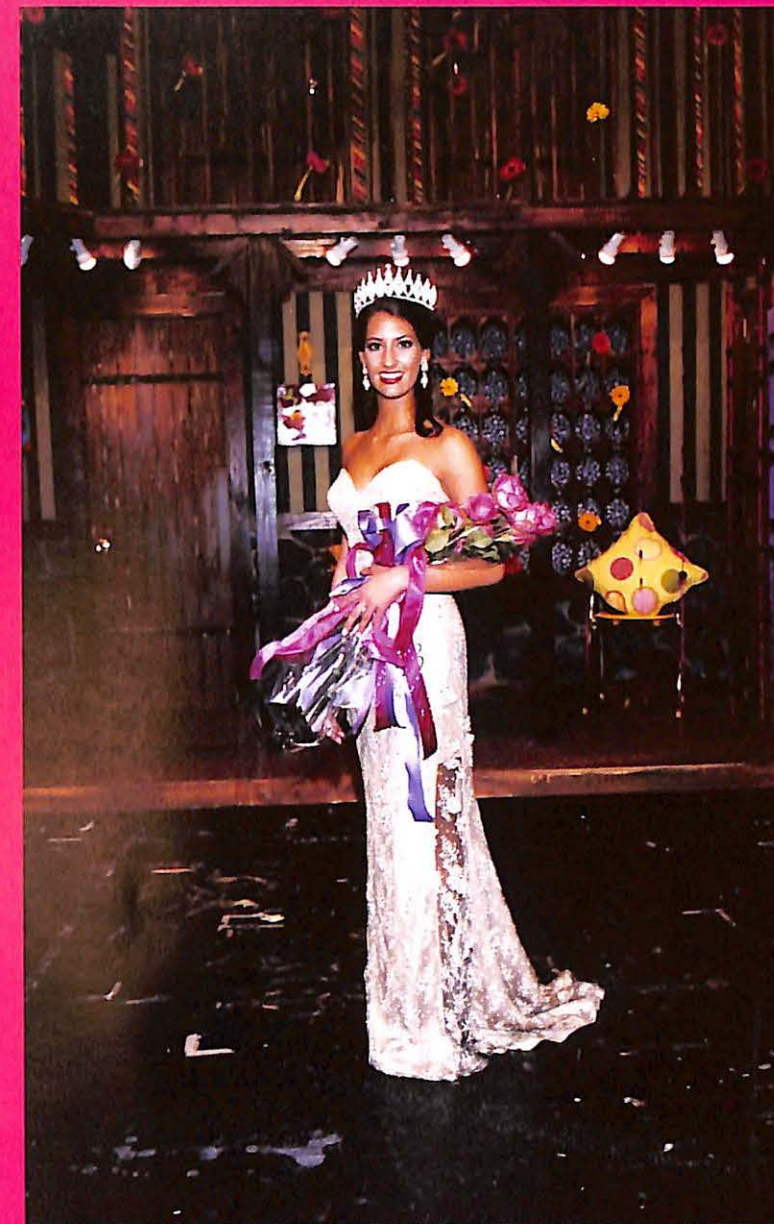

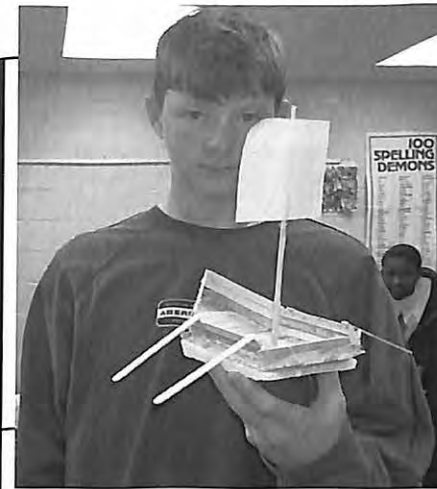

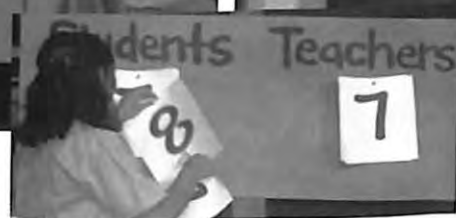

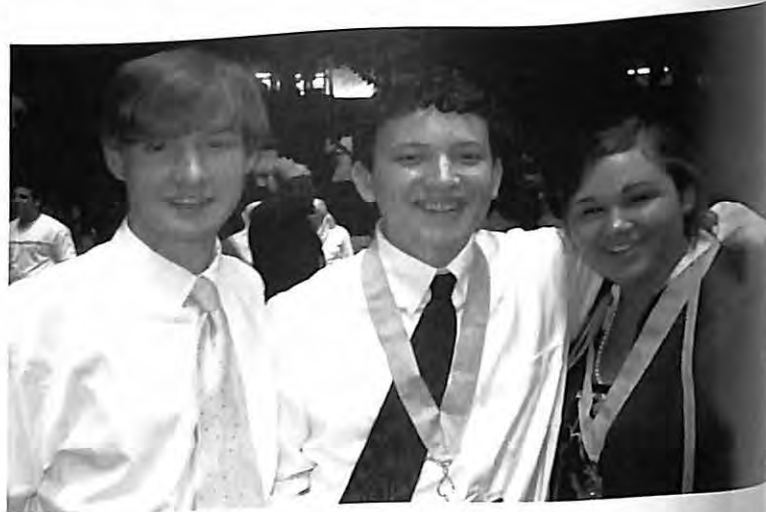
Graduation is a time for smiles and tears, leaving friends and starting new lives. This year's graduation ceremony certainly had it all.

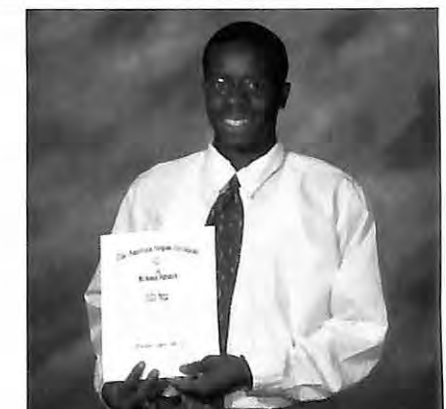

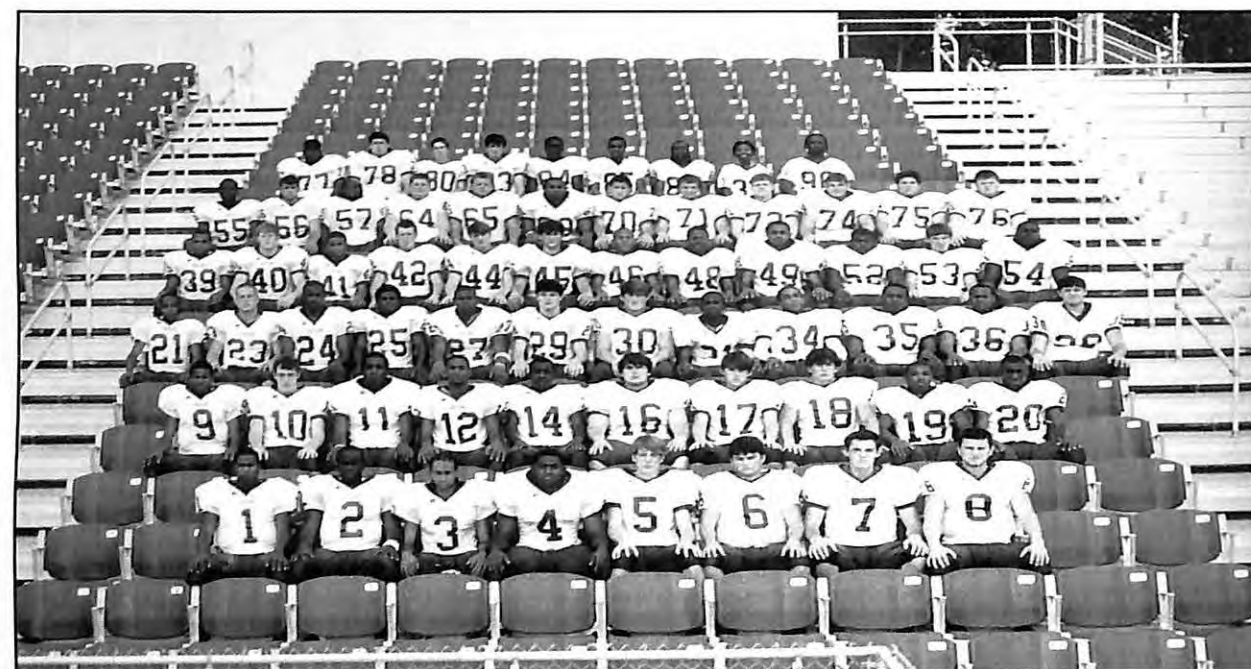

William Cole described his reaction to being picked Most Athletic as honored and suprised.

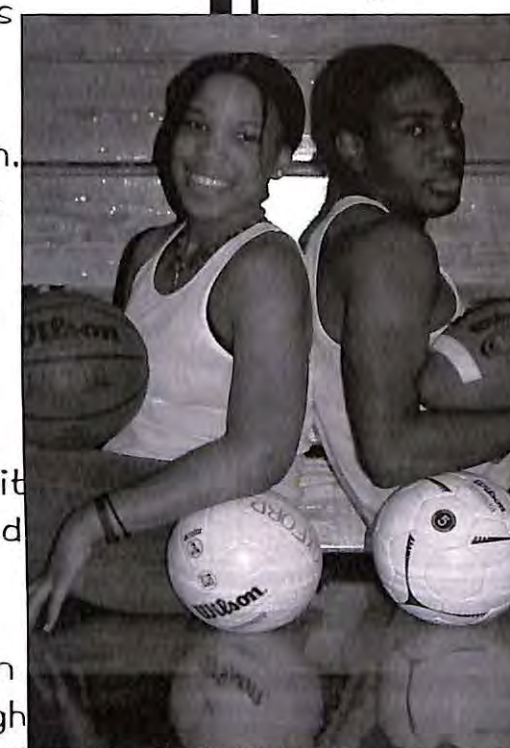
Cole said he believes it takes talent to get this superlative and also a real passion and love of sports.

several sports got him this award.

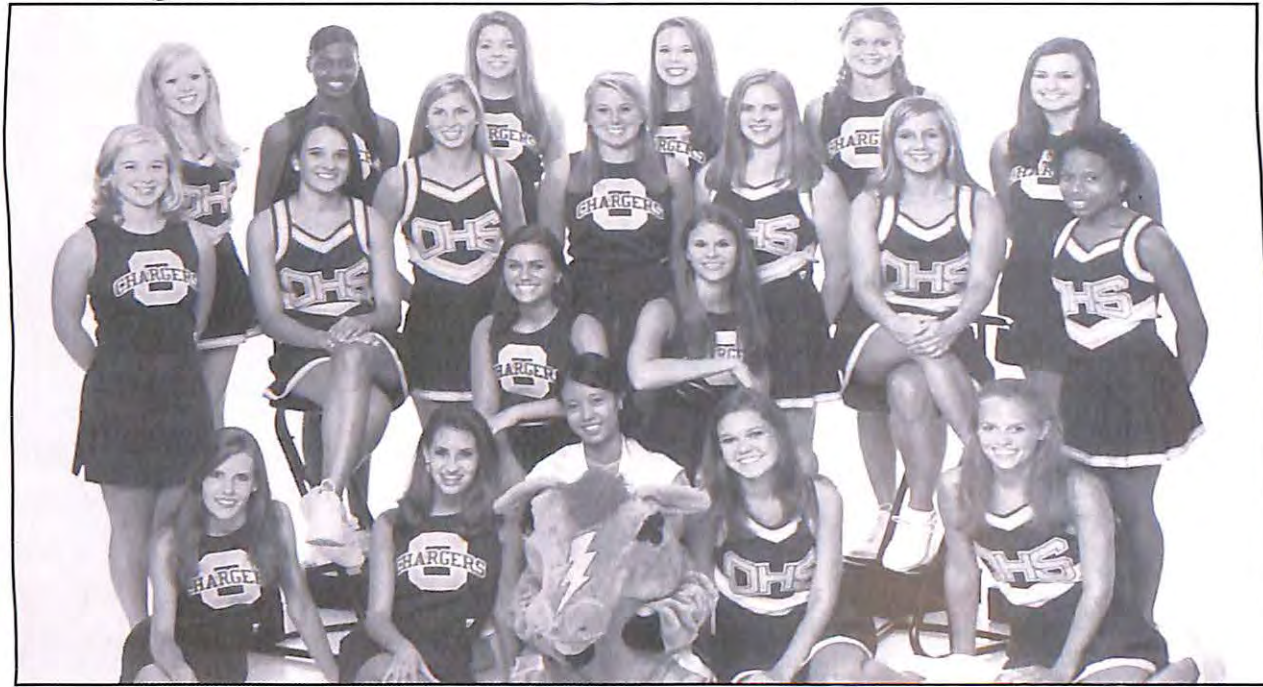

Cole plans to attend college in the fall and play some sport because sports have always been and always will be a part of who he is.

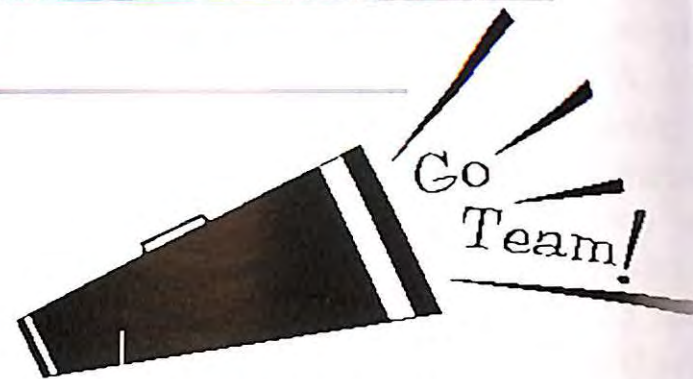

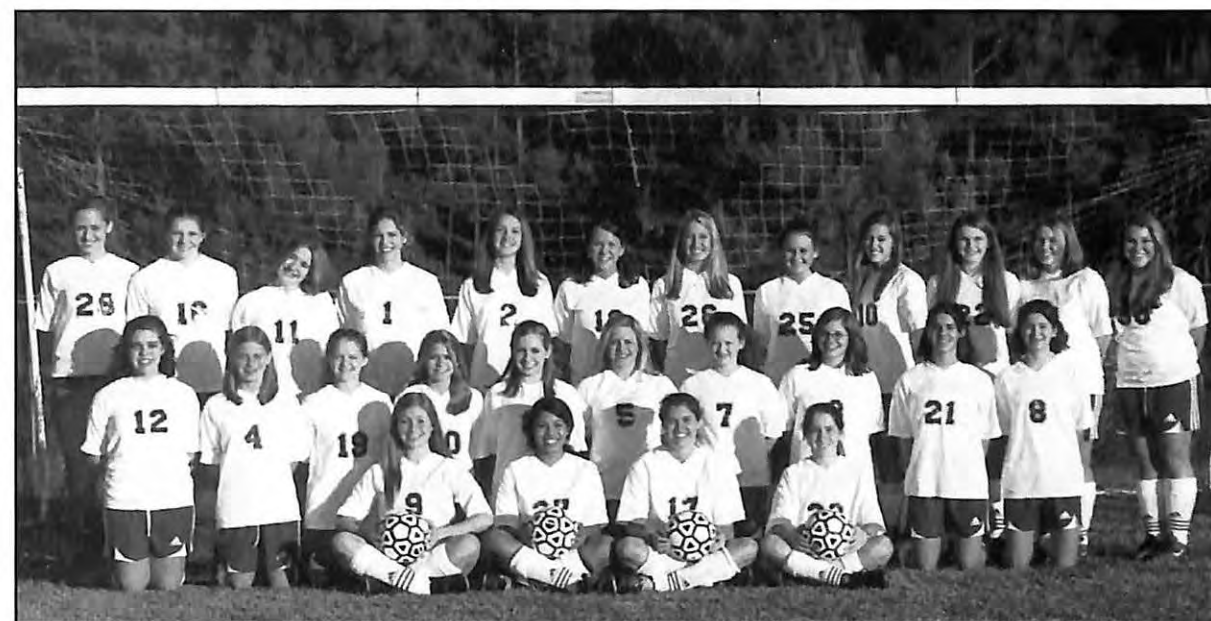

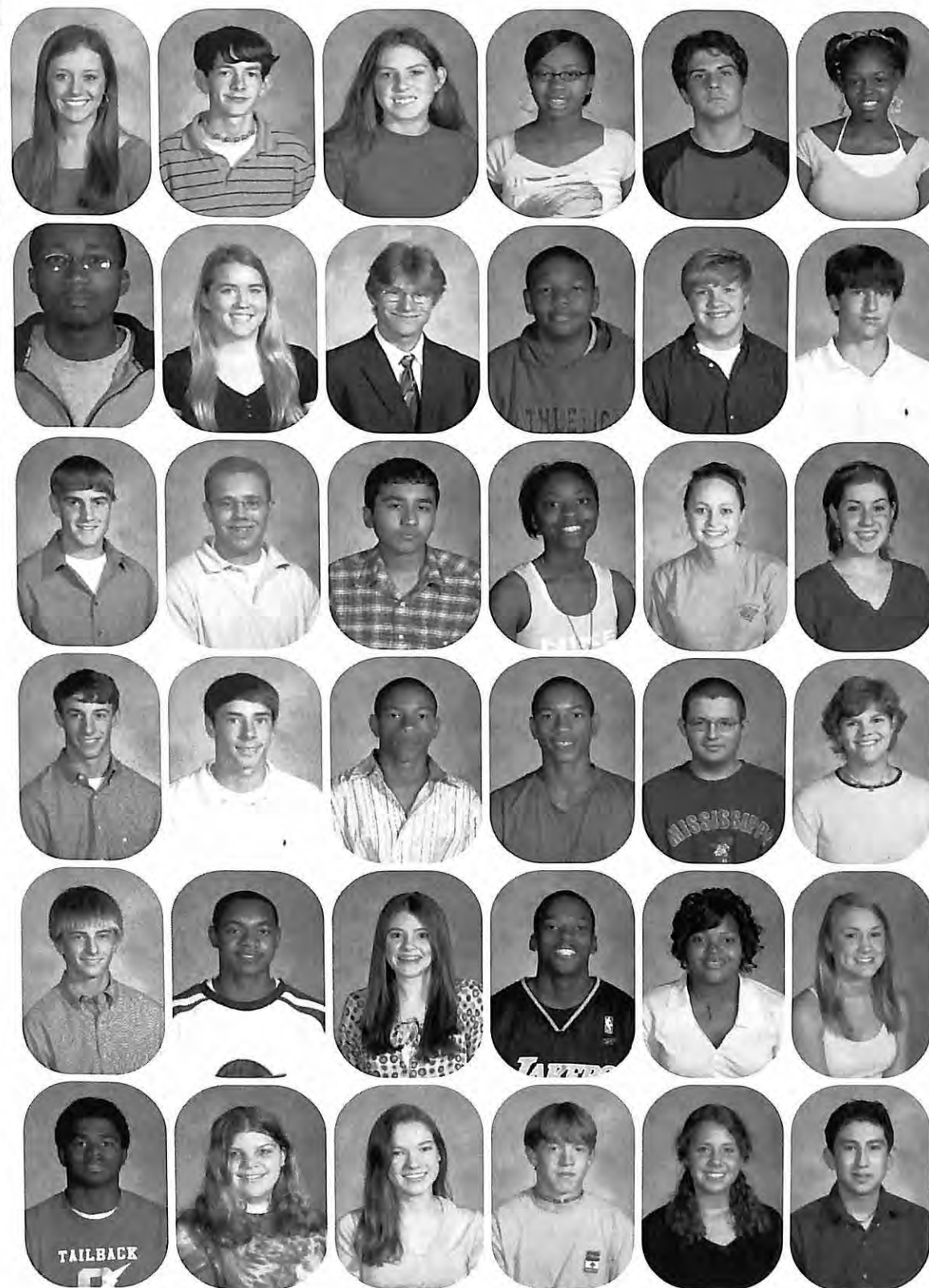
Press Pass: Blake Belcher
