K-5: We teach cooperative games, locomotor movements, manipulative skills, team building, and introduction to team sports.





ImPACT stands for "Immediate Post-Concussion Assessment and Cognitive Testing". It's the most common, scientifically proven computer-based test used for concussion management. We use ImPACT testing to provide baseline and post-injury testing for athletes ages 5-59 years.






