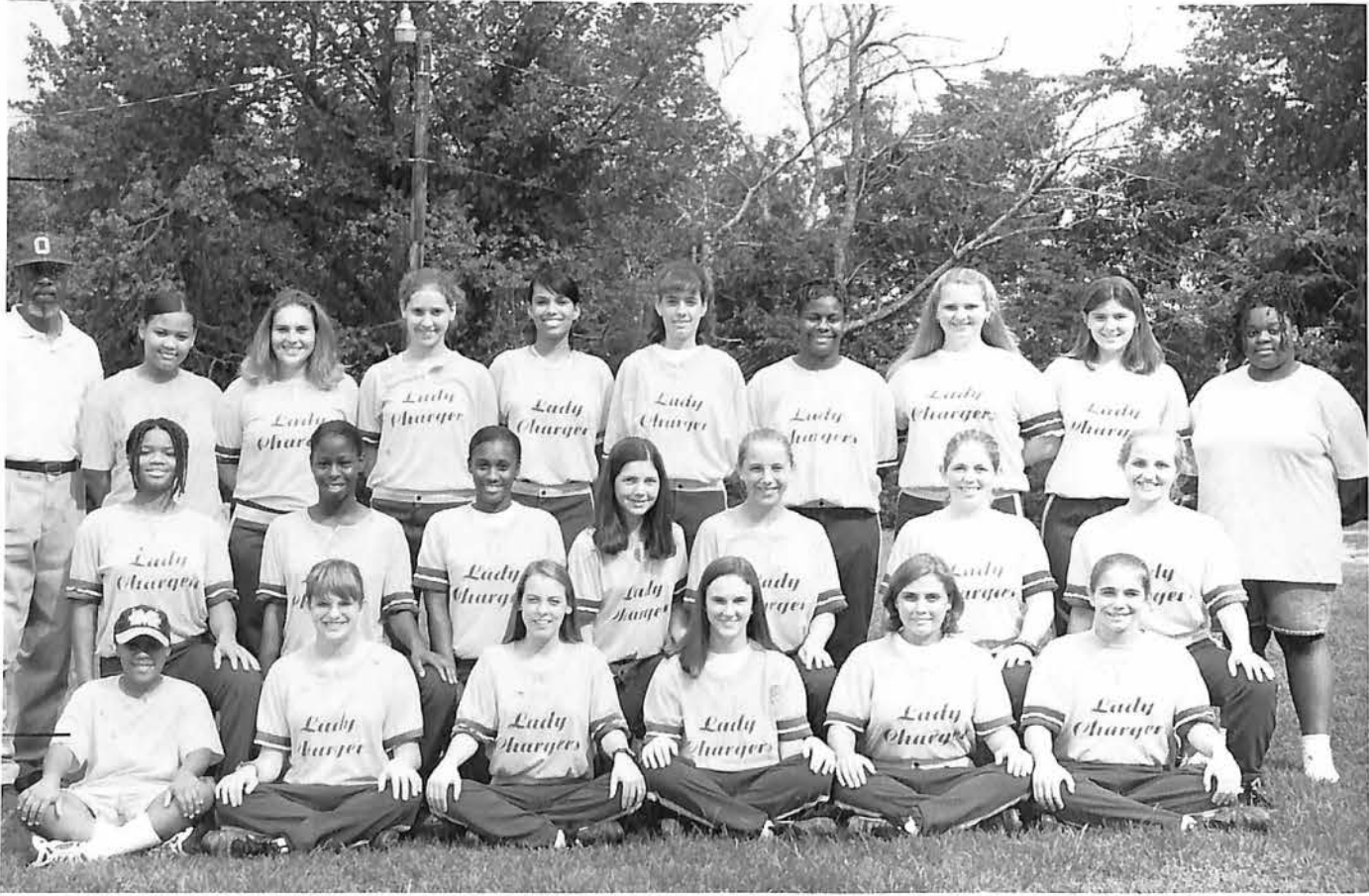
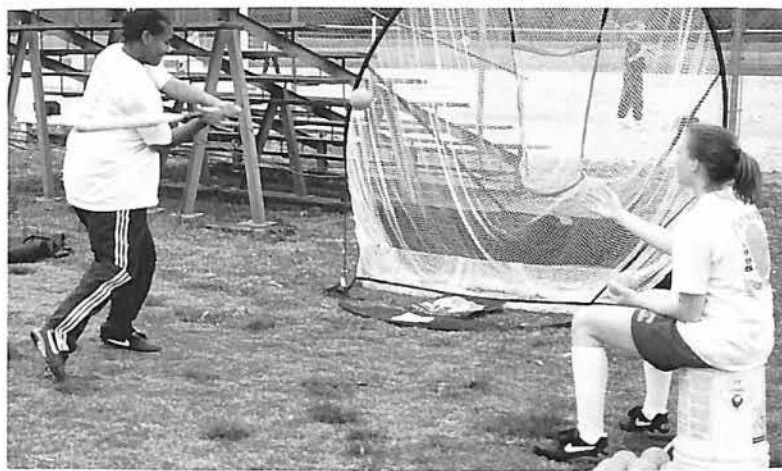
SOFTBALL

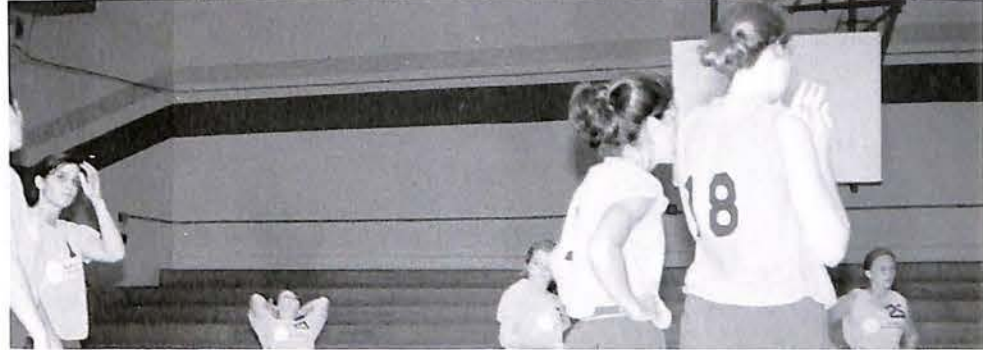

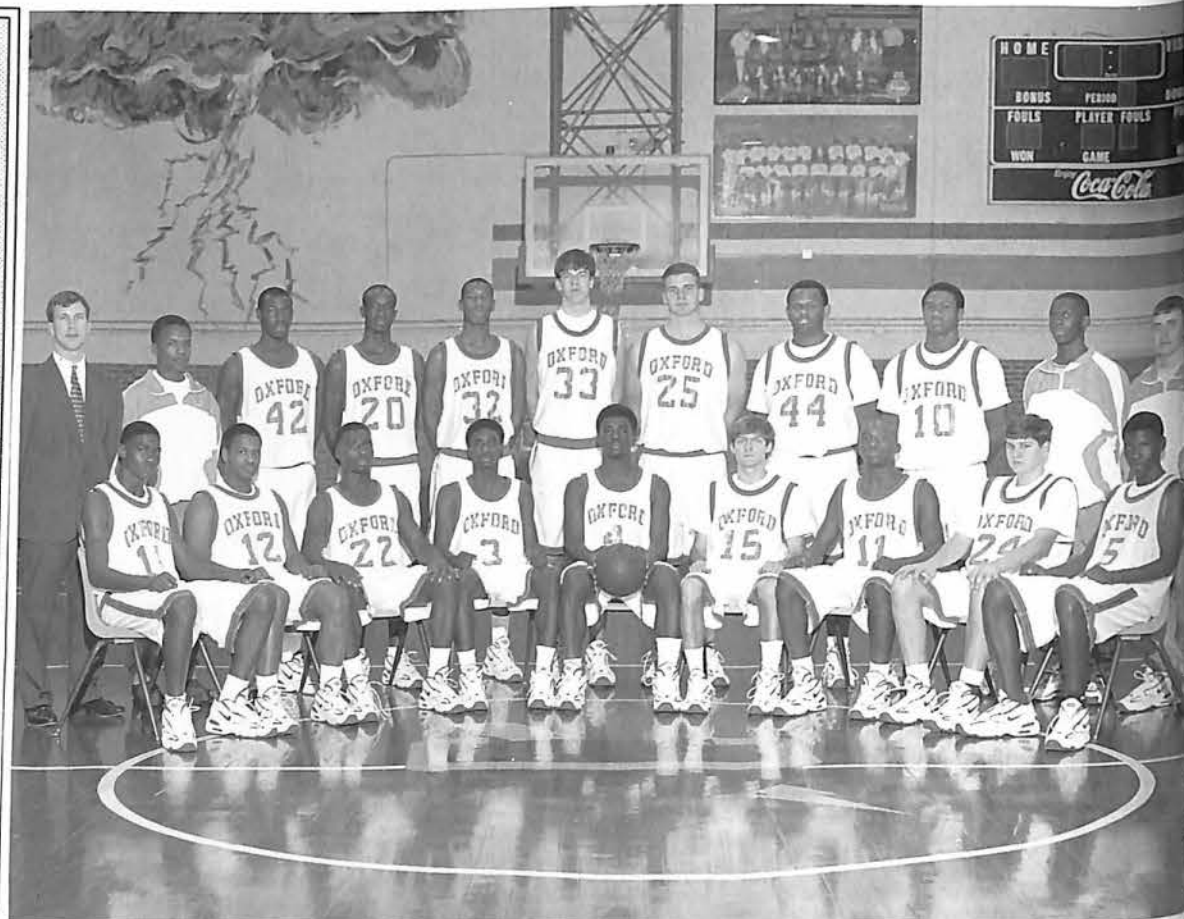

The Chargers were upset in the semifinals of the district tournament by Olive Branch 54-62.

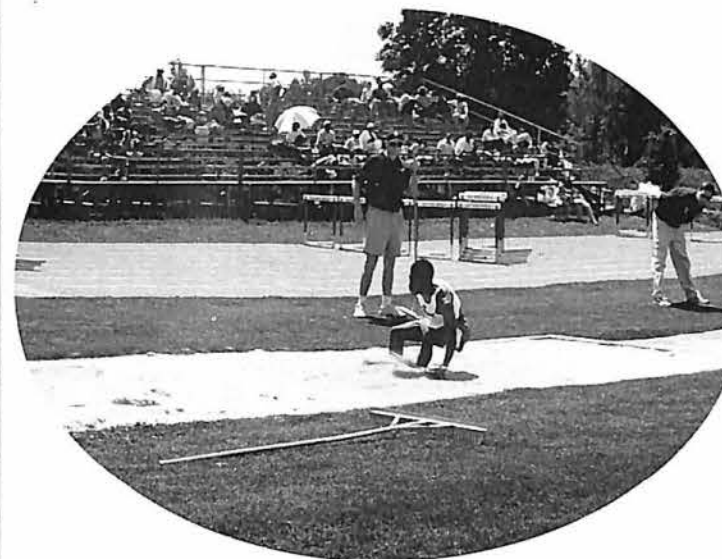


The Oxford High Lady Charger Basketball team had a very successful season this year. The Lady Chargers started the first half of the year with an undefeated record in the state of Mississippi. The girls also participated in a nationally ranked tournament in Longview, Texas, in December. Oxford won one game and lost two; one to the number one ranked Skyline team of Dallas, Texas, and the other game to the number two ranked Longview team out of Longview, Texas. After Christmas the Lady Chargers came back to win several games in a row. The only other game they lost the whole season was to Starkville. The Lady Chargers finished the season with a 36-3 record. (35-1 in Mississippi) During their 97-98 season, the girls also managed to win a tournament hosted by North Pontotoc. They later battled through several tough teams to become the District Champions. Four players from Oxford made the All-District Team. These players included Allison Shaw, Marni Fitts, Jamilla Quarles, and Meg Banahan. Next the Lady Chargers defeated Neshoba Central and Noxubee County for the North Half Championship. In the state tournament, Oxford beat Neshoba Central once again and also Bay St. Louis to win the state title. This was a rare feat for the girls because it was their championship title in a row. Three Lady Chargers also made the All-State Tournament Team. These included Shaw, Fitts, and Banahan. To top the season off, Lady Charger Head Coach Jeff Nelson was awarded with the title of "Coach of the year."

we cried boo-hoo

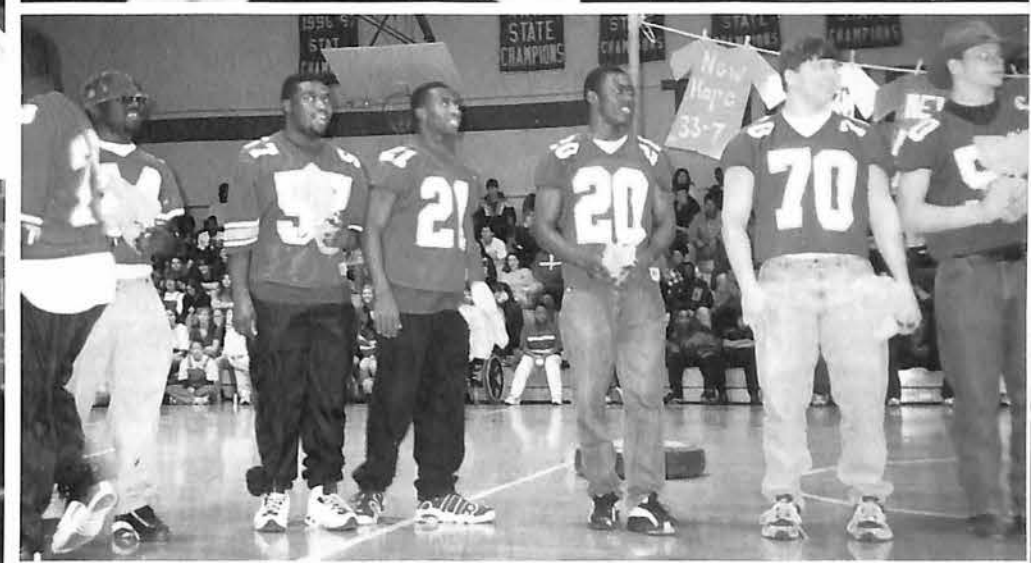
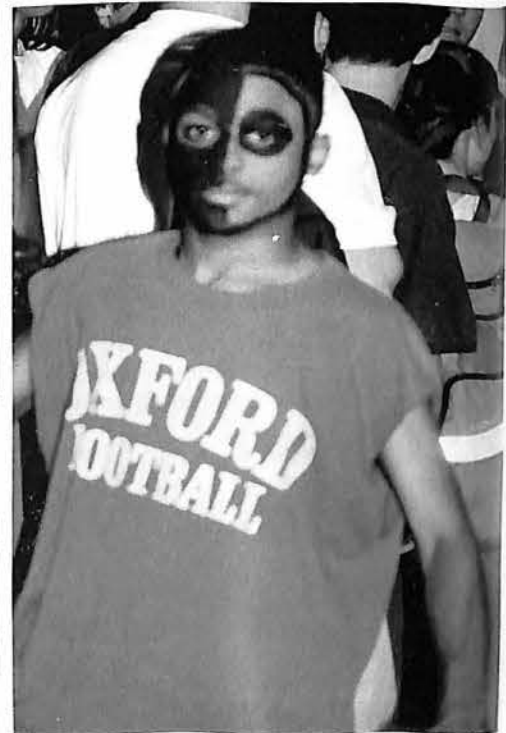
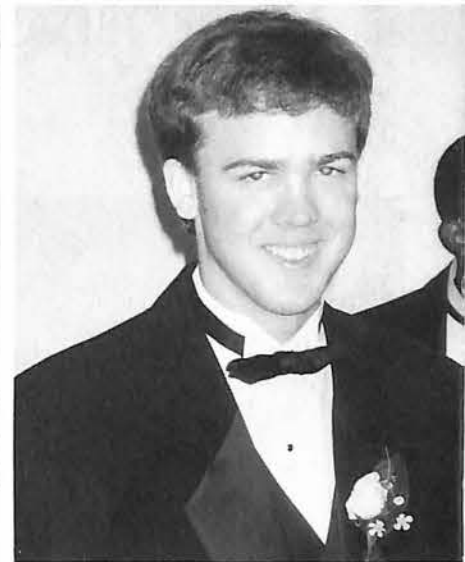
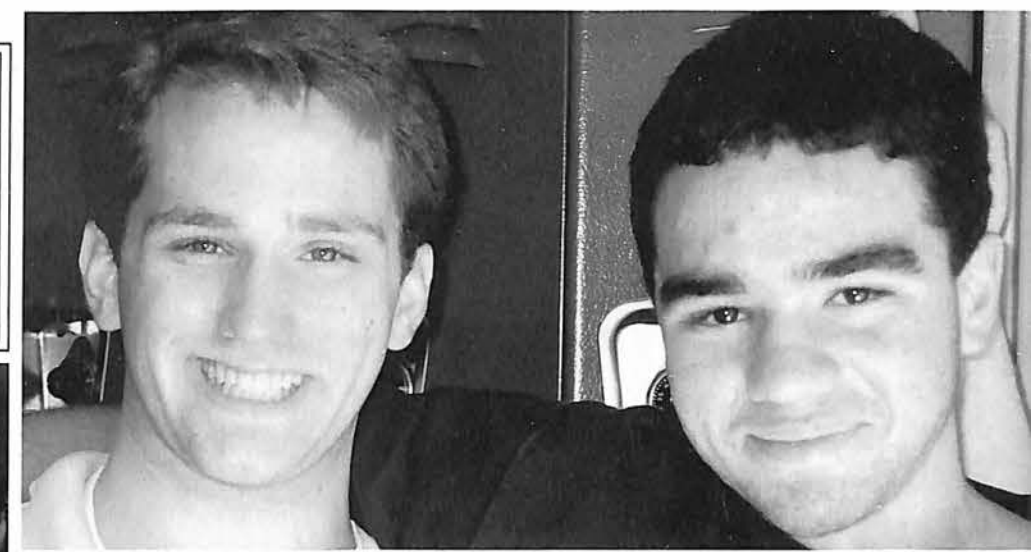


Then came grades first,

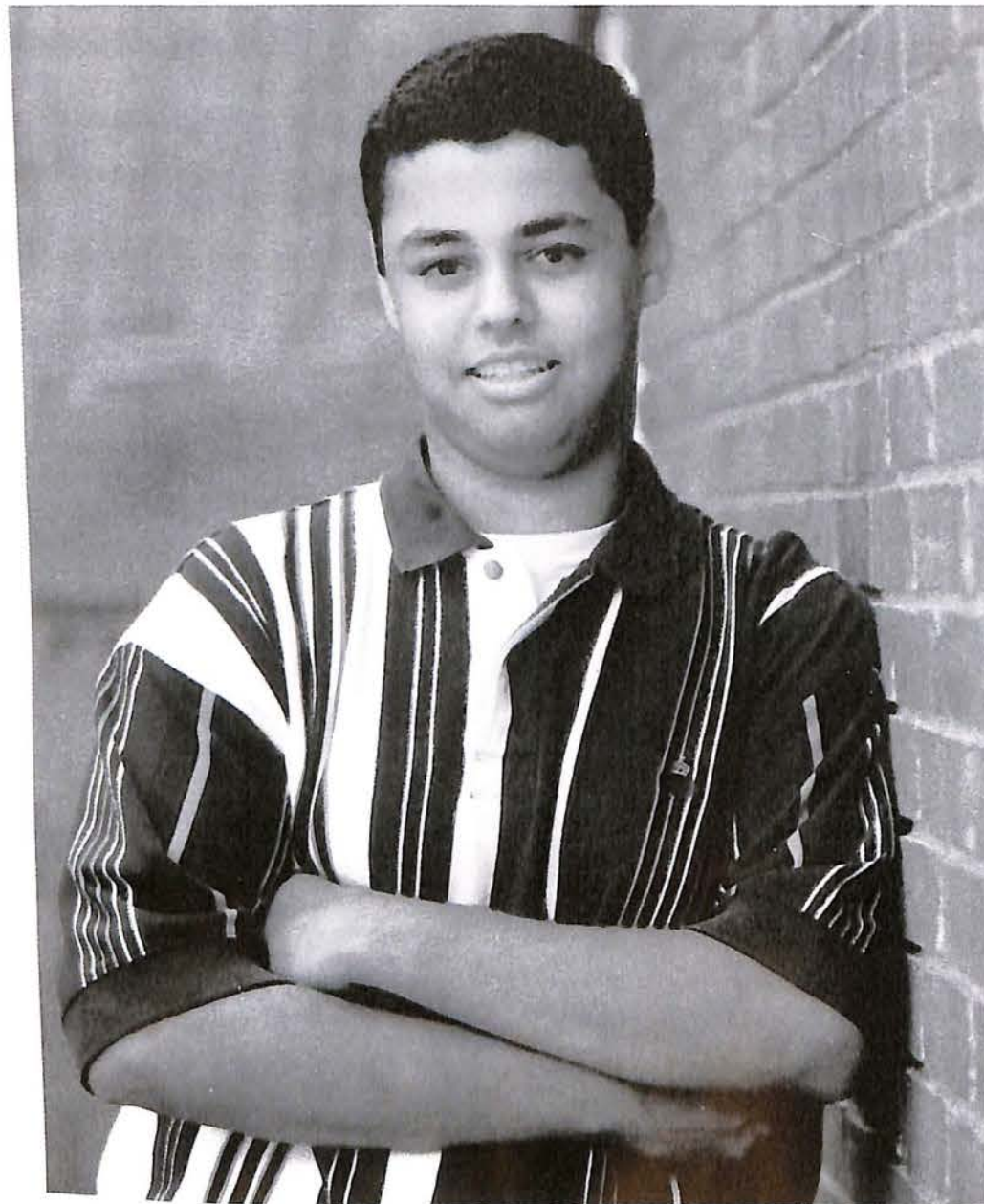
