Dear Parents/Guardians:

I hope this letter finds you and your family well and enjoying the remaining weeks of summer. Last week, parents were asked to complete a survey for each child who attends Seaford Schools. The data revealed that some families would like the District to provide a remote learning option in lieu of in-person instruction.

Prior to the Governor's statement last Friday requiring districts provide a remote learning alternative to inperson instruction, please know that we had already been preparing a plan to accommodate this preference. As a result, the Seaford School District will be offering a Remote Learning Center Option for students who prefer not to attend in-person instruction.

We are hosting a series of meetings for parents who are interested in this Remote Learning Center Option. On Wednesday, August 19, 2020, the scheduled meetings are as follows:

Manor School and Harbor School at 6:00 pm Middle School at 7:00 pm High School at 8:00 pm

Because we want to make sure that we are able to address inquiries regarding the Remote Learning Center Option, we will not be discussing the comprehensive reopening of schools' plan that was presented at the August 5th Board of Education meeting.
