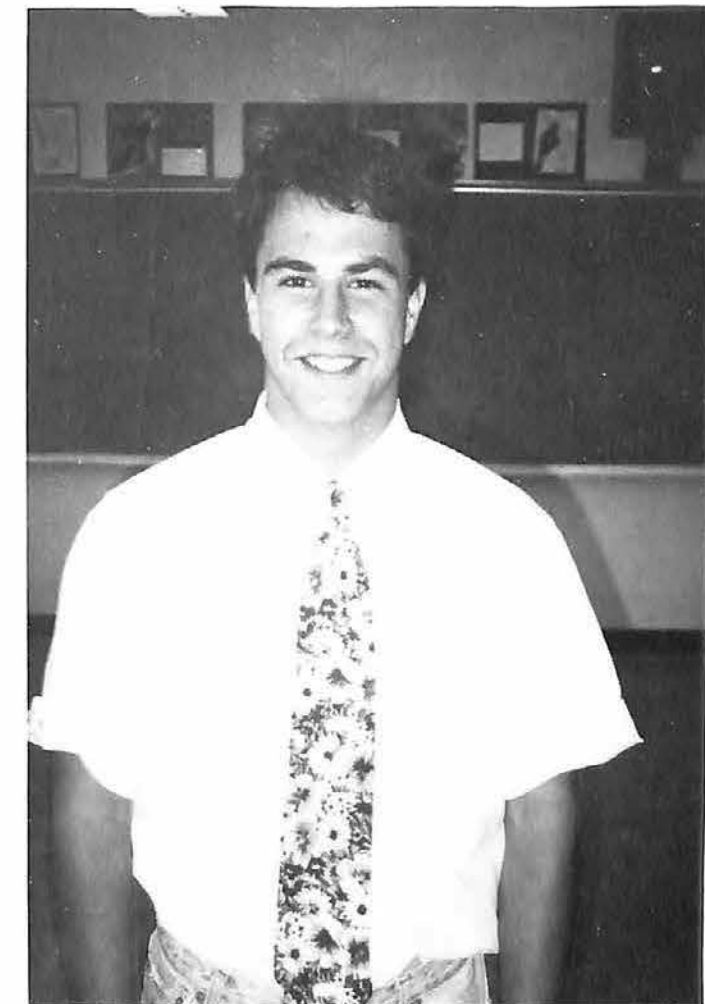


## Star Student and Star Teacher
