Pleased be assured, Seaford is committed to creating a safe school environment for our students and staff. School security and the safety of our students and staff has always been of utmost importance to the Board of Education and administration. Over the last few years, many enhancements and improvements have been made to the district's security procedures and protocols. A few examples include: new safety doors and locks for all classrooms districtwide (currently being installed), a new lockdown system and additional security cameras.

Kindly note, the Seaford School District has had a Districtwide Safety Committee and a Districtwide Safety Plan as well as Building Level Teams and Building Safety Plans.
