Over the weekend, there was a surge in COVID-19 positive cases with 18 new cases being reported. In order to contain a spread, one class at the Harbor and three Varsity teams at the High School have been quarantined. In addition, one class at the Harbor shifted to remote instruction today so that we could further contact trace.

Below are the number of positive COVID cases since my letter dated March 5, 2021:

In order to remain open for in-person instruction, we all need to abide by social distancing protocols in the classroom and after school hours. Contact tracing has revealed that some cases are tied to social gatherings. Please note that it is vital that if a student or an employee is not feeling well or believes to be a close contact to someone who has tested positive, that he/she must remain at home.
