- Meets monthly (August thru June) to review and act on items related to the provision of special education services within the SELPA;
- Utilizes the OSC Chairperson to meet regularly with the SELPA Director to ensure all relevant issues related to the provision of special education in Marin County are addressed in OSC meetings;
- Receives input from the SELPA Director and three (3) standing committees on issues
 related to special education. consists of all the SELPA's Special Education Directors
 and meets monthly. The Business Advisory Committee (BAC) consists of all the
 SELPA's District Business Officials and meets monthly. The Special Education
 Advisory Committee (SEAC) consists of parents, community agencies, and educators
 within the SELPA and regularly meets throughout the school year;
- Adopts the SELPA's Annual Budget Plan, Annual Service Plan, and Fiscal Allocation Plans annually. The SELPA's AB 602 Fiscal Allocation Plan has six (6) set asides that support the provision of special education services for the SELPA's member LEAs.
- Approves and adopts all policies and procedures related to the provision of special education services; and
- Follows the guiding principle "All for one, one for all" related to the provision of special education services within the SELPA.
