Would like to appropriate from the repair reserve fund in the 2017/2018 school year funds not to exceed \$96,000

These funds will be used for:

- Various painting jobs throughout the District
- Fence repairs
- Repair of the Harbor Elementary School outside basketball courts

Appropriation will not exceed \$97,000

- Able to adjust one of our bids from a Co-Op Bid to a BOCES Bid to save some money
- Now looks like the not to exceed amount will be \$96,000

Once this is approved we will appropriate the funds and start the work as soon as it gets a little warmer

- Looking to do all this work when the schools are closed; most likely during the breaks and to be completed by the end of the school year
