Throughout the years, East Union High School has had a reputation for having excellent graduation ceremonies. In general, the behavior of our seniors at the ceremony indicates that they respect themselves, their parents, and the school. We believe that the ceremony will have dignity so that each of us can remember it with pride when we celebrate after! Your signature at the bottom of this page indicates that you understand the following standards of conduct for the graduation ceremony.

- The ceremony is not a celebration and is to be conducted in a dignified manner and I will conduct myself properly.
- 2. My participation in the ceremony is a privilege and not a right.
- 3. I am not to alter the cap and/or gown in any way unless I have prior approval.
- I will dress in good taste, and will wear dress shoes or nice shoes suitable to walk on grass.
- 5. I will not bring any noisemakers, balloons, or other items that might detract from or disrupt the ceremony in any way.

- 6. I will not use any drugs or alcohol prior to or during the ceremony. Such use will disqualify me from participation.
- If my behavior detracts from or disrupts the ceremony in any way, I will be removed from the ceremony and my diploma will be held pending the results of a conference with the principal.
- 8. Leis and sunglasses cannot be worn by graduates.
- I will clear all obligations such as detention, bill and fines, etc. prior to the deadline and attend graduation practice to be *eligible* to participate in ceremony.

Seniors are encouraged to decorate their cap as a way of expressing their themselves. Seniors wishing to decorate graduation caps must follow the school process and meet the set deadlines. The caps will be decorated to thank a family member, teacher, friend, to recognize the post-secondary plans, graduation year, high school activities, or recognize the senior's culture, heritage, identity, religion, etc.

Only school designated regalia will be permitted to be worn at the graduation ceremony. Stoles and Honor Cords will be a recognition of academic honor of minimum GPA of 3.5, with other criteria determined by site graduation committee. No other adornment, pins, buttons, embroidery, or stitching will be permitted on the graduation gown or stole.

## Disneyland Rules/Polices The following items are prohibited for all Attendees:


- Alcoholic beverages and any illegal narcotics/substances.
