Planning Committee would like us to assume larger parcel – use triangle area for educational objectives
Use indigenous flora and fauna
Change direction of road a little bit
We need to get SEQRA documents
- What things are left over from original scope of bond that was not put in?

- Emblem on field - \$5,000 savings could be used toward scoreboard
