Dear Parents and Guardians,

Over the last few weeks, parents have asked for information regarding COVID vaccination availability. Today, I received the following information from Dr. Lawrence Eisenstein, Nassau County Commissioner of Health, and I am forwarding it to you:

“... starting this Thursday afternoon and running for 4 days, Nassau County, in partnership with Northwell Health and Nassau Community College is presenting ‘Student Days’. The intent is to provide free Pfizer vaccinations against COVID-19 with a focus on our 16-18-year-old students.”

He continues to say that, “Although this event targets students, we will not turn any eligible resident away, and should Pfizer be approved for dissemination in those 12-15 years old, they can be included in this initiative as well.”

“Student Days” vaccinations will be administered in the main gymnasium at Nassau Community College:  
Thursday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, 1pm-9pm  
Friday, May 14<sup>th</sup>, 1pm-9pm  
Saturday, May 15<sup>th</sup>, 9am-5pm  
Sunday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, 9am-5pm.
