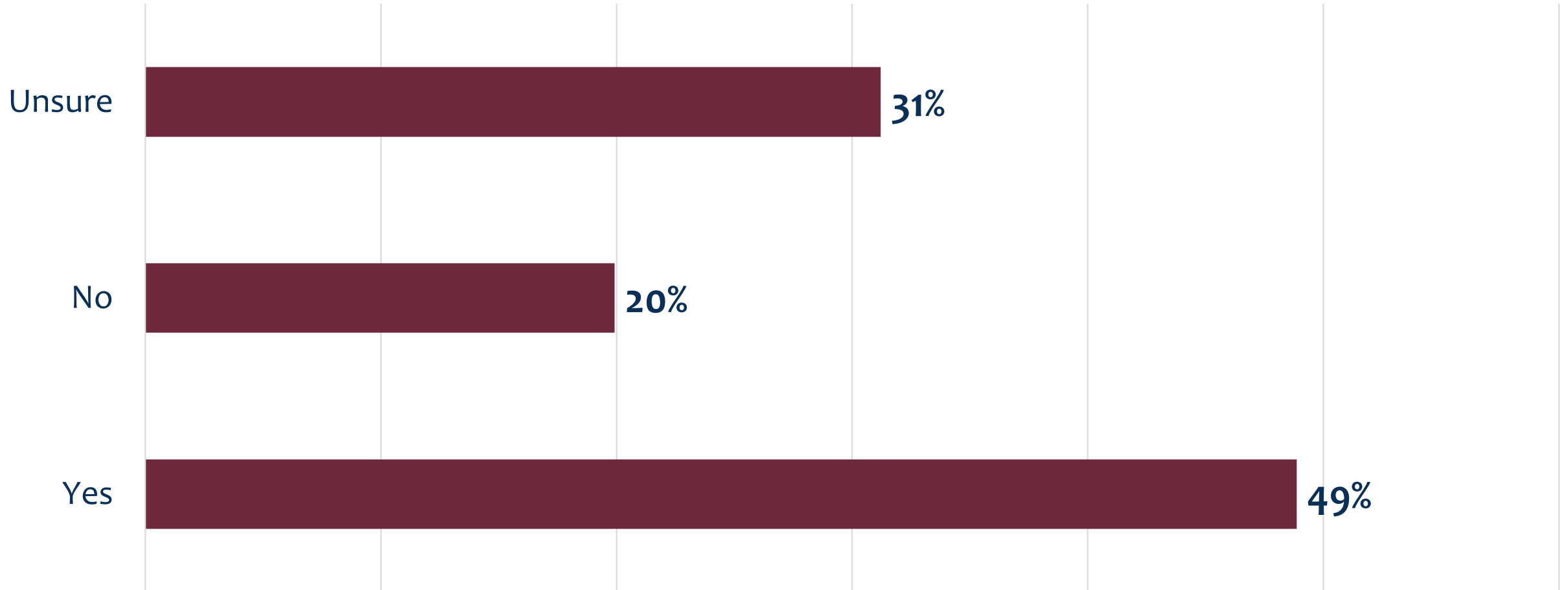

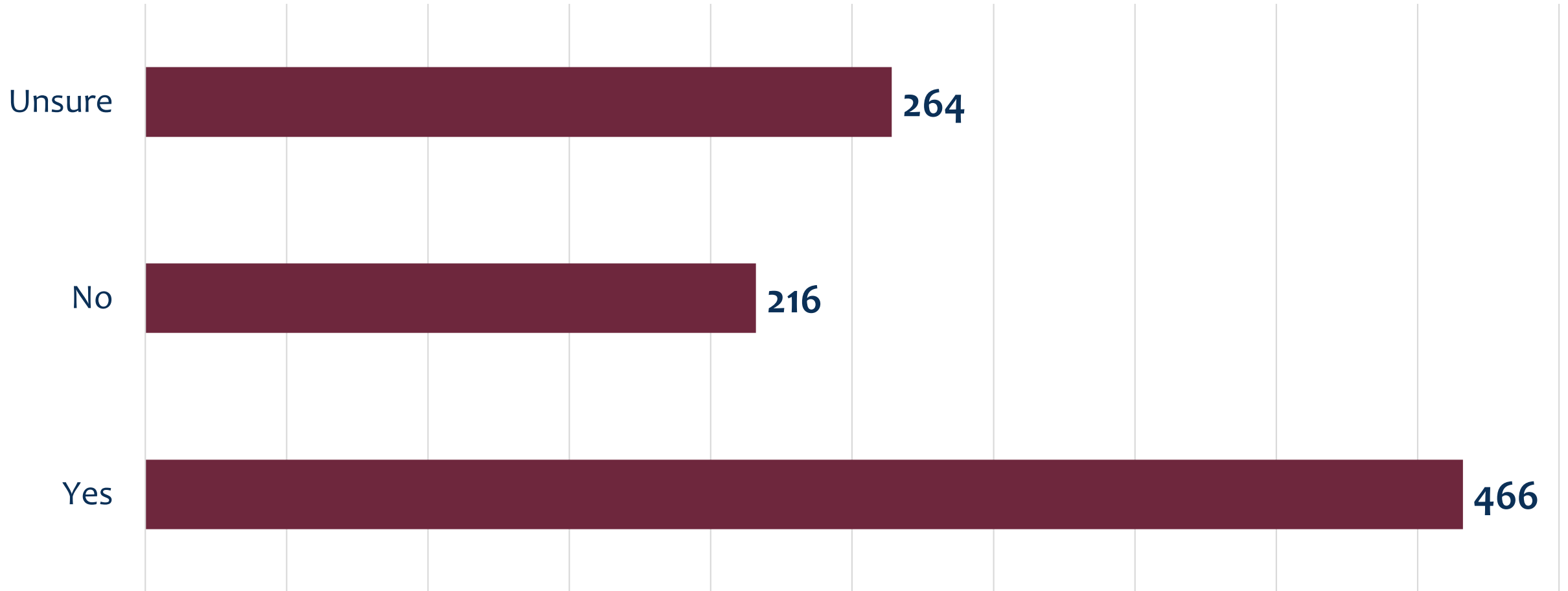

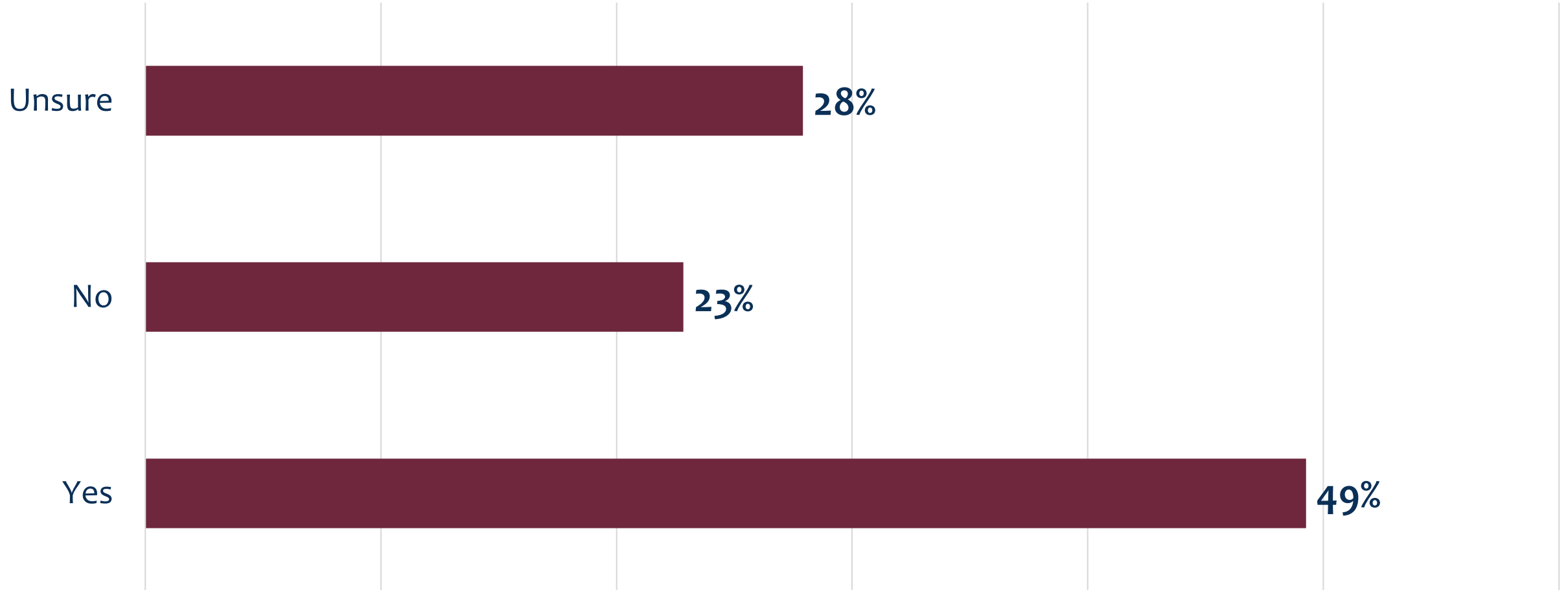

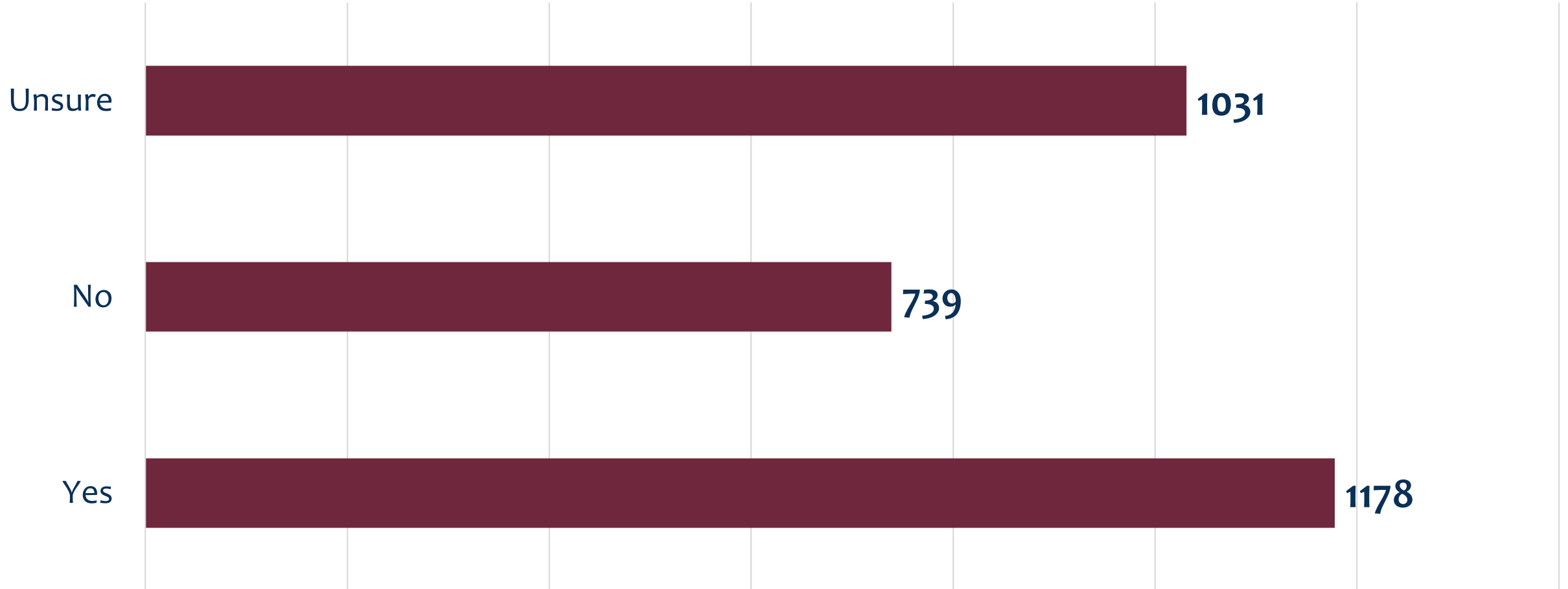

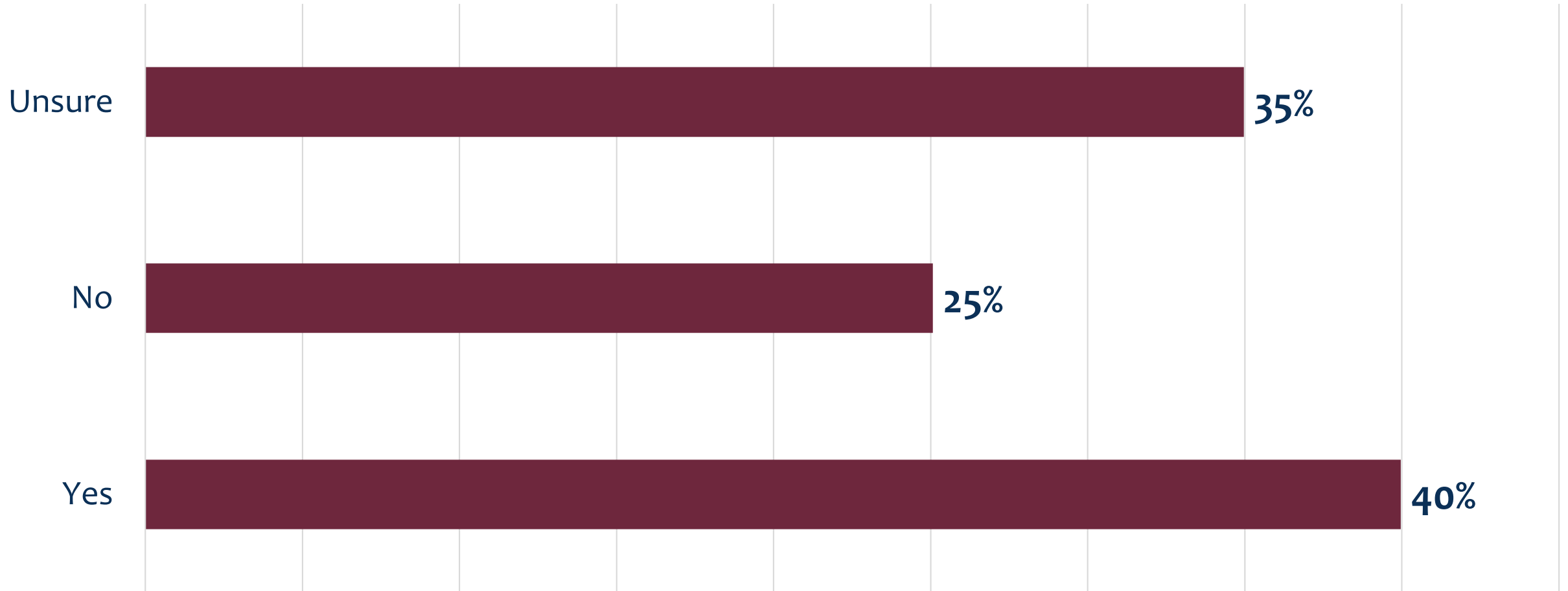

## Overall Results - Number of Survey Responses



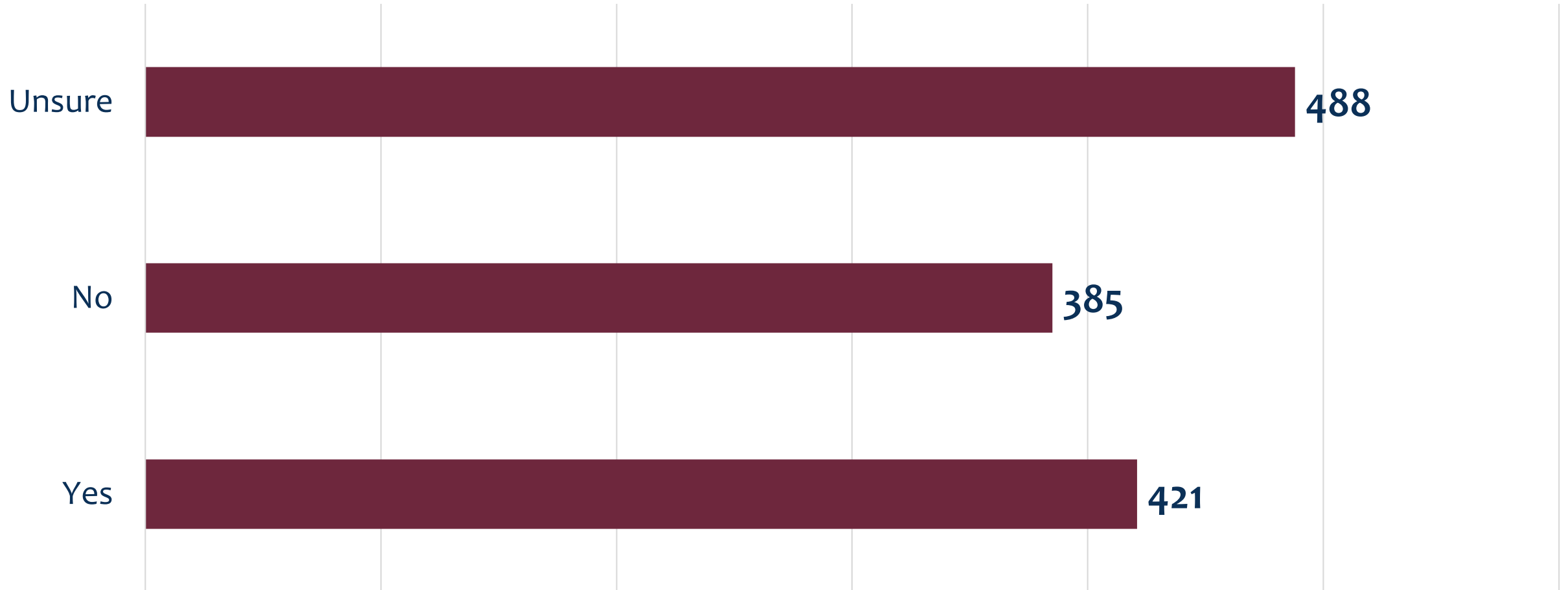

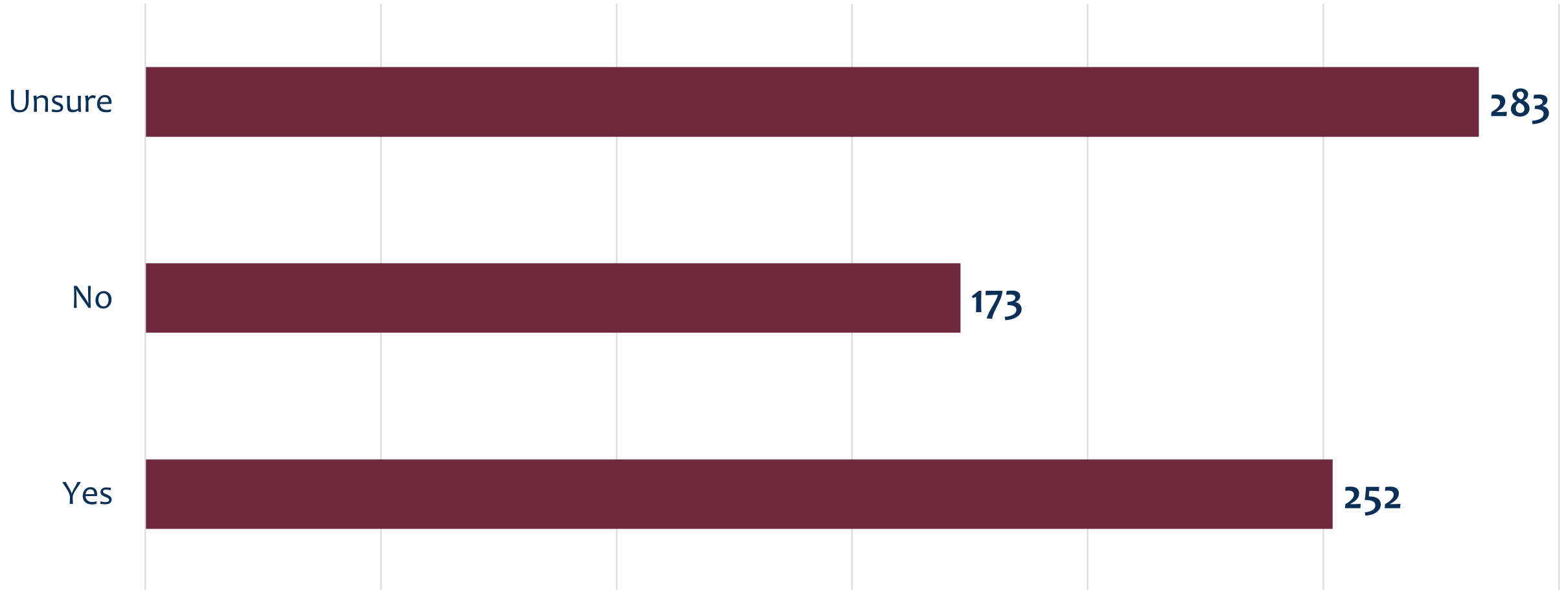

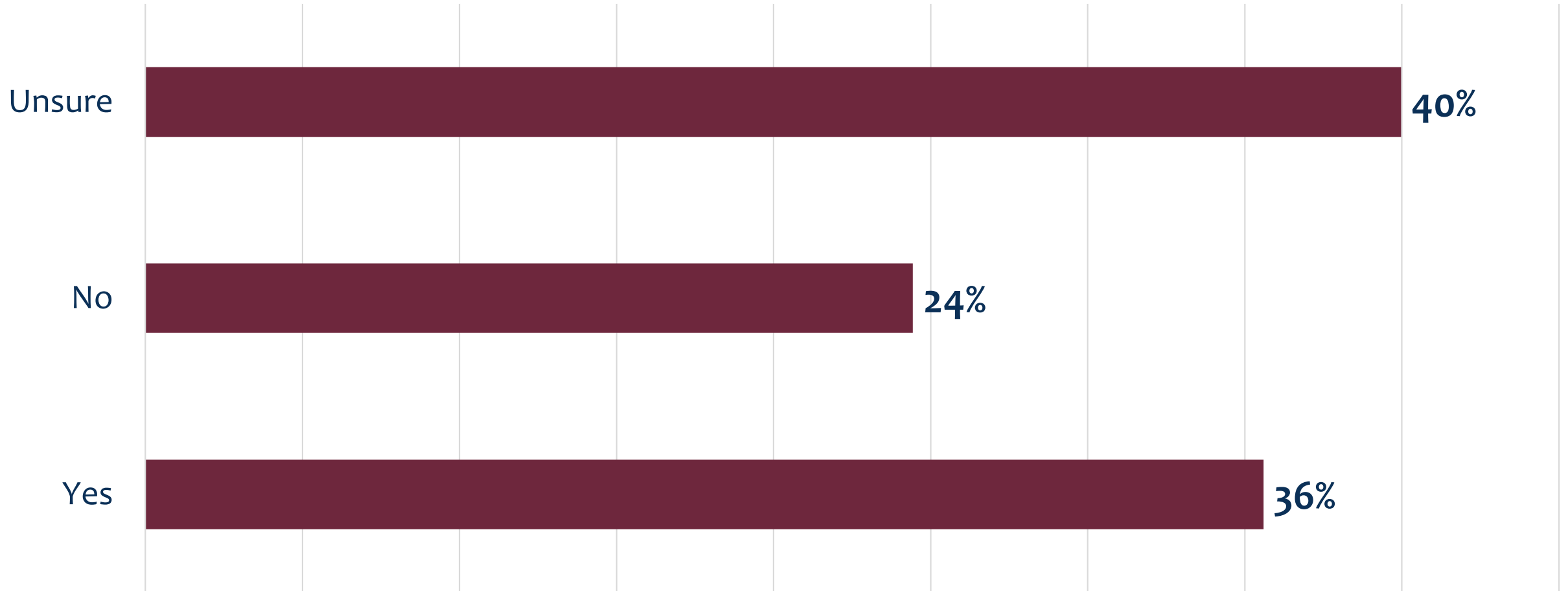

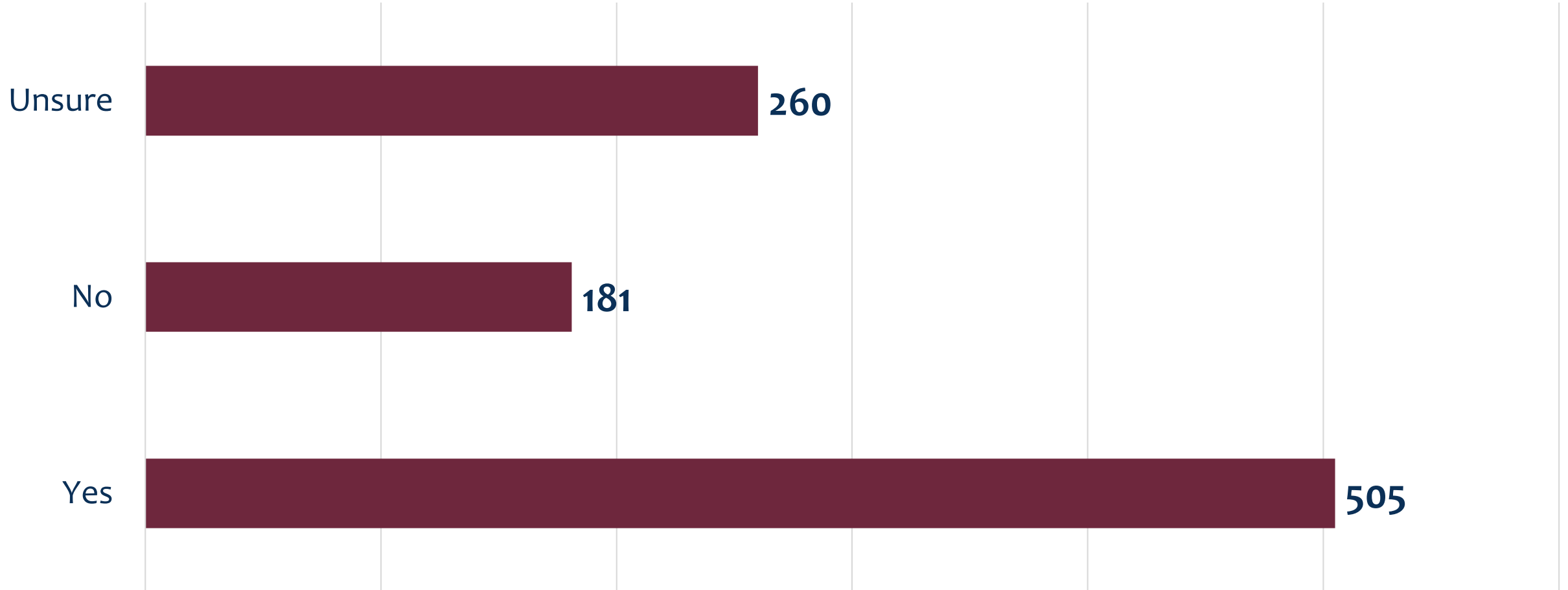

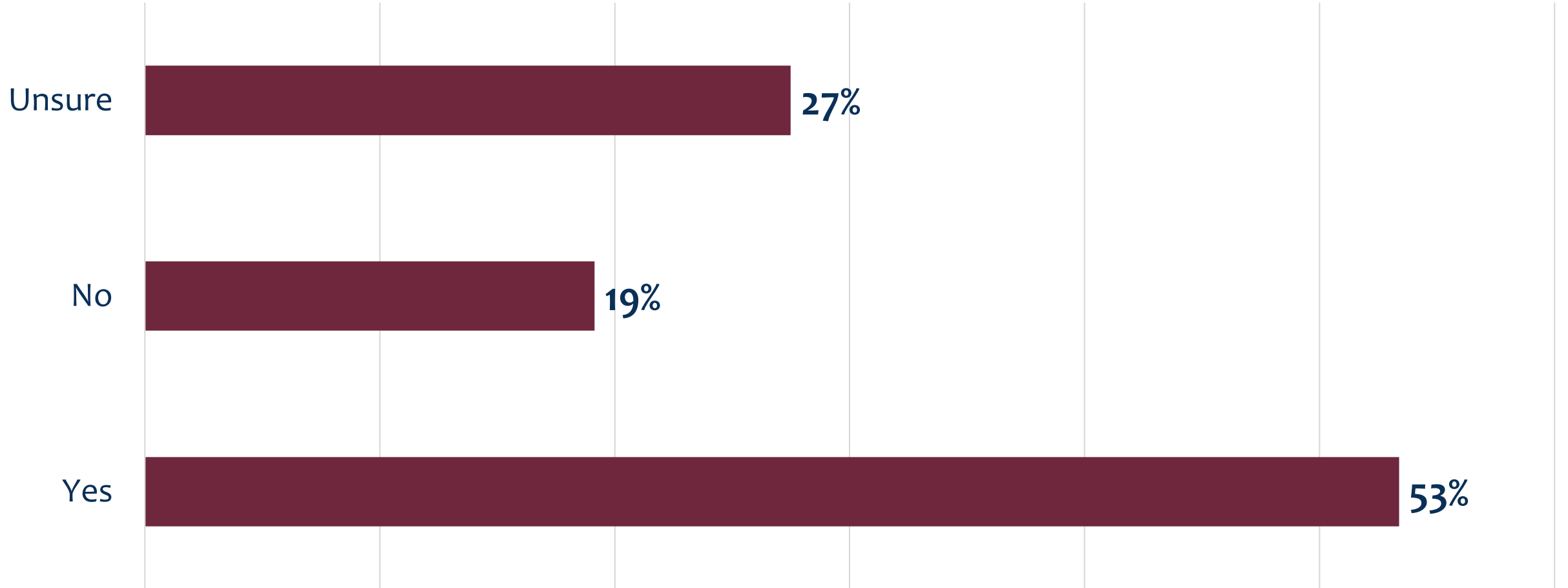

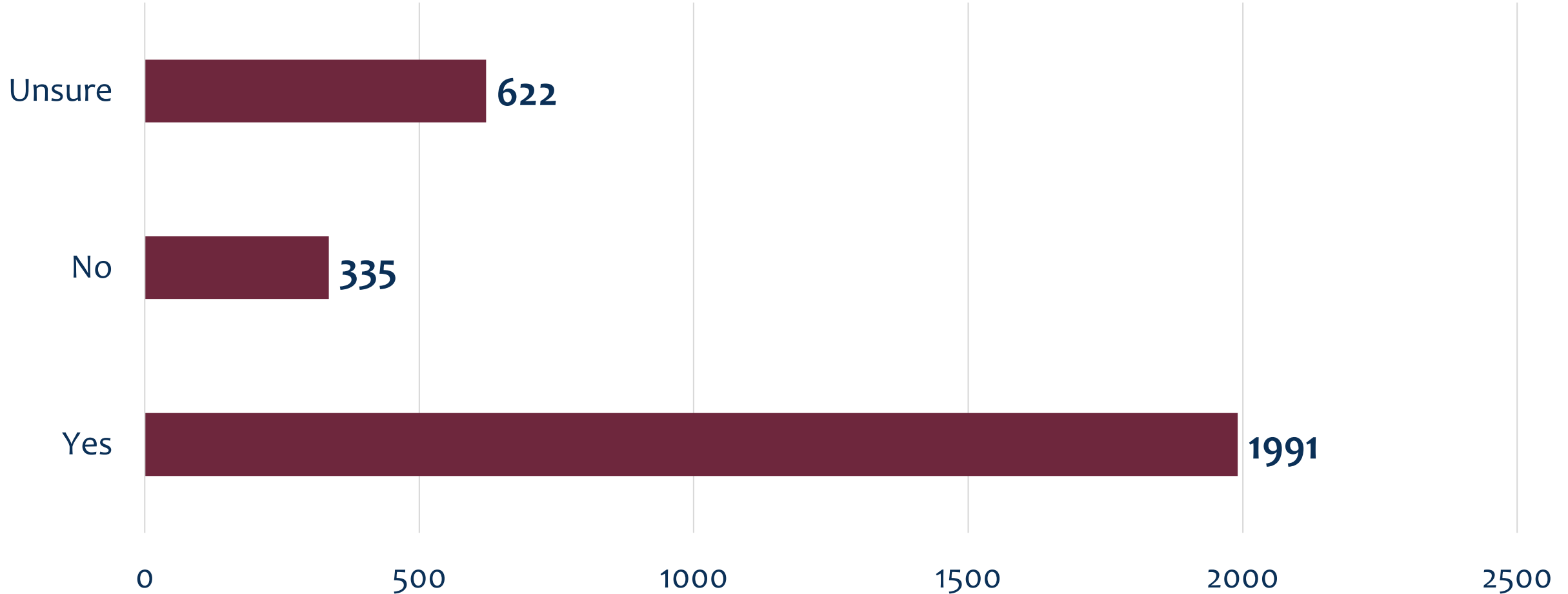

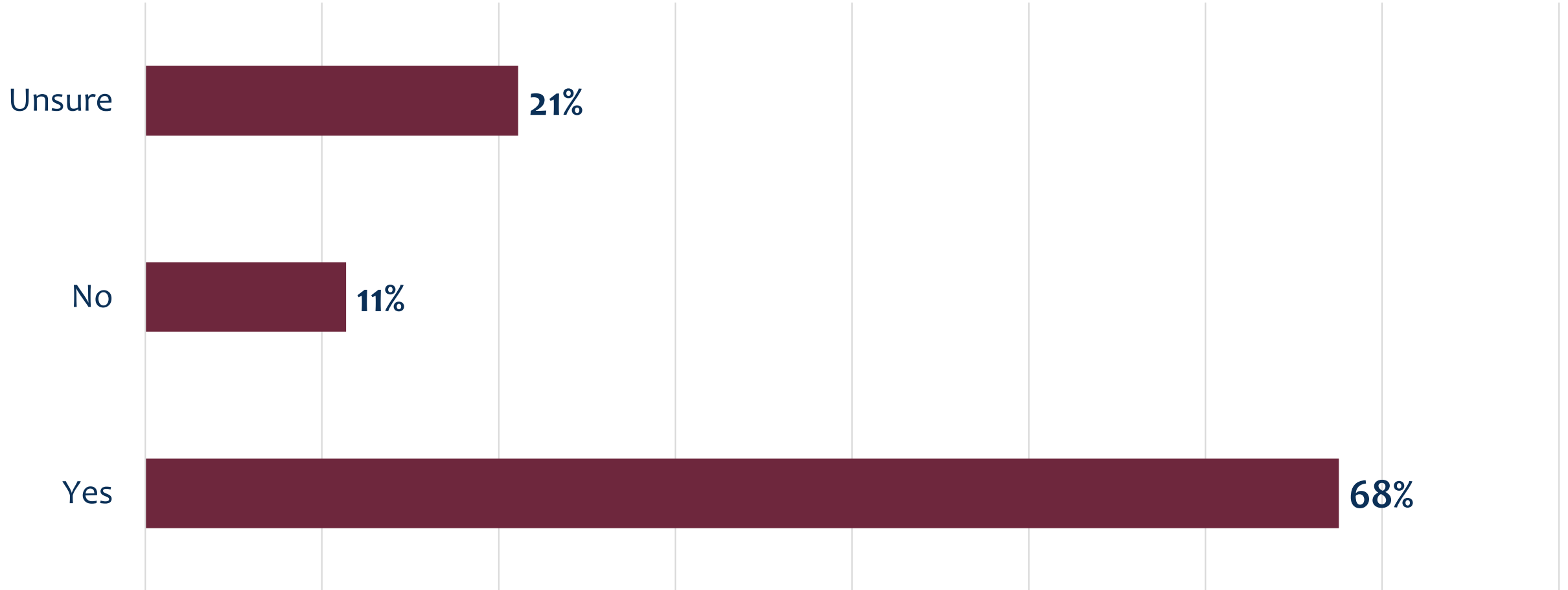

## Overall Results - Number of Survey Responses



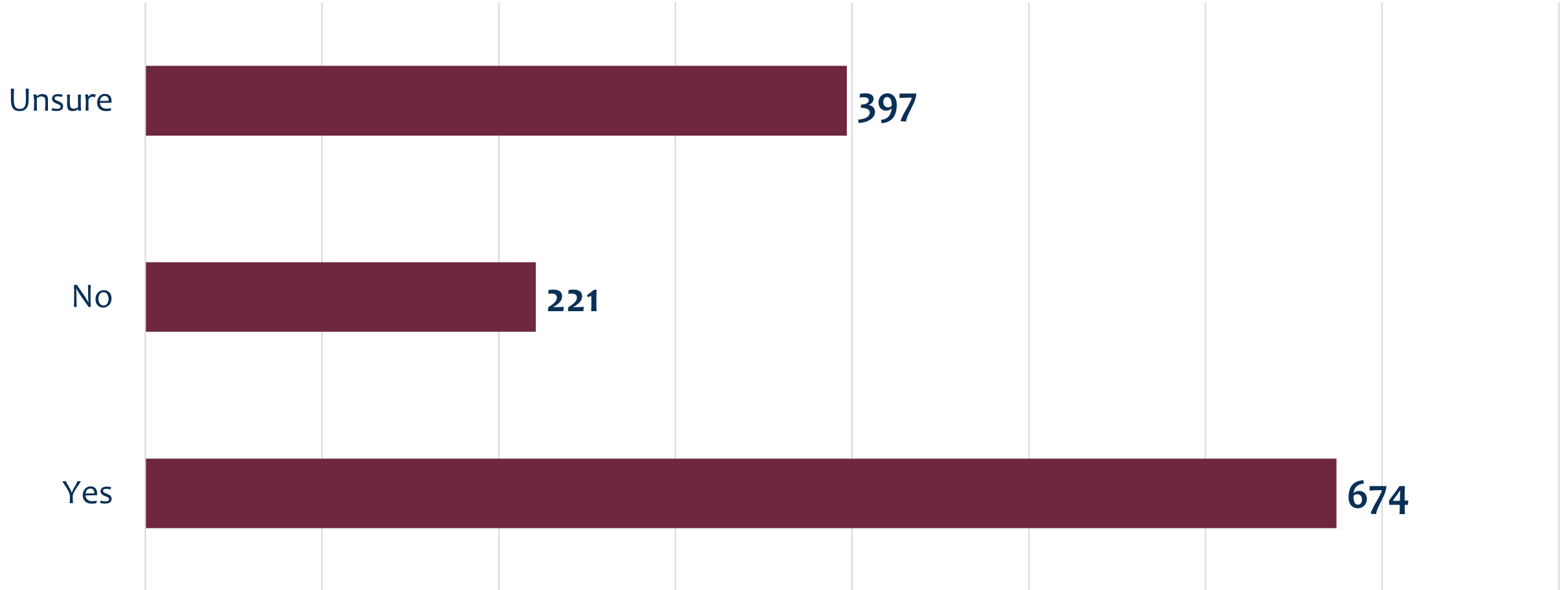

Overall Results – Percent of Survey Responses



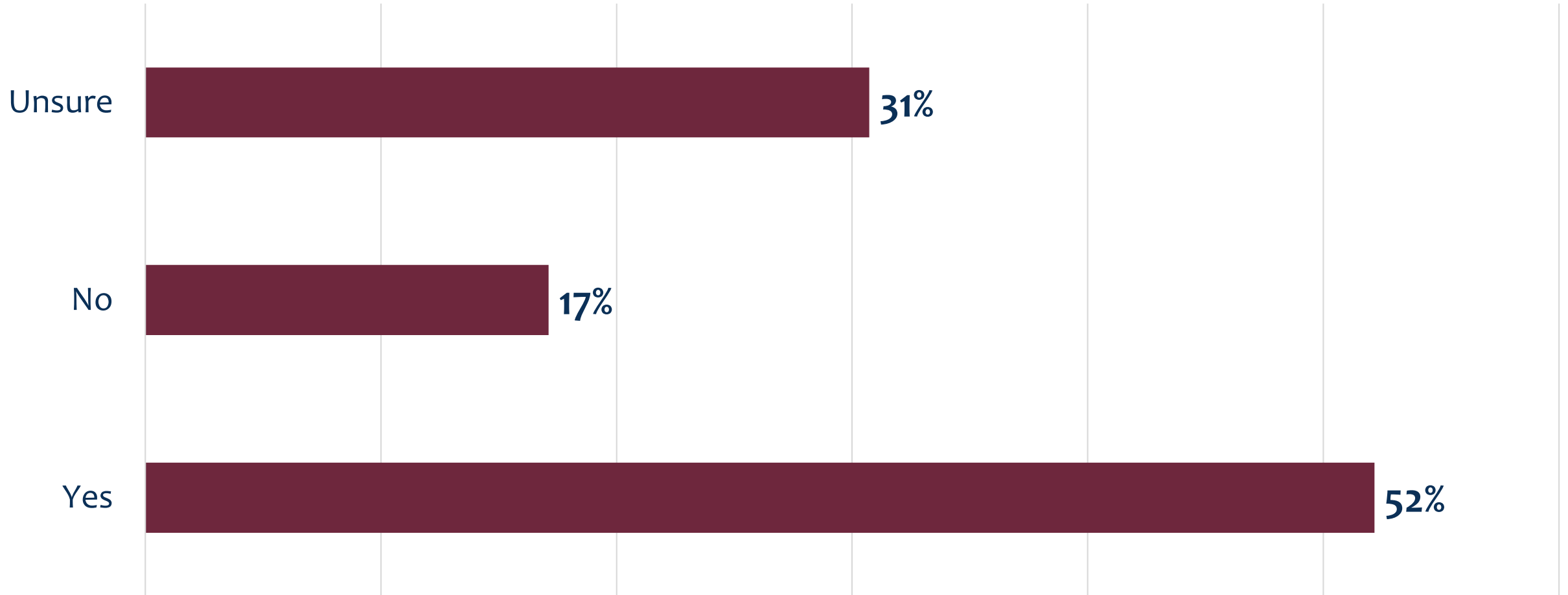

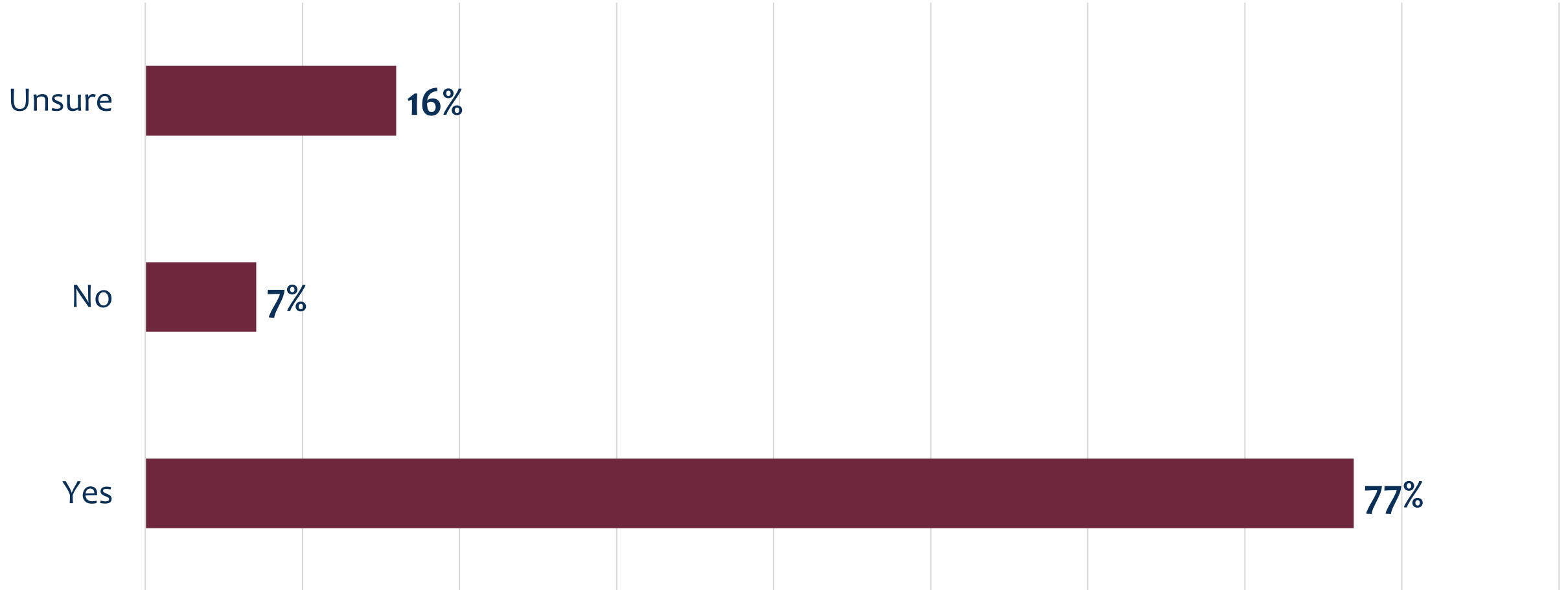

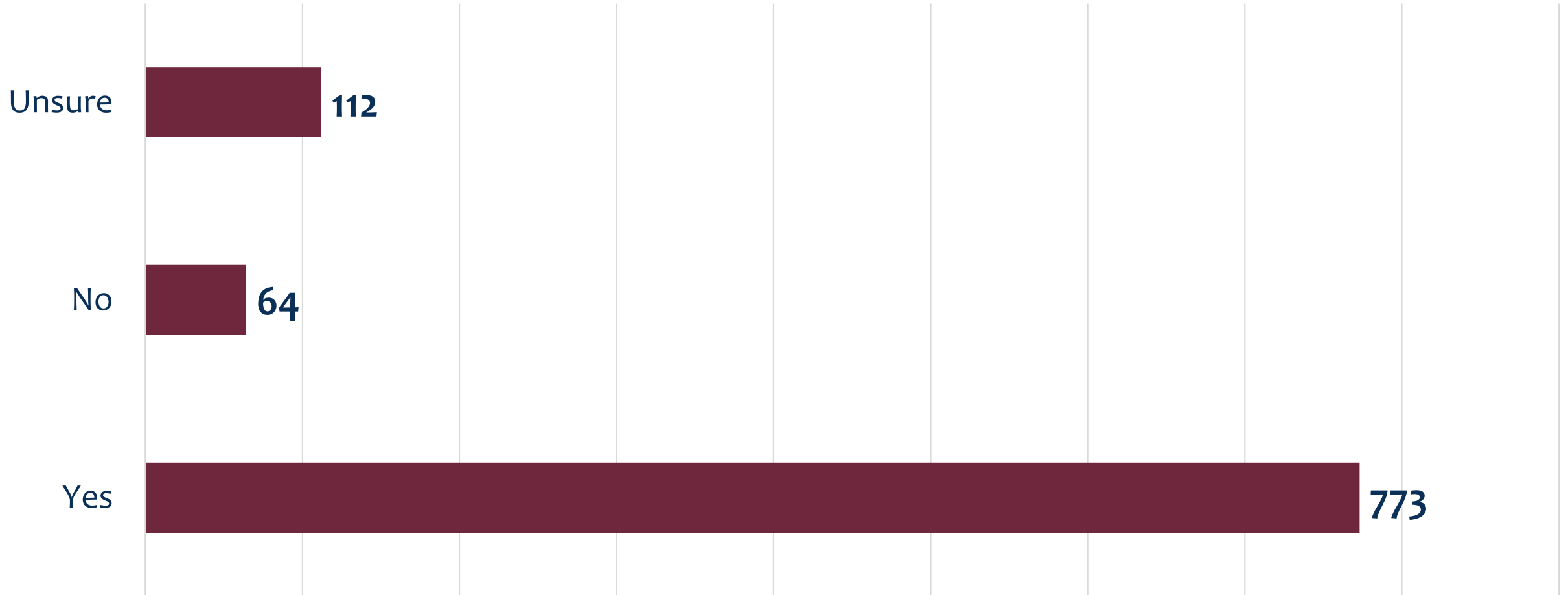

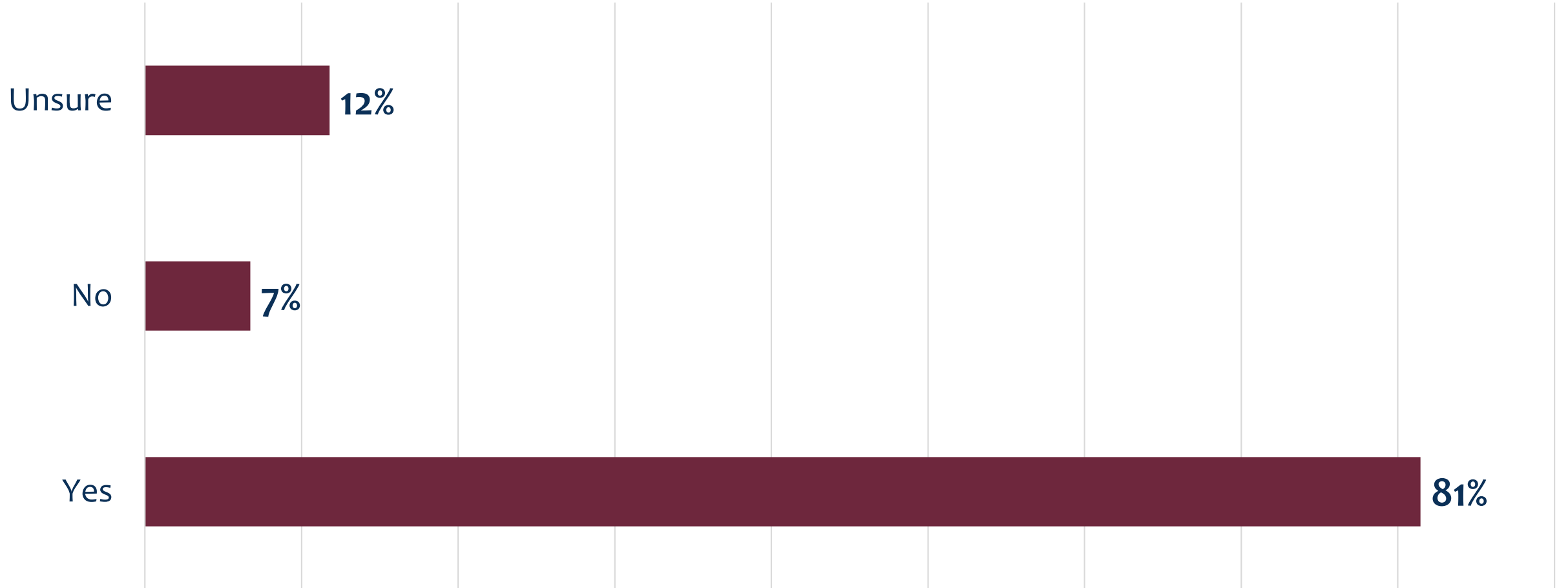

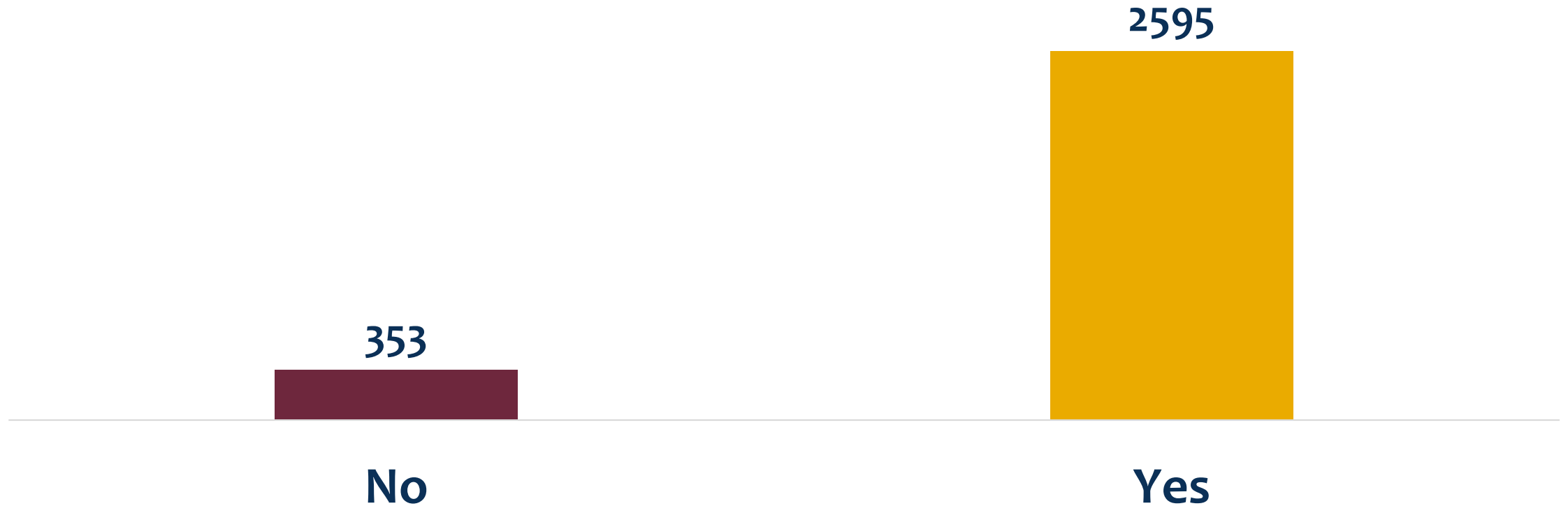

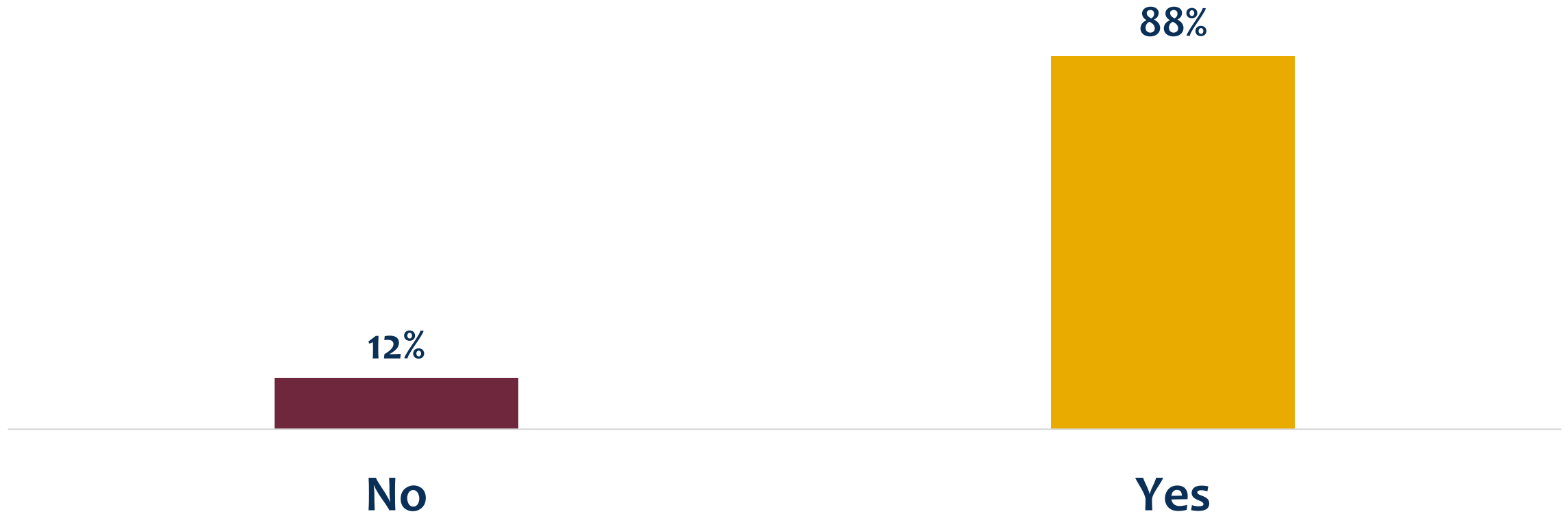

Overall Results - Number of Survey Responses



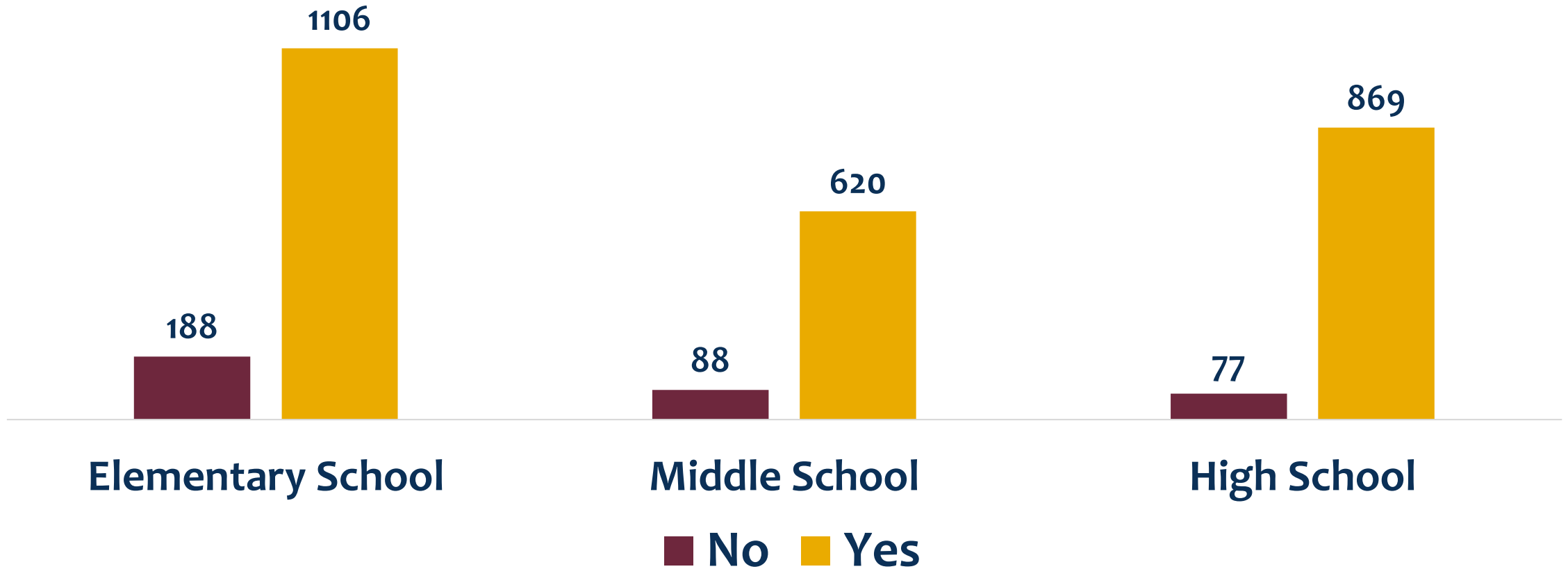

Overall Results – Percent of Survey Responses



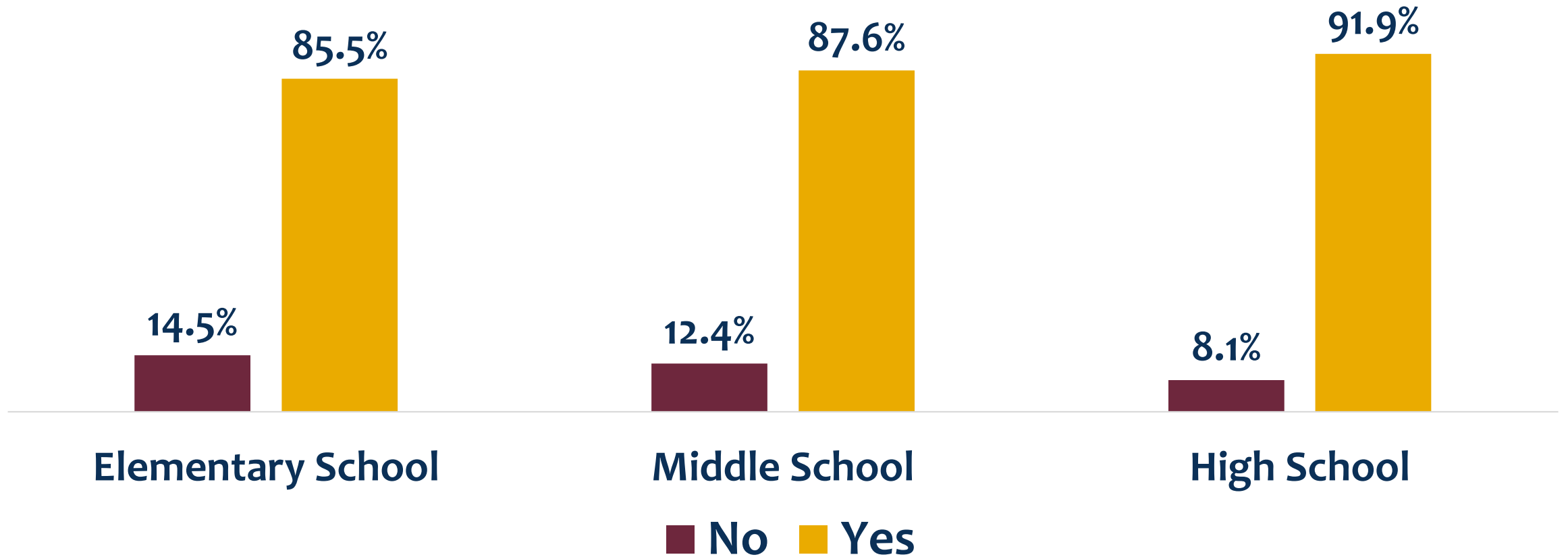

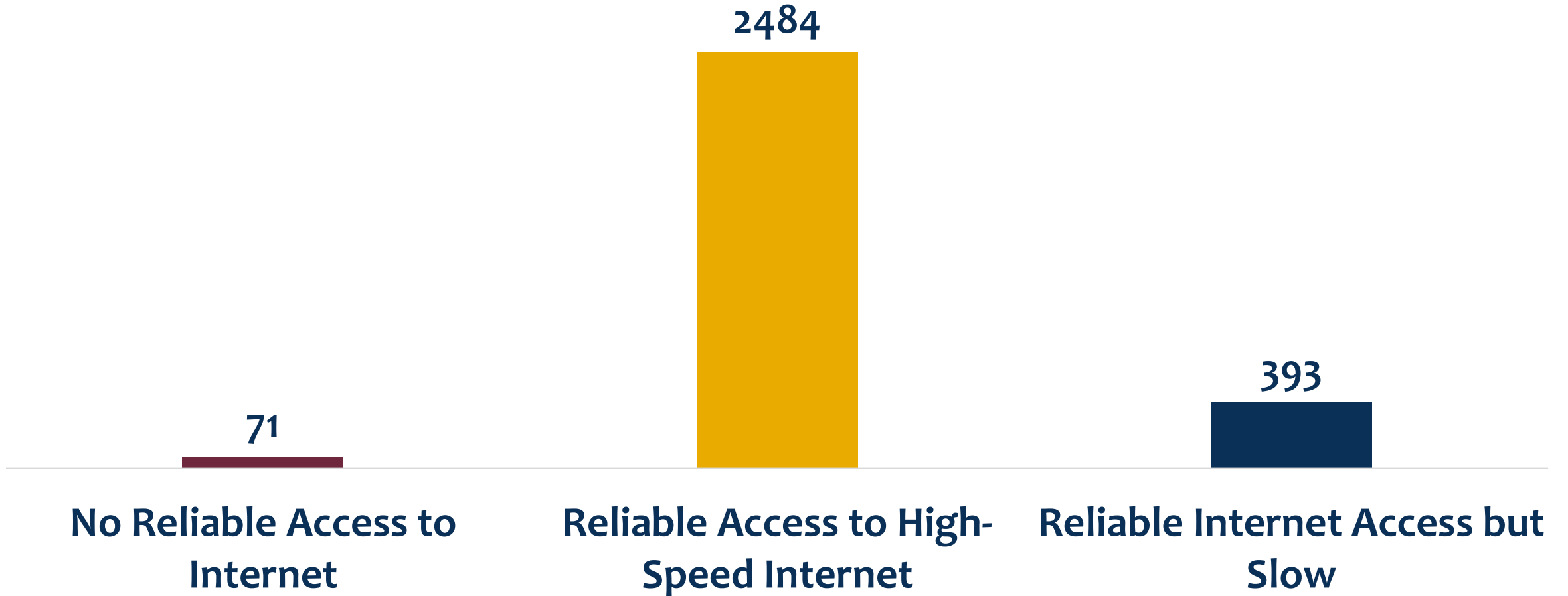

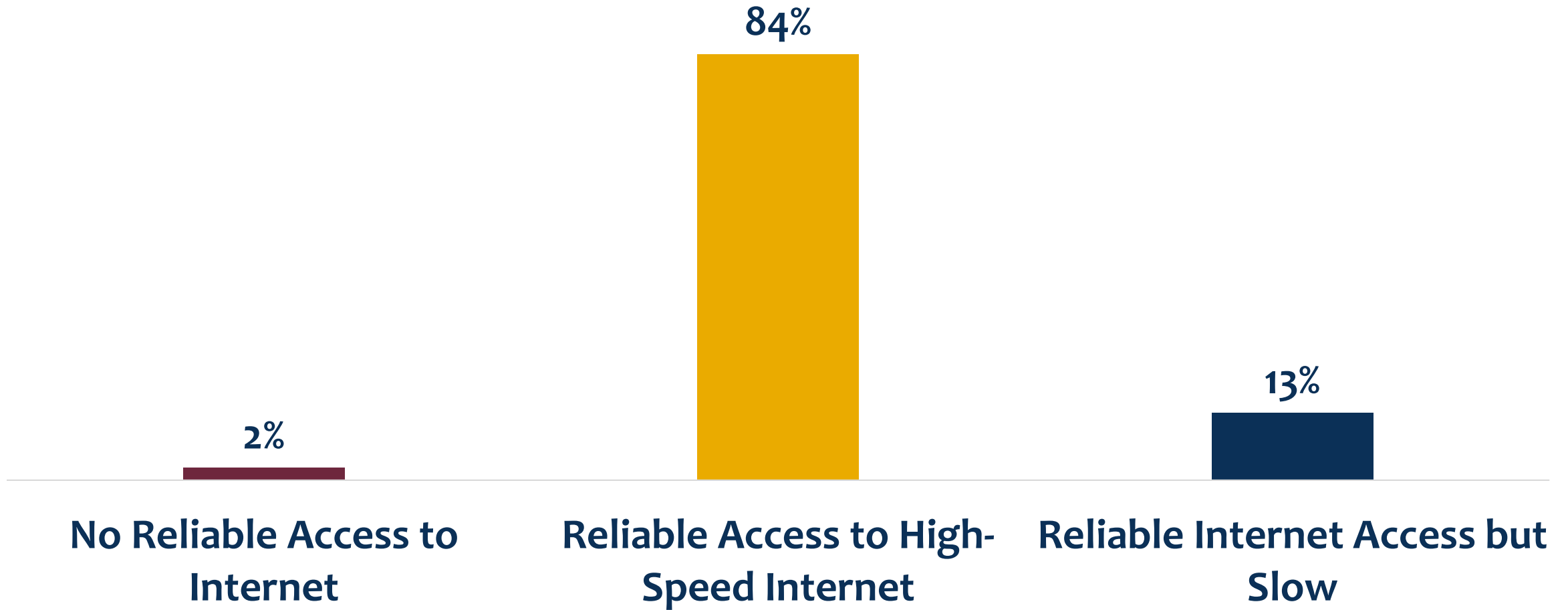

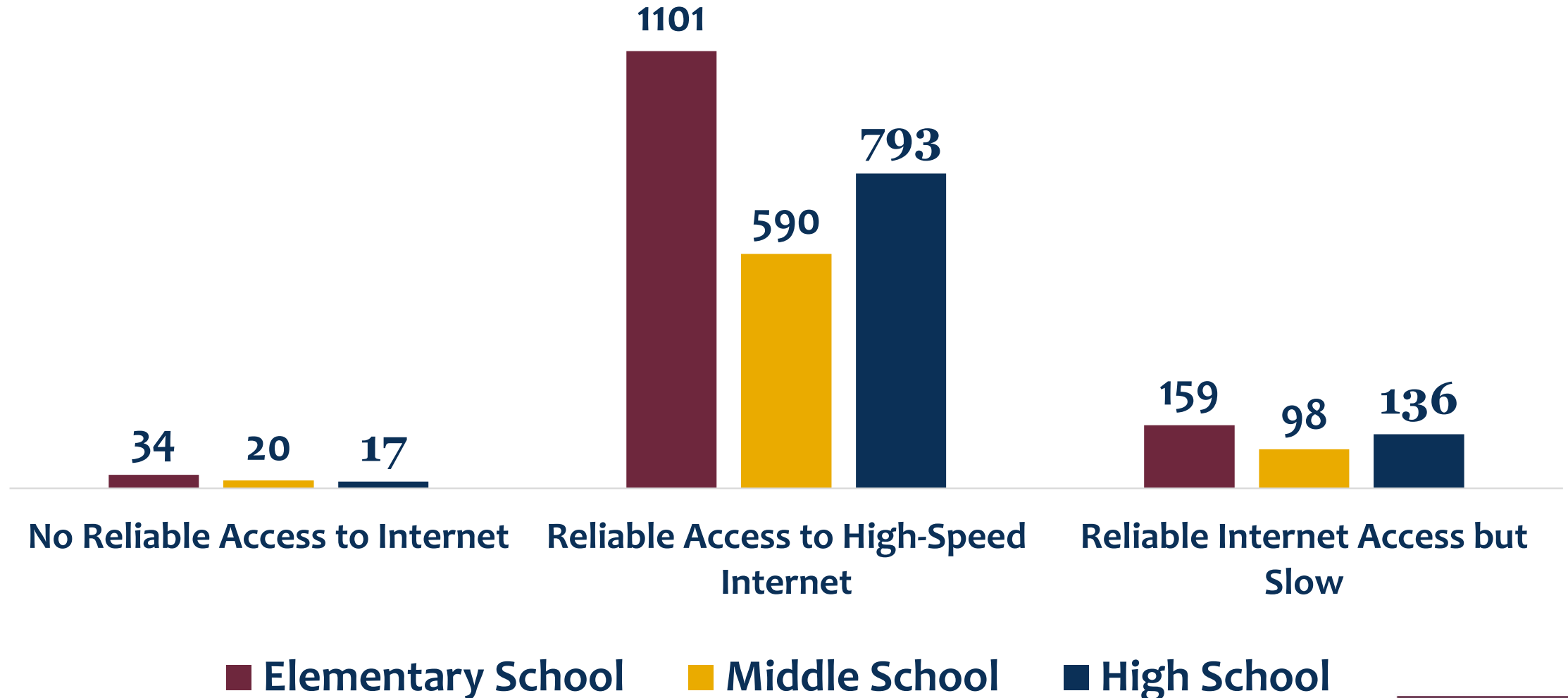

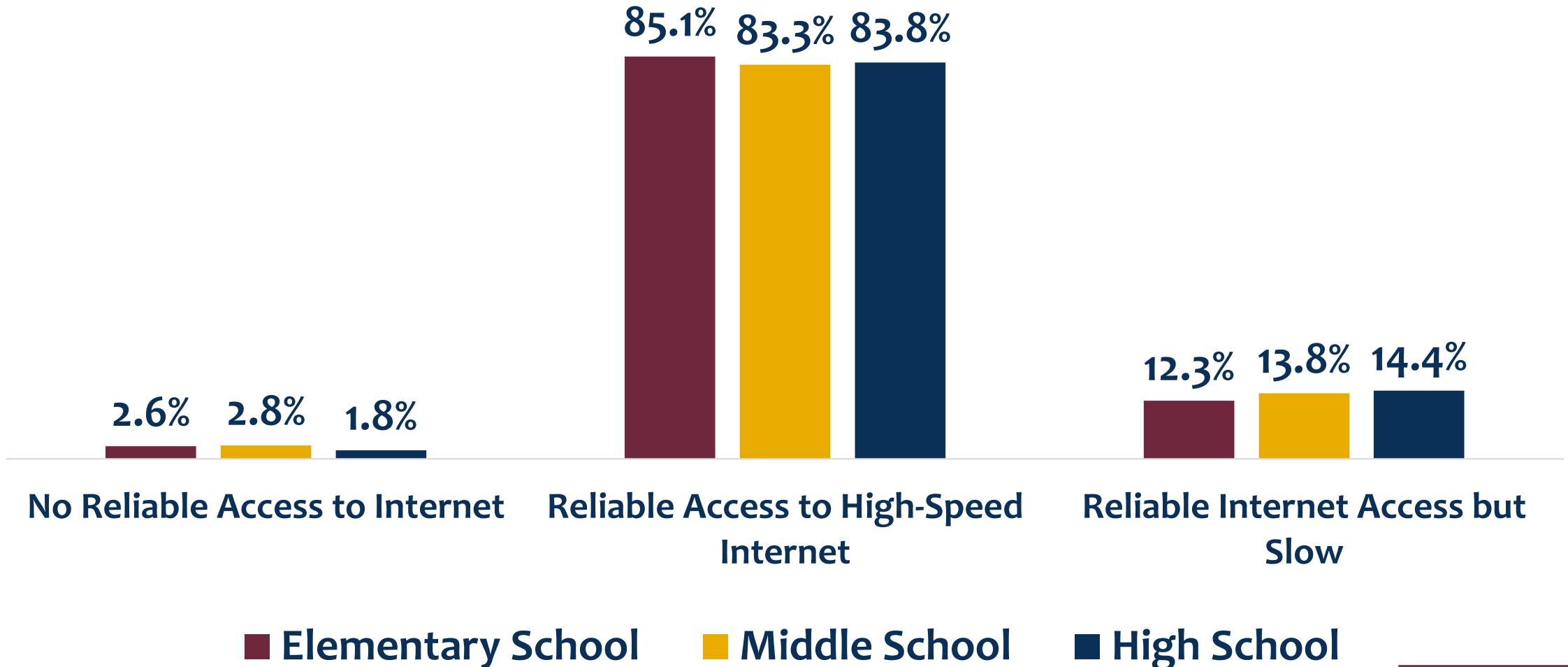

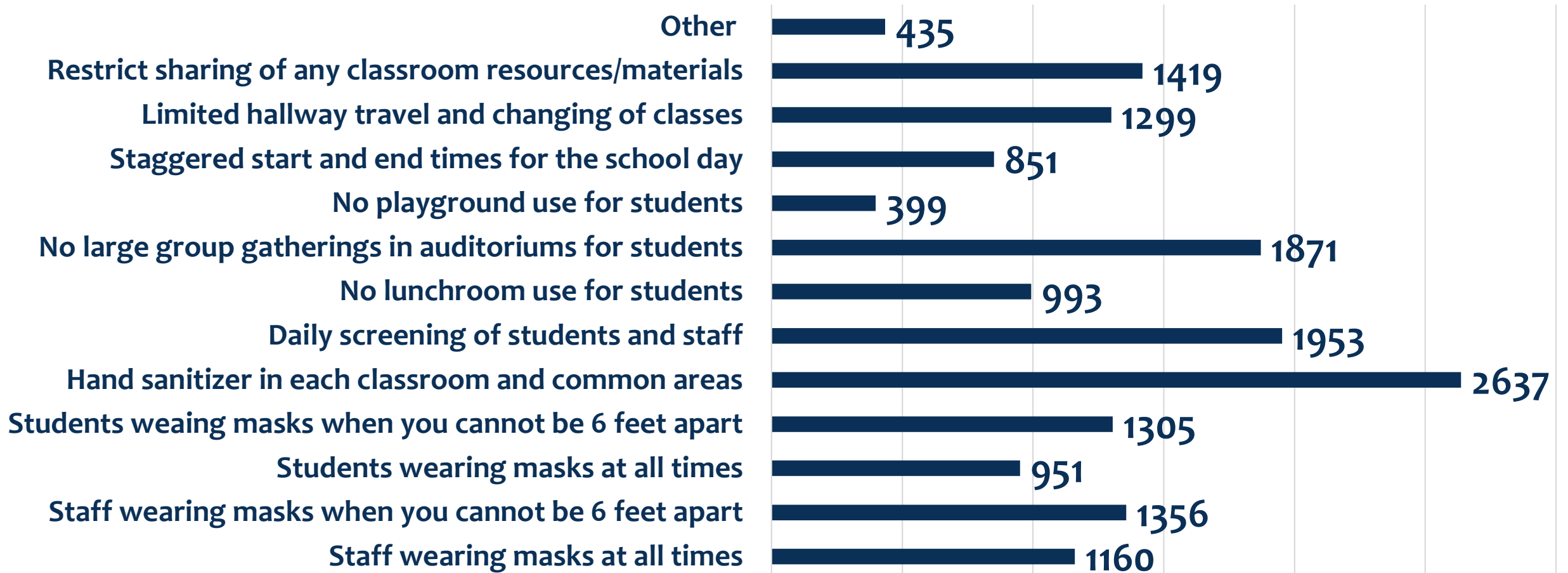

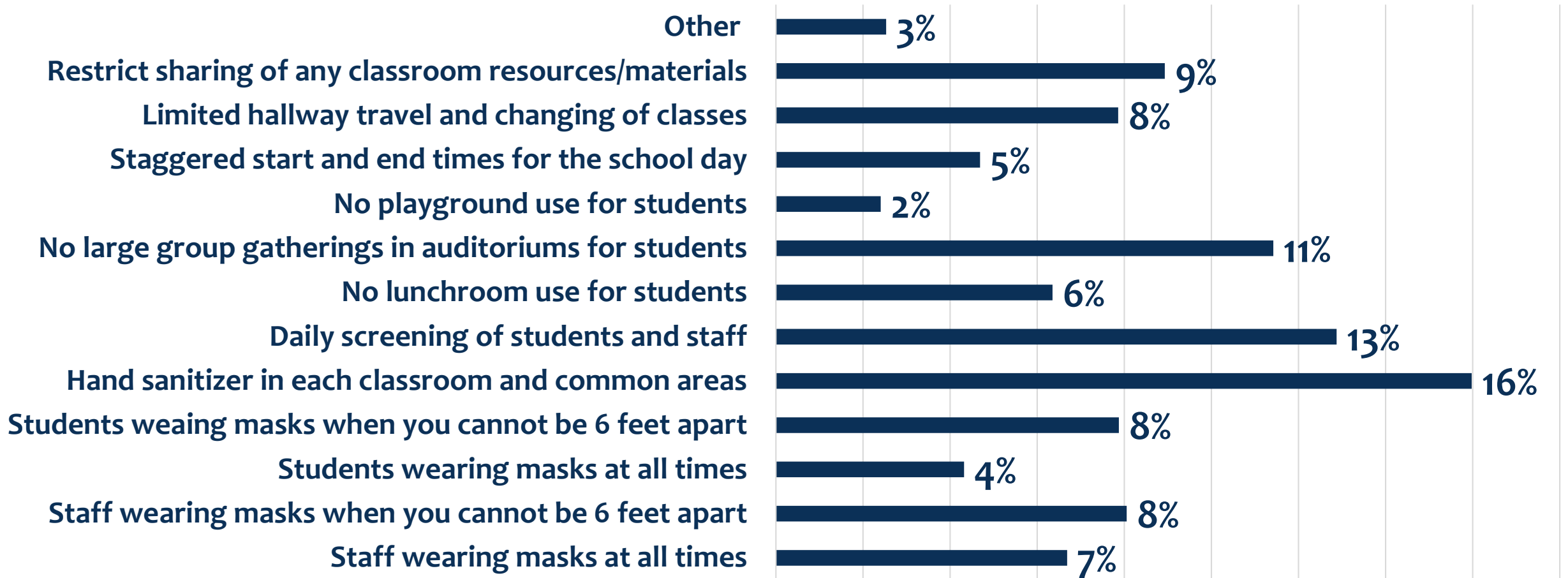

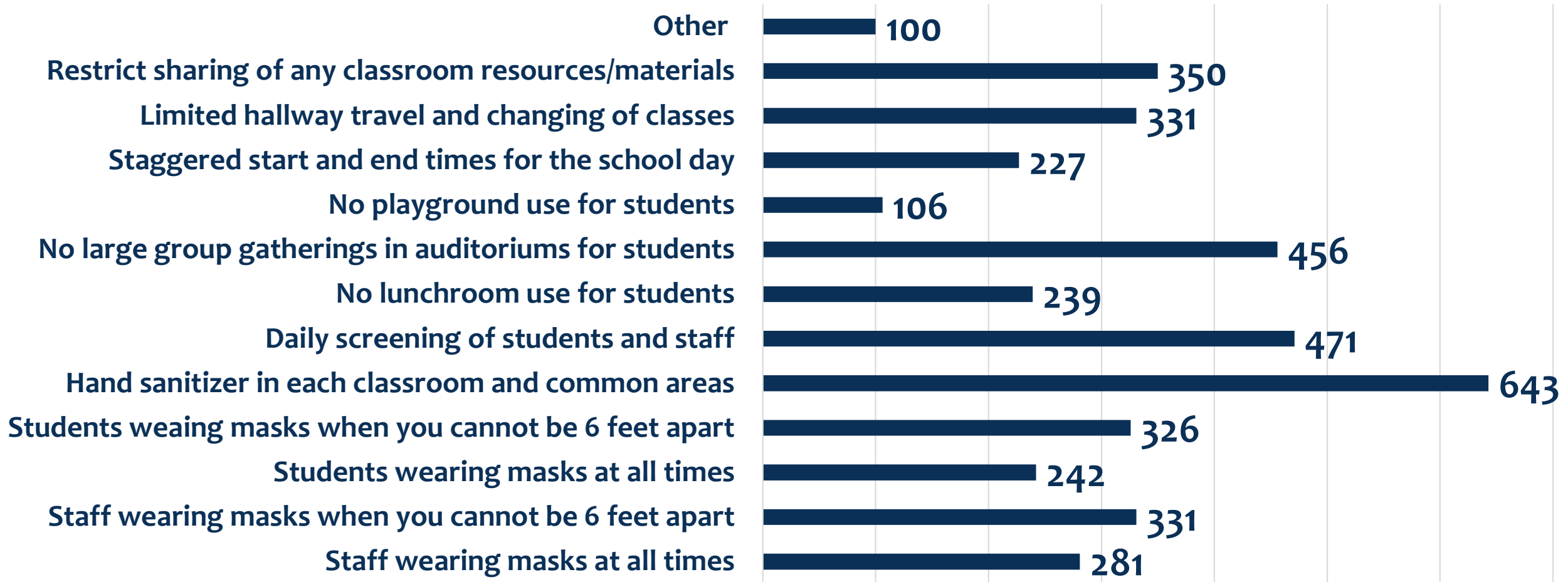

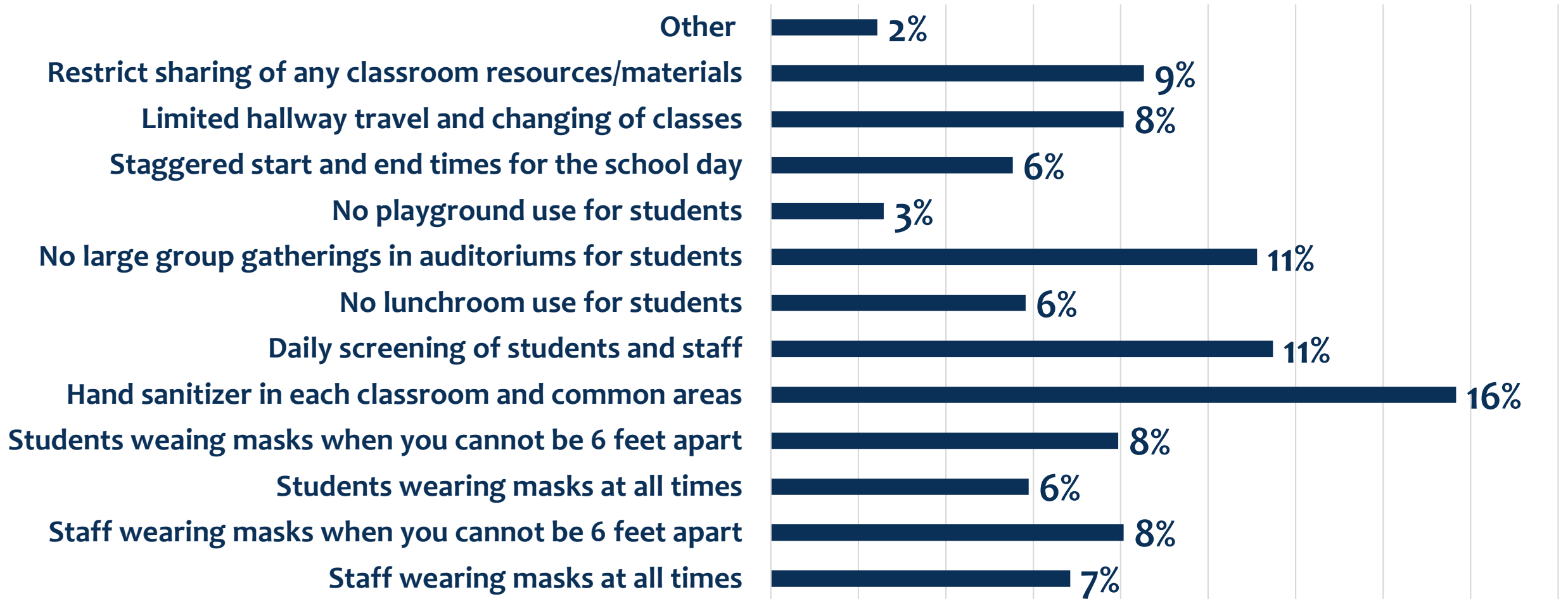

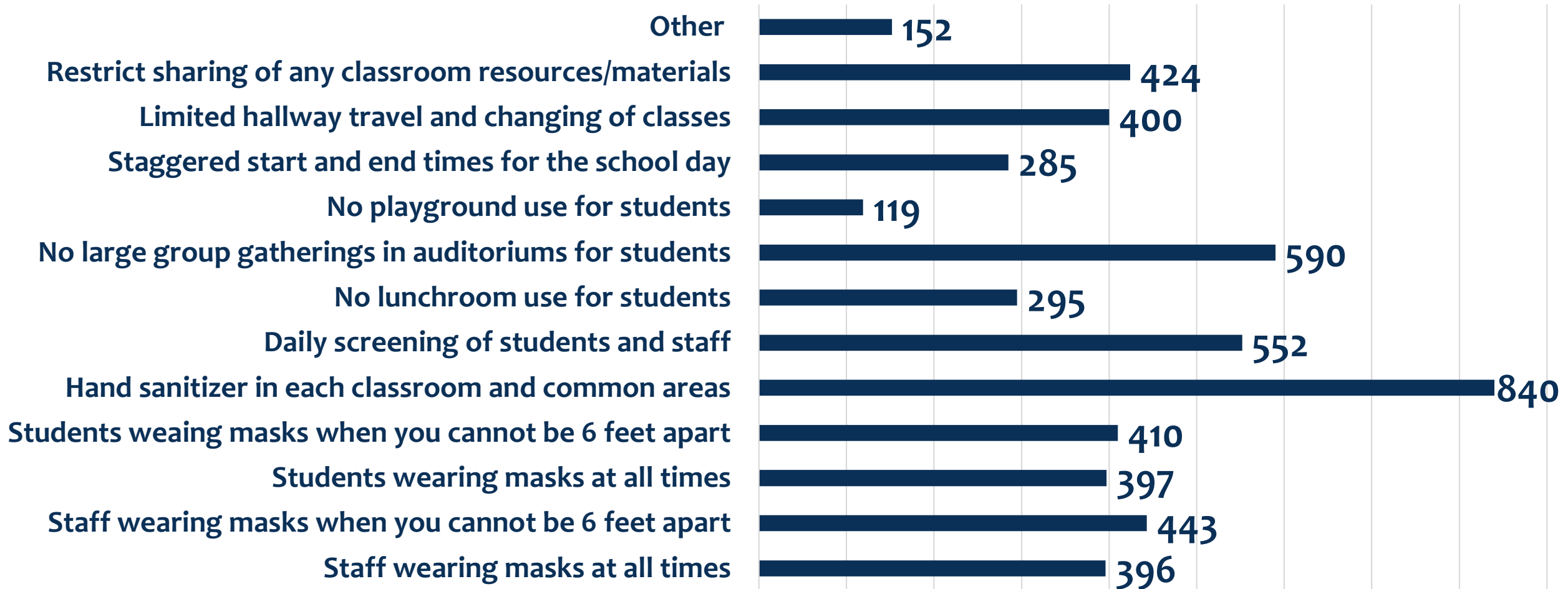

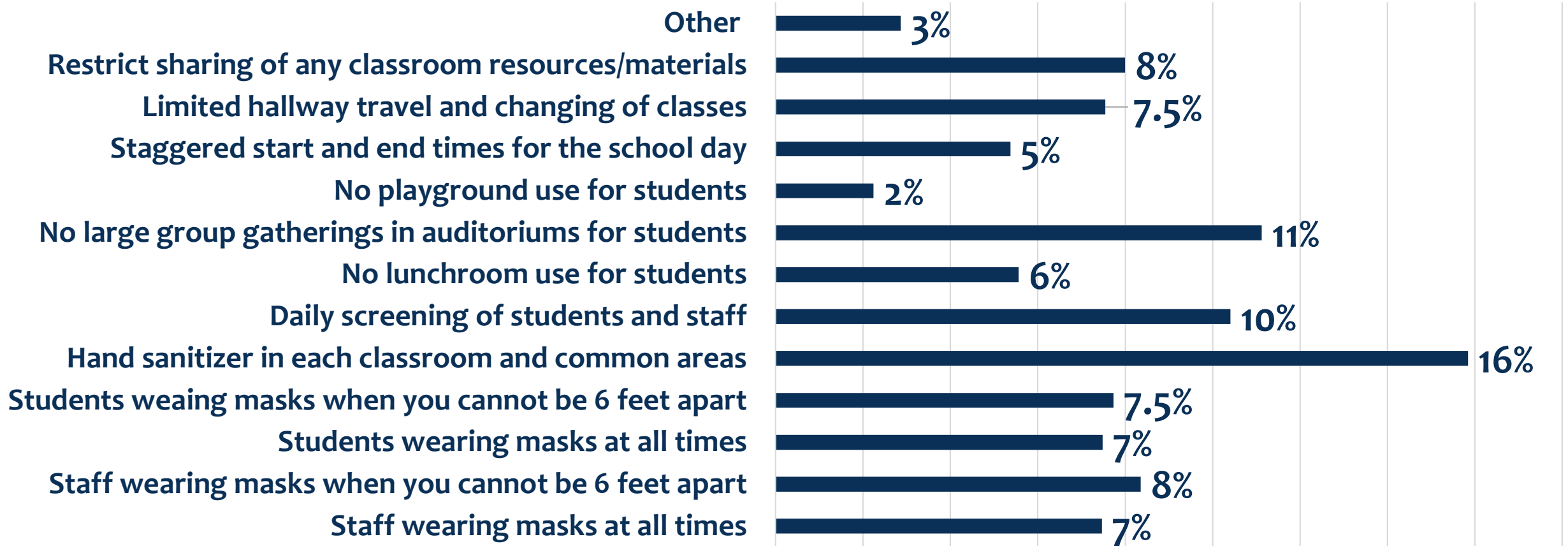
