Motion by Ms. Stark, second by Ms. Parisi, to approve the award of contracts for Summer Home to School Transportation (In-District and Private Schools) as per the recommendation of the Assistant Superintendent for Business and Operations to Educational Bus Transportation, Inc.

Ms. Stark asked for clarification concerning the monthly cost for the cameras on the 25 buses. Dr. Pecora advised that the monthly cost - \$5,850 for the 25 buses - is about \$232 per bus for the cameras per month. \$5,850 per month for all 25 buses. Mr. Kahn advised that they received a letter which stated if we do not do all the buses then it would be \$200 or \$300 a month. Dr. Pecora went on to say that we do not know where we are right now or how we might want to monitor things or how we are going to use the buses. We do know we are not going to be able to quadruple or triple the buses. There are not enough drivers or busses and if we have to have the children wear masks it would be helpful to have cameras on the buses. We cannot have matrons on the buses. Matrons cost approximately \$2,200 per bus per month. Mr. Kahn also advised that there is a letter that is a part of this, so they are really accepting this with an addendum that Timothy Flood signed stating the cost is \$234 a bus per month if we do not do all 25 buses.
