



This upgrade will include new ceiling grid, ceiling tiles & new LED lighting. This construction is to take place in the Summer 2024.











The new scoreboard will match this existing softball scoreboard.









OUTDOOR COMFORT STATION






New Bleachers for Baseball & Softball Fields






