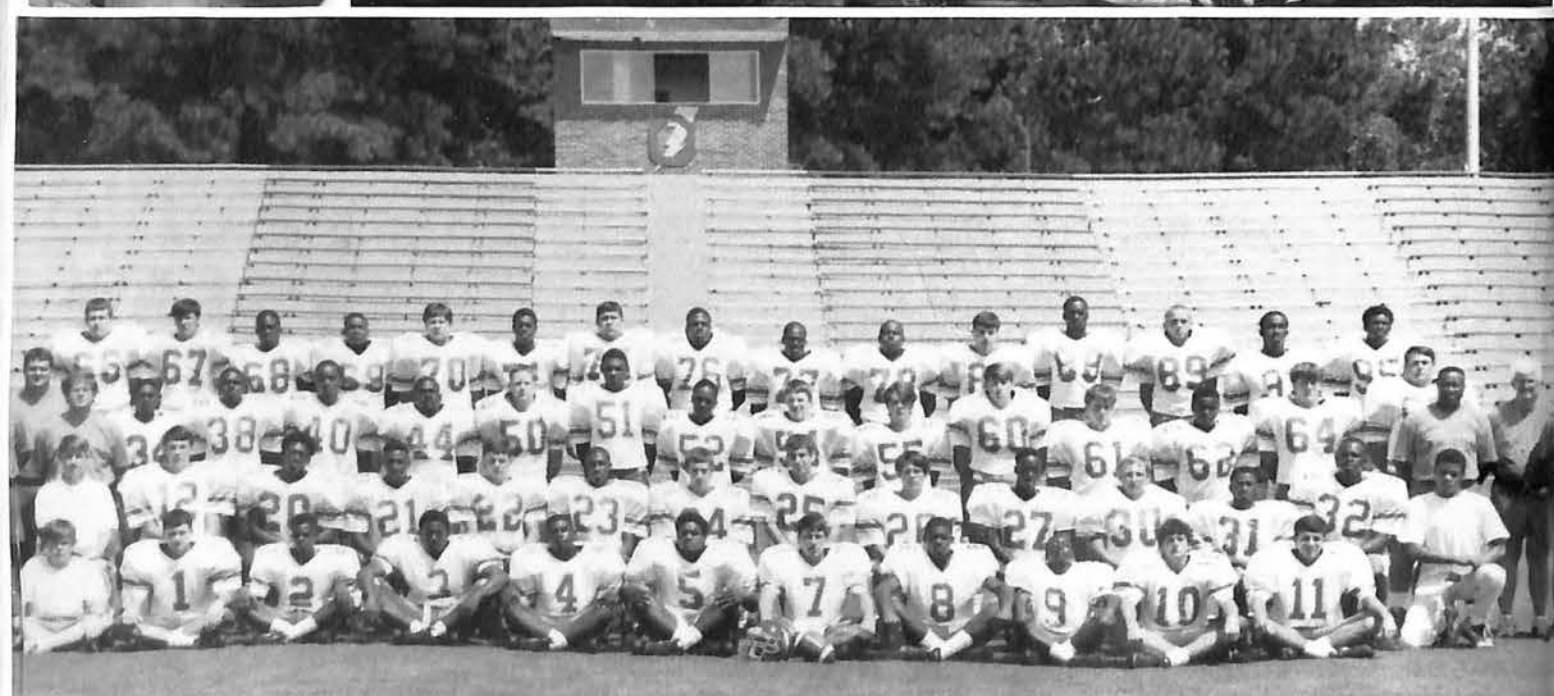
# Football

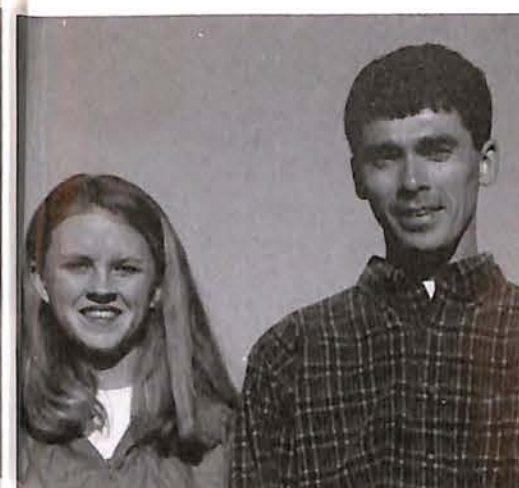
## Girl's Cross Country

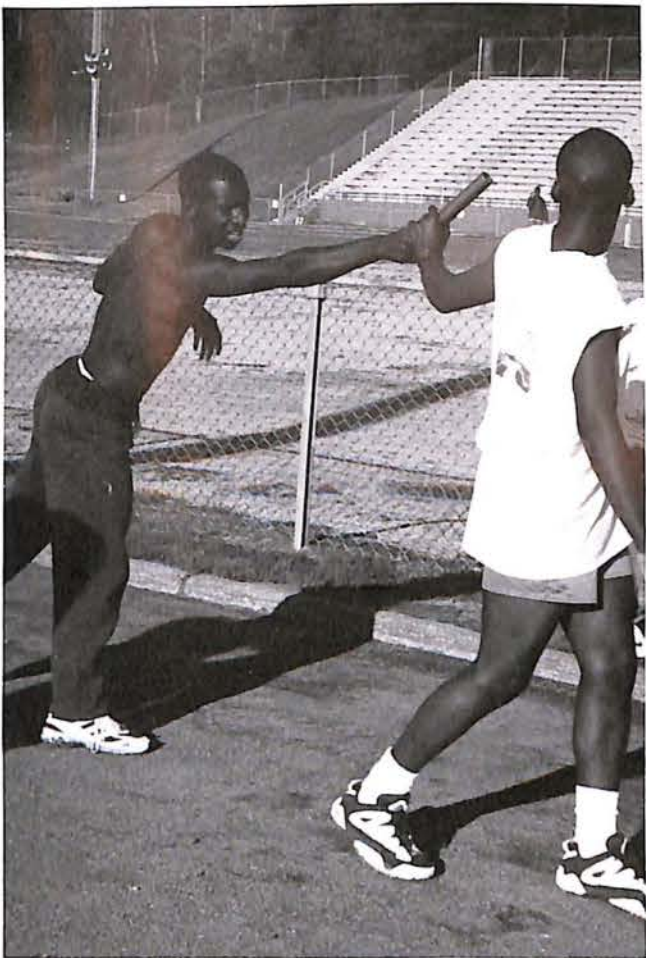




# Track and Field

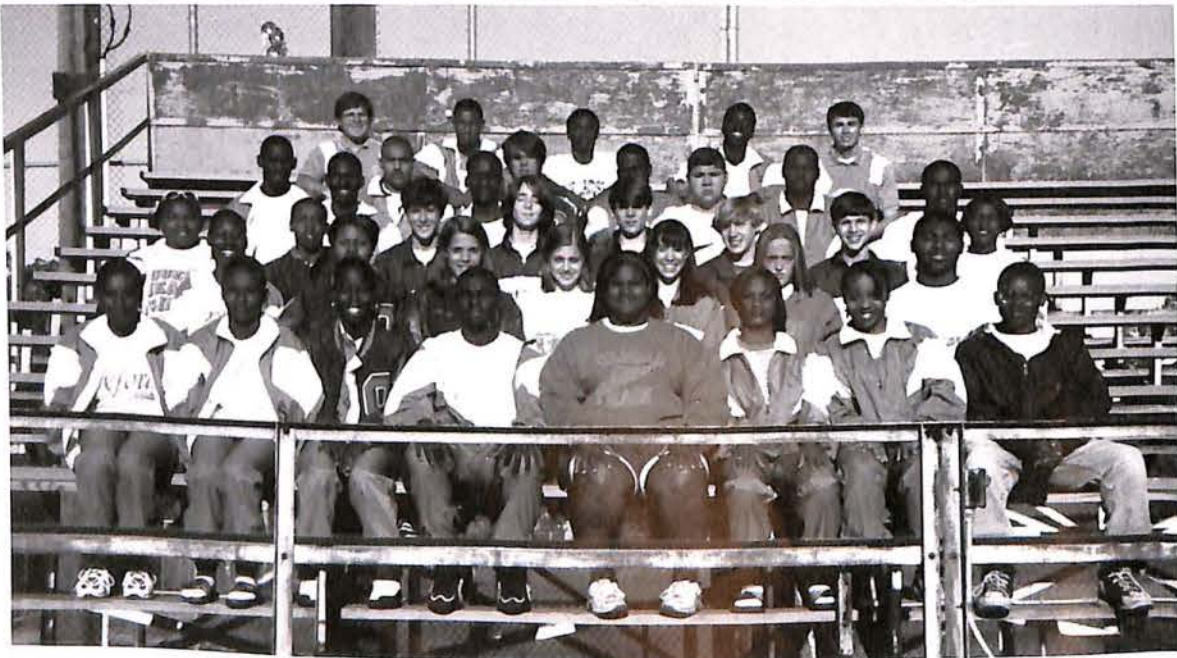

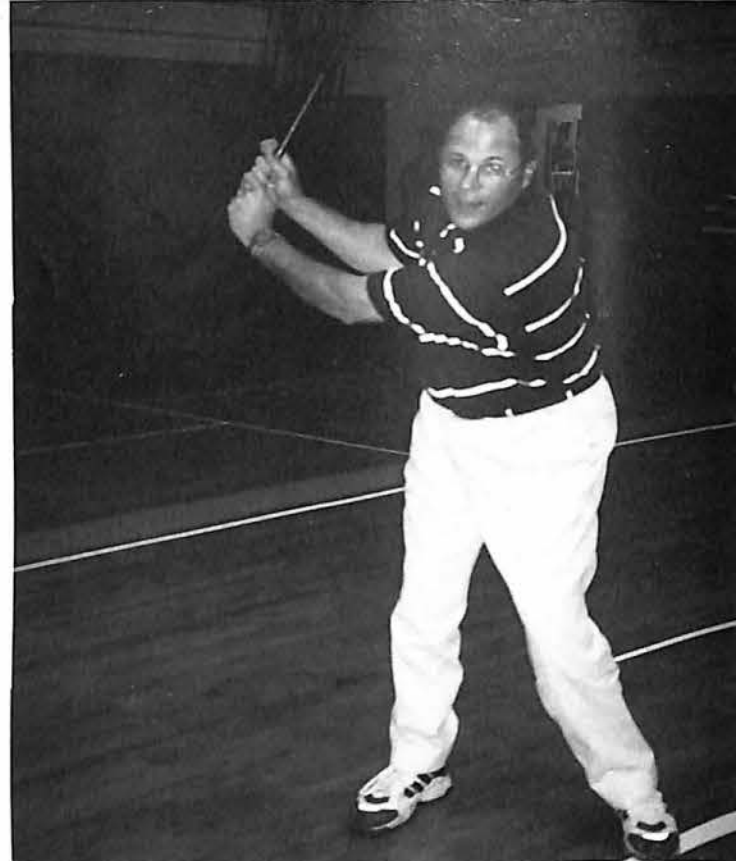


# Golf
