WHEREAS, the Board hereby affirms the sale of 2165 Seaford Avenue, Seaford, New York to the assignee of BK at Seaford, LLC, Seaford Waverly Corp., which assignment is on substantially the same terms and conditions set forth in the contract of sale, as amended, on file in the Office of the District Clerk and further affirms that the sale does not represent the sale of substantially all of the assets of the corporation and said assets are not used in the course of the daily activities of the corporation, and said sale has been approved by the qualified voters of Seaford Union Free School District; and

WHEREAS, the Board by majority vote affirms and approves all closing costs associated with the sale of the premises, including but not limited to title fees and broker commissions:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Seaford Union Free School District hereby by majority vote approves the sale of 2165 Seaford Avenue, Seaford, New York to the assignee of BK at Seaford, LLC, Seaford Waverly Corp. for the purchase price of \$5,144,000 and pursuant to the aforementioned contract of sale.
