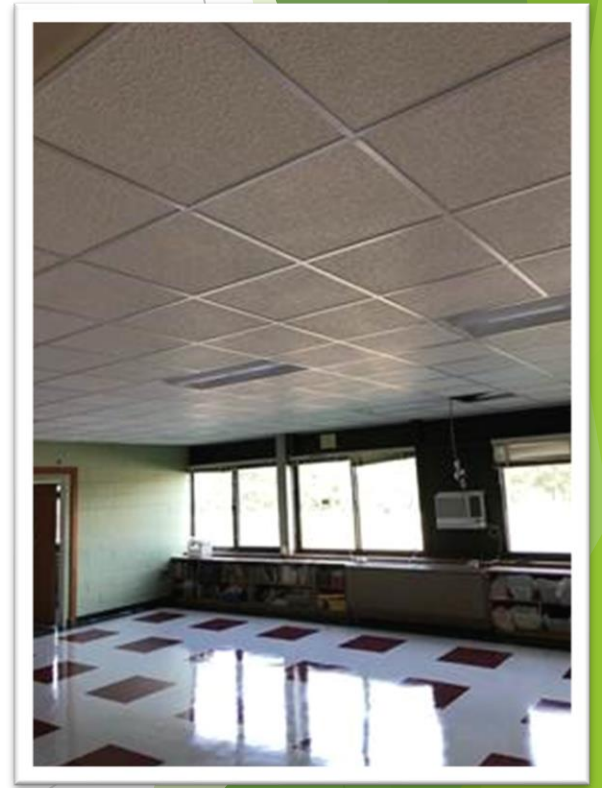

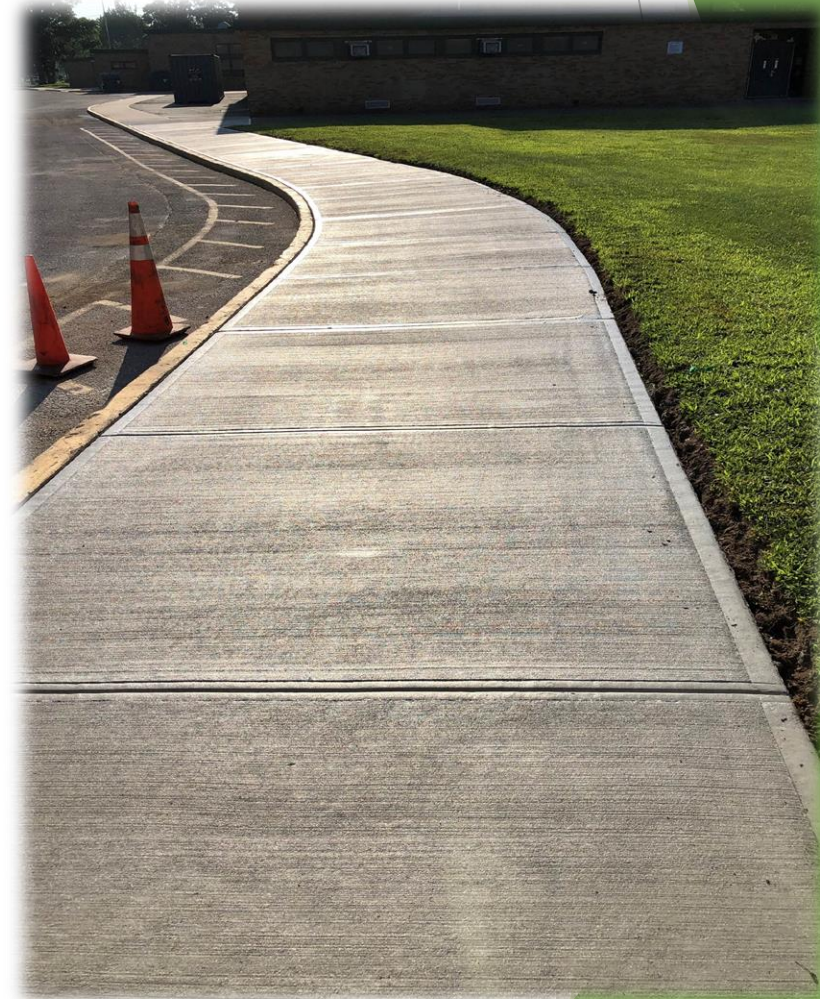

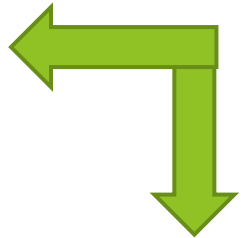

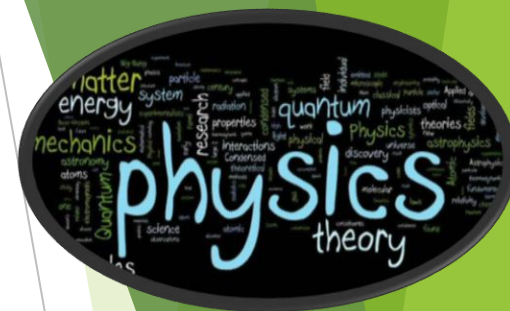

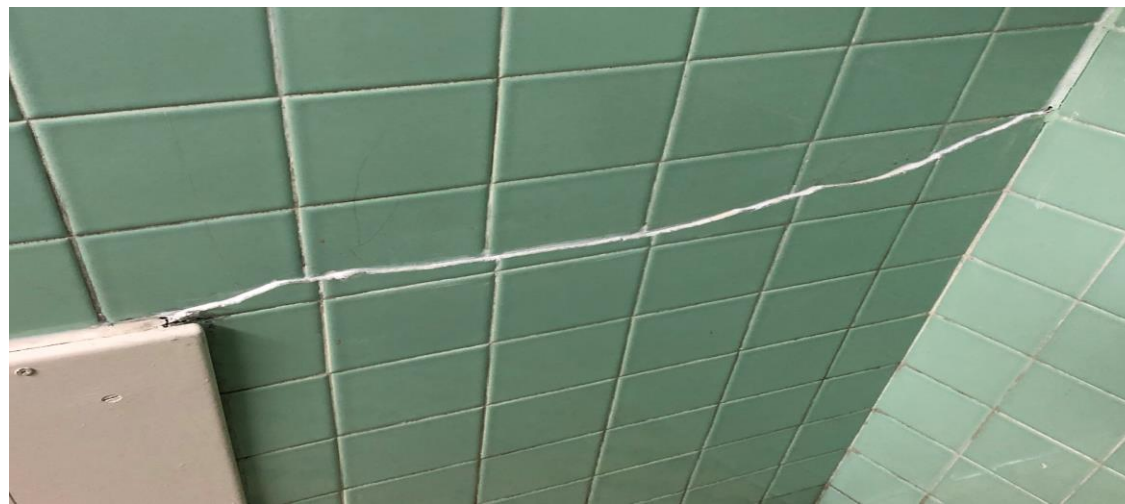

High School Boys and Girls Bathroom

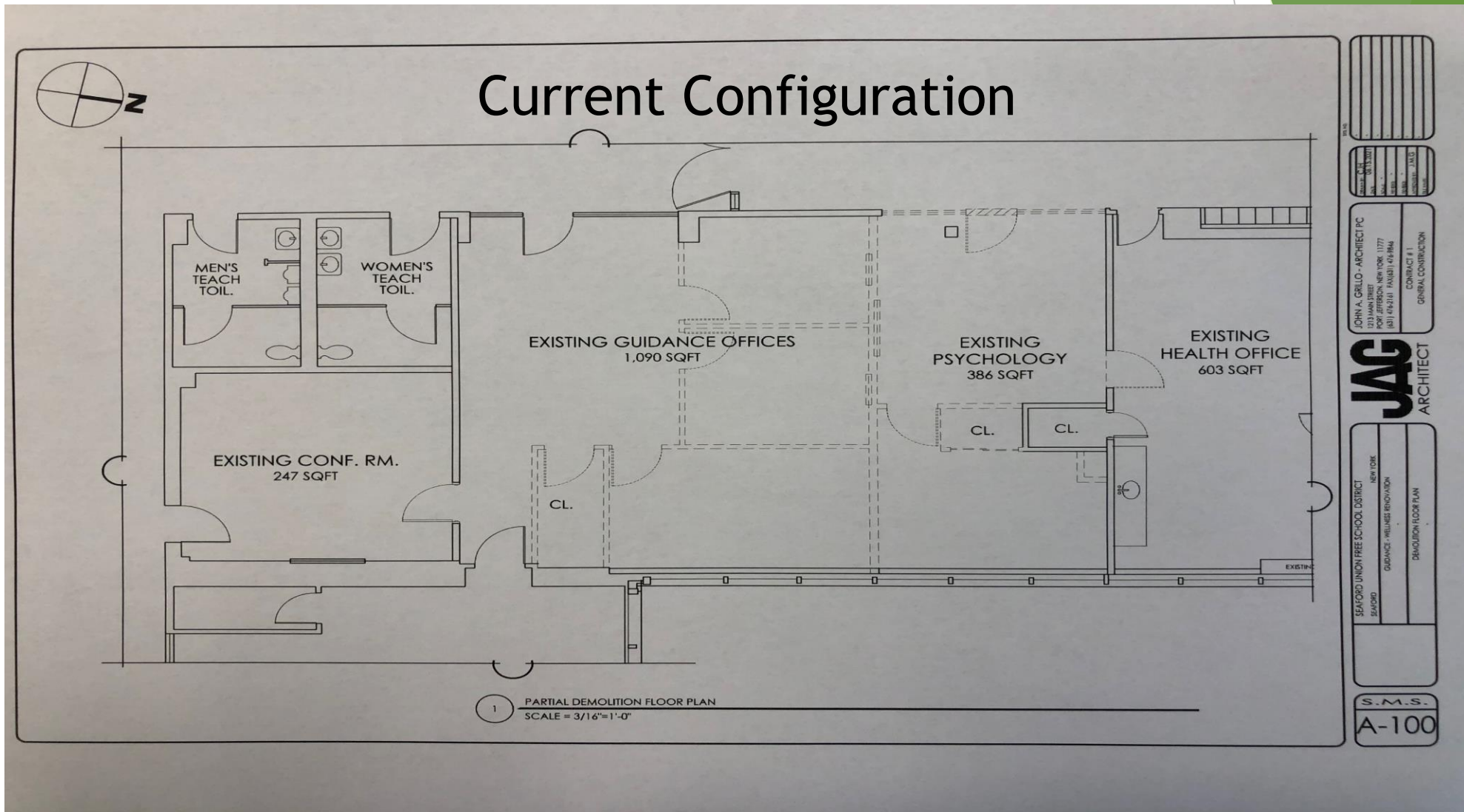

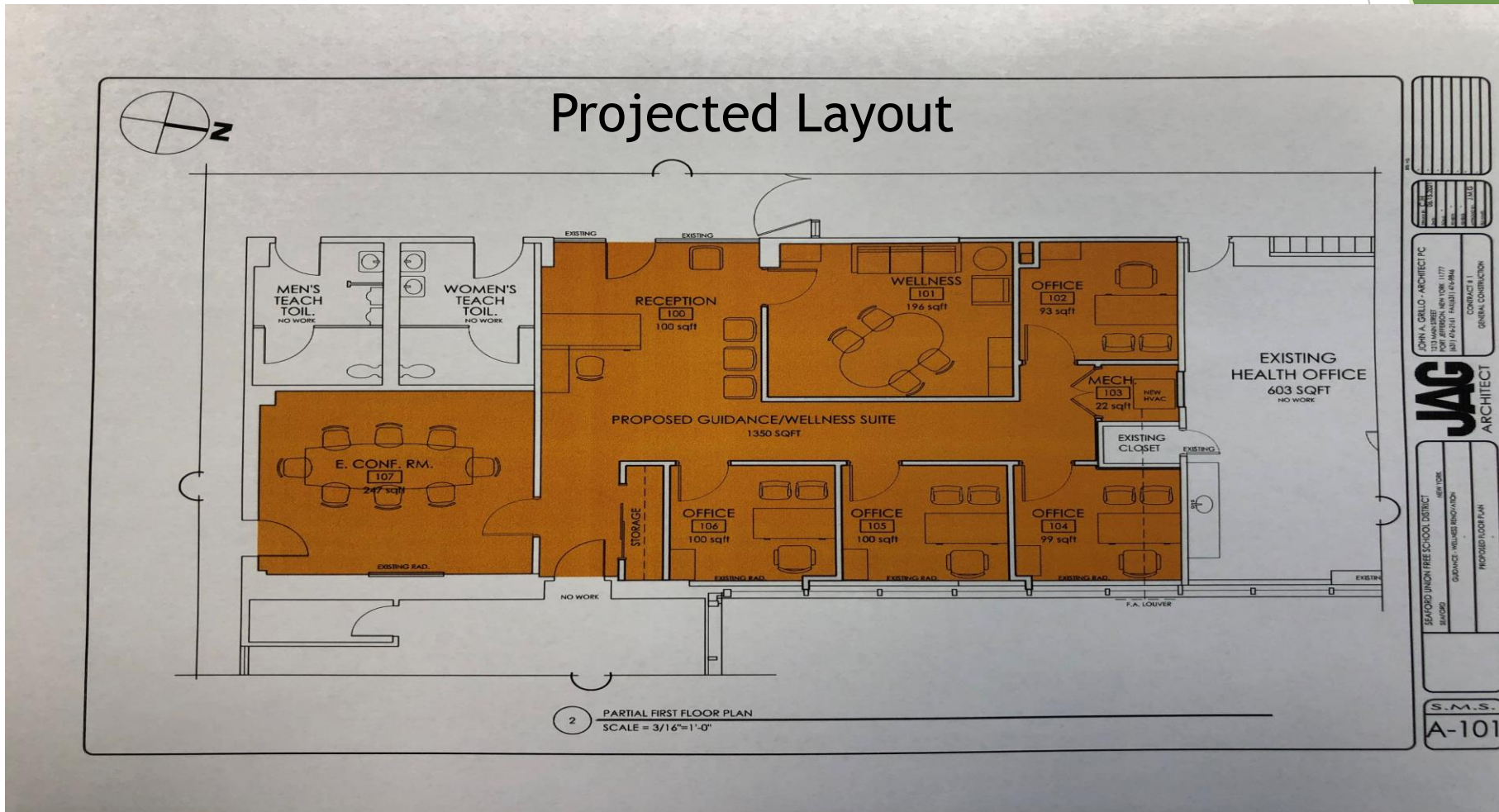

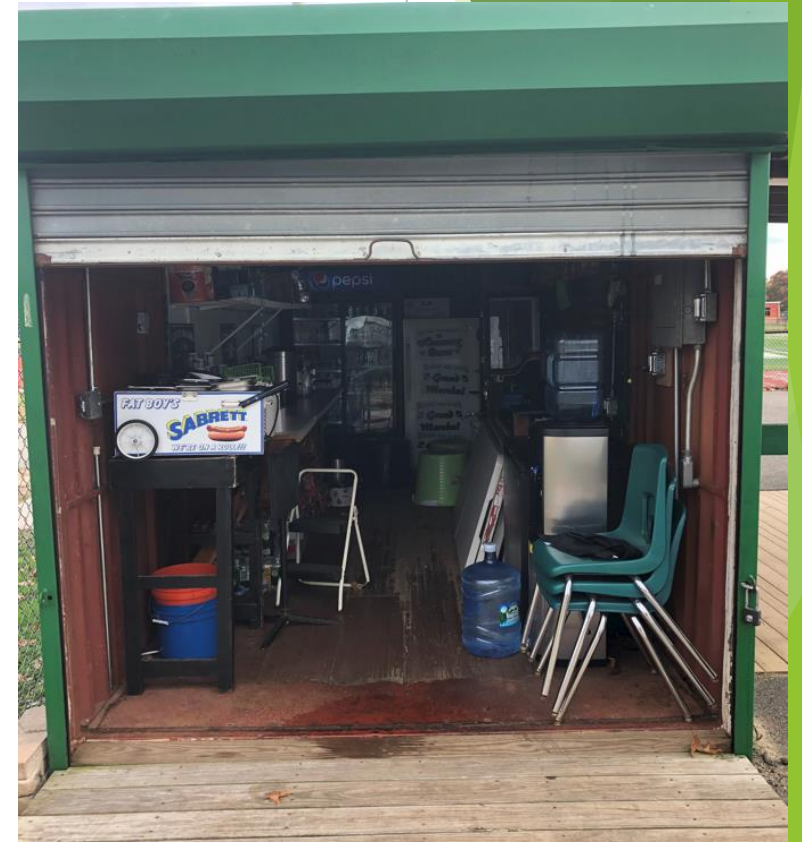

Multi-purpose Artificial Turf Fields**

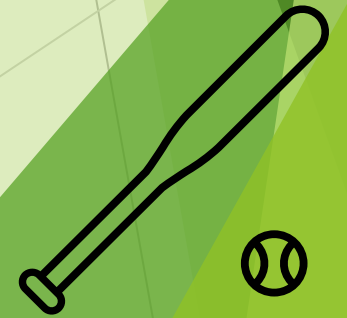
Build a Multi-use Artificial Turf Field Including Relocating the Varsity Baseball Field 2022 - 2023



Proposed funding through Capital Reserve requiring voter approval.

Benefits of Relocating the Baseball Field

- ▶ Secondary field (old Varsity Field) is then functional and safe for the MS team
- ▶ Fewer houses in danger of foul balls
- ▶ Closer to the HS building
- ▶ Better seating
- ▶ Better parking
- ▶ More space for batting cages, bullpens, storage units, and bleachers
- ▶ Dugout space has better potential
- ▶ Electric and water on site
- ▶ More athletes on the field space during practices
- ▶ Close to the snack shack

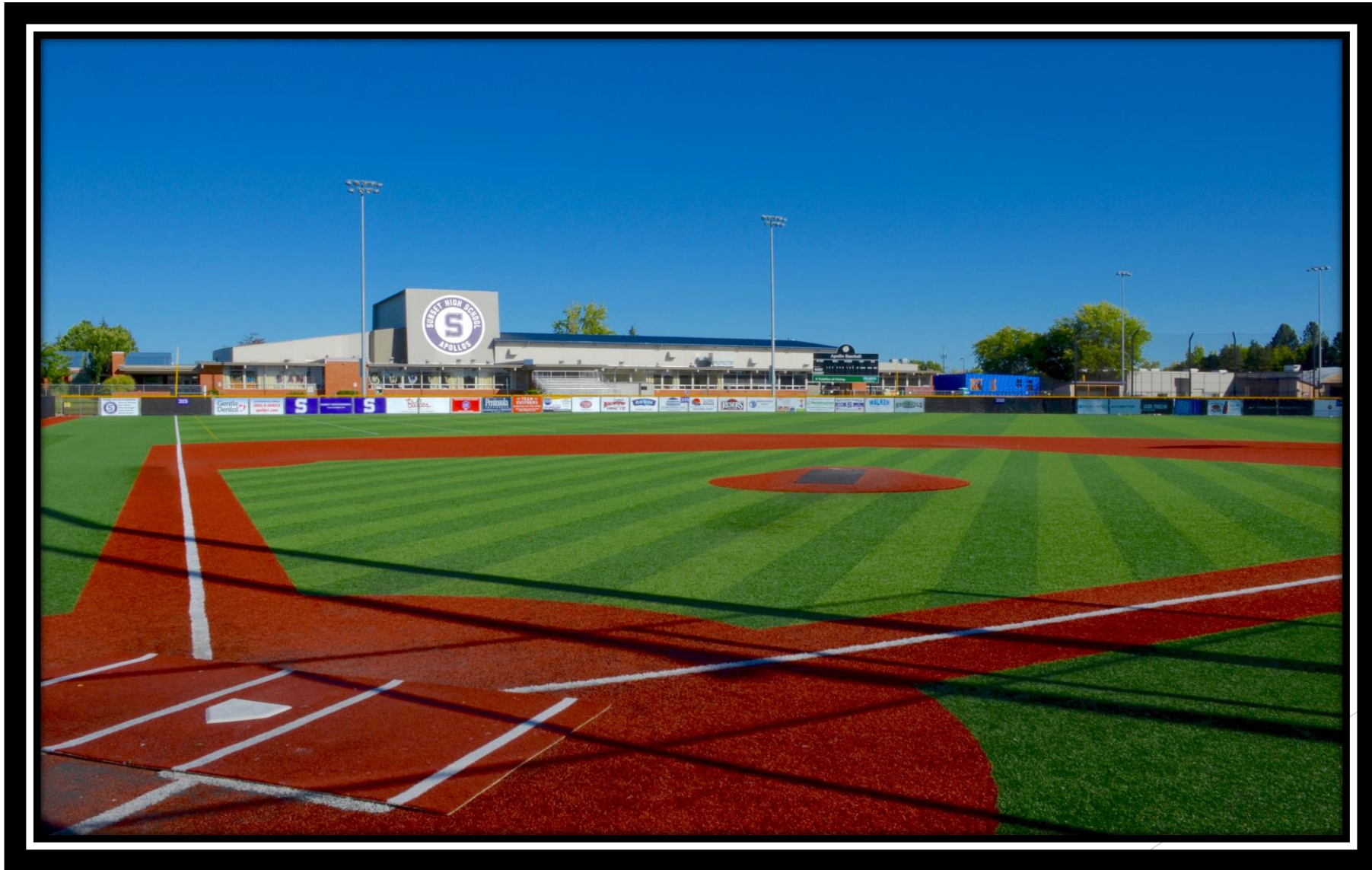

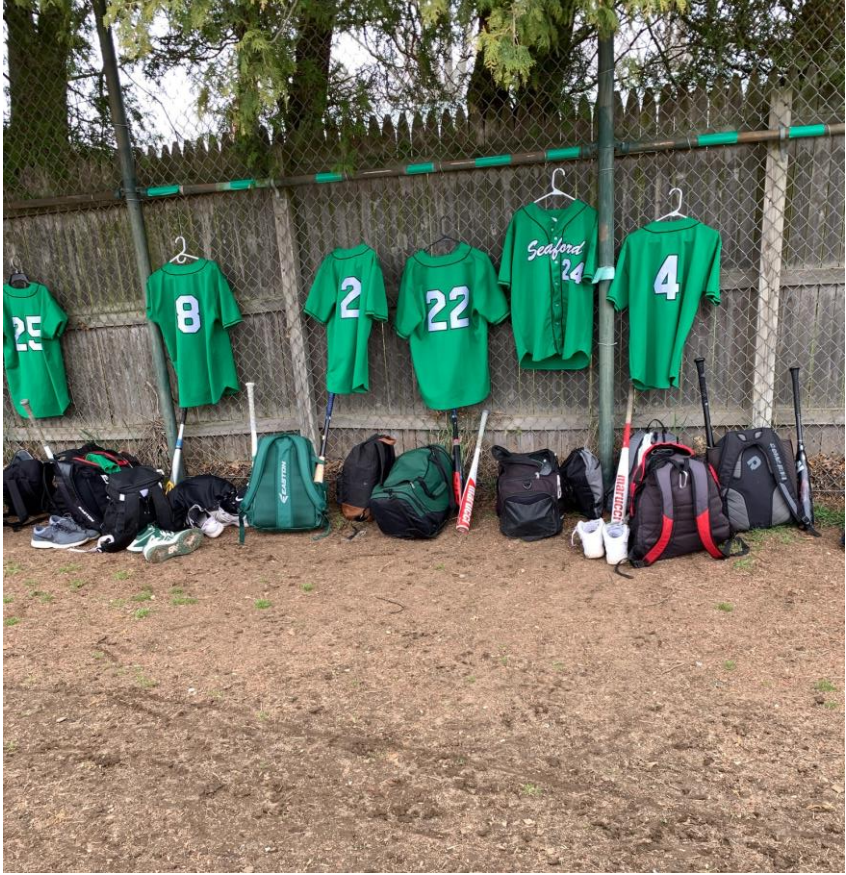

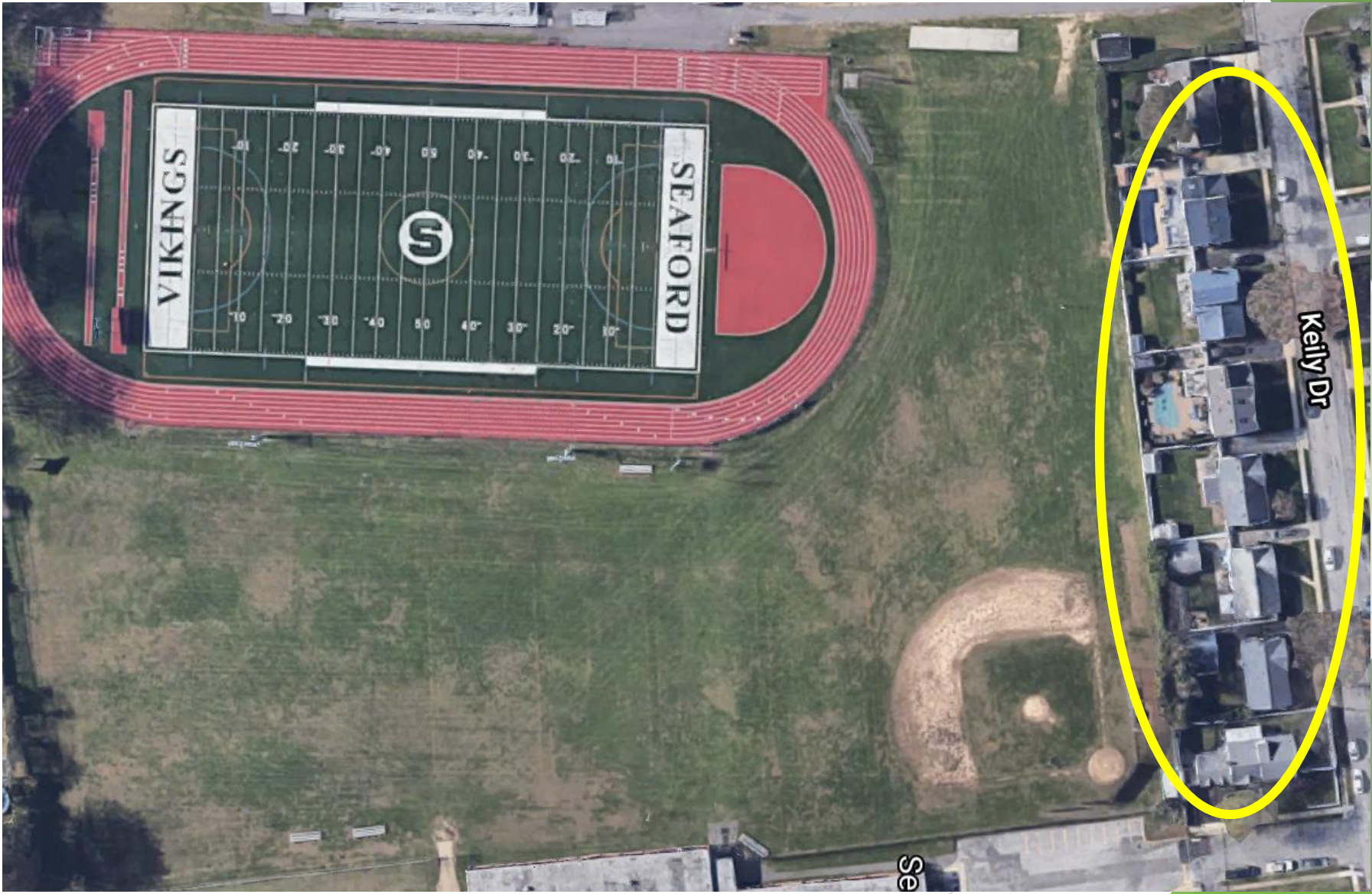
