Dear Seaford Community,

Earlier this afternoon I confirmed with the New York State Department of Health that an employee tested positive for COVID-19. This person had been working at the Seaford Manor School earlier last week.

As I previously reported, the Manor School was professionally cleaned and sanitized by a restoration company on March 20<sup>th</sup>. This cleaning occurred after this employee had been in the building.

The Nassau County Department of Health has advised us that it is their responsibility to contact persons who may potentially have been exposed. Due to privacy laws, we are not able to share the identity of the individual or details about his/her case. We ask that medical questions be directed to your family doctor/healthcare provider.

We recognize that this news will be concerning to our community. Please be assured that the safety and well-being of our students and staff is our number one priority. We will remain in close contact with health officials, follow any recommendations they issue, and continue to keep you updated to the extent permissible.

Please be reminded that the Department of Health continues to emphasize the importance of social distancing and frequent hand washing. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our community safe and healthy.
