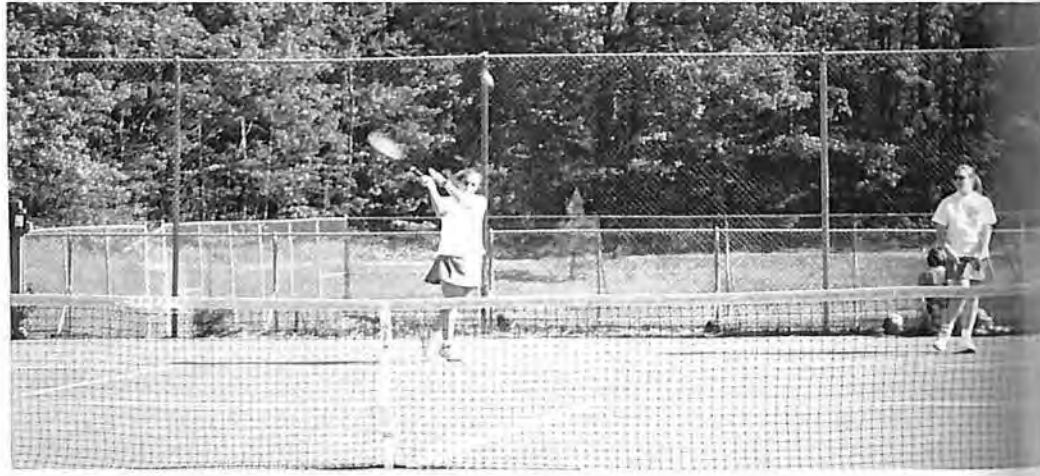
Tennis

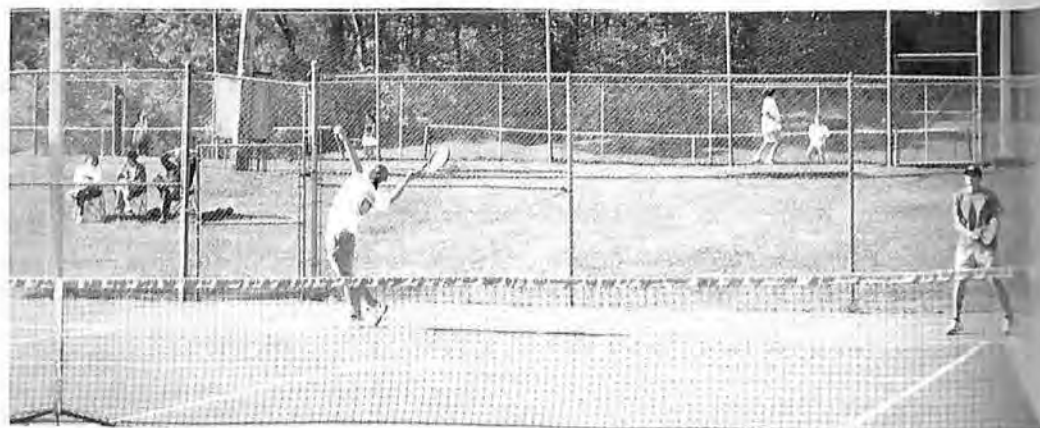

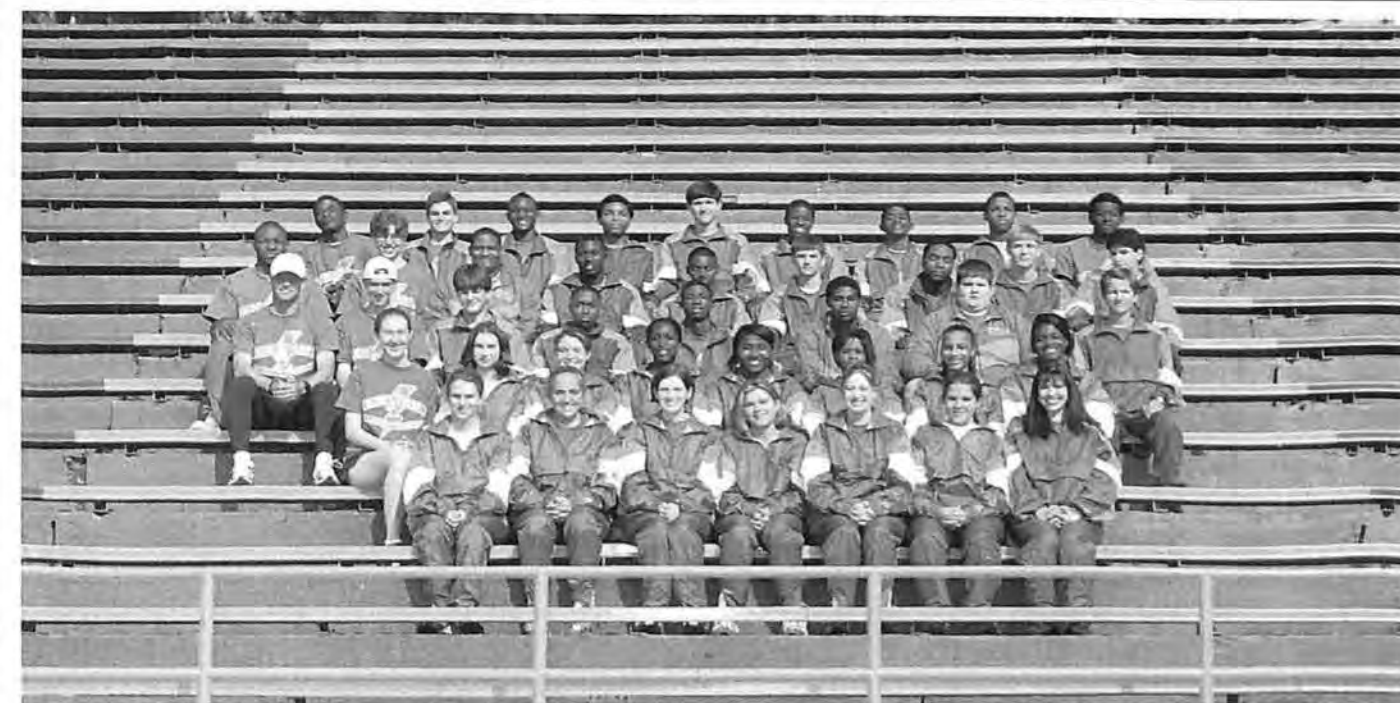


State Champs!
