With the close of the school year fast approaching, I would like to thank you again for your continuous support and understanding. As mentioned at our last Board of Education meeting (June 2), an opportunity exists to have a vaccination site for students located at Seaford High School. While vaccine distribution is not a school function, several community members have asked if the District can provide access to them. Mount Sinai South Nassau has arranged for a mobile vaccine unit to administer vaccines to any community member aged 12 and older starting at 3:30 PM Thursday, June 10th, at Seaford High School. The Pfizer vaccine is available for individuals aged 12-17 and the Johnson and Johnson for those over the age of 17. - Please bring proof of eligibility to your appointment (identification showing date of birth)
- Second dose appointments for Pfizer will be made on site after the first vaccine, which will be at **519 Merrick Rd., Rockville Centre**
- Please wear masks and short sleeves

Please know that teachers and administrators have been working earnestly in planning celebratory activities for the end of the year. Given the new gathering capacity guidelines, we are pleased that many of them will be in-person and we will be able to come together as a community once again.
