Vulnerability of State Aid

- Due to the extraordinary challenges from our COVID-19 health crisis, creating a \$10 billion loss in revenue to the State, support for schools will remain nearly flat for a total of \$27.9 billion in school aid.
- The NYS Director of Budget has the ability to readjust state aid prior to and then several times after the budget vote. There is no way of knowing how deep the cuts may be, which provides some degree of uncertainty when planning a budget.
