Earlier this afternoon, Nassau County Police Department Commissioner Patrick Ryder announced that the department will be increasing its presence at school districts throughout our region tomorrow based on a new TikTok challenge in which students throughout the nation are encouraged to make threats against their schools on December 17, 2021.

It is important to note that there have not been any specific threats made toward Seaford Schools. However, out of an abundance of caution, there will be two officers from the NCPD in our district tomorrow, as well as district security personnel. Please do not be alarmed if you see police cars on campus tomorrow, as it is only precautionary.

Please take this time to speak to your children about the importance of responsible social media use and encourage them to report any suspicious activity or threatening posts to a trusted adult immediately.
