The Lady Charger Softball team ended their season with 7-6. They finished as runner-up in the district, and they made it to the play-offs, returning home with an overall record of 7-8.



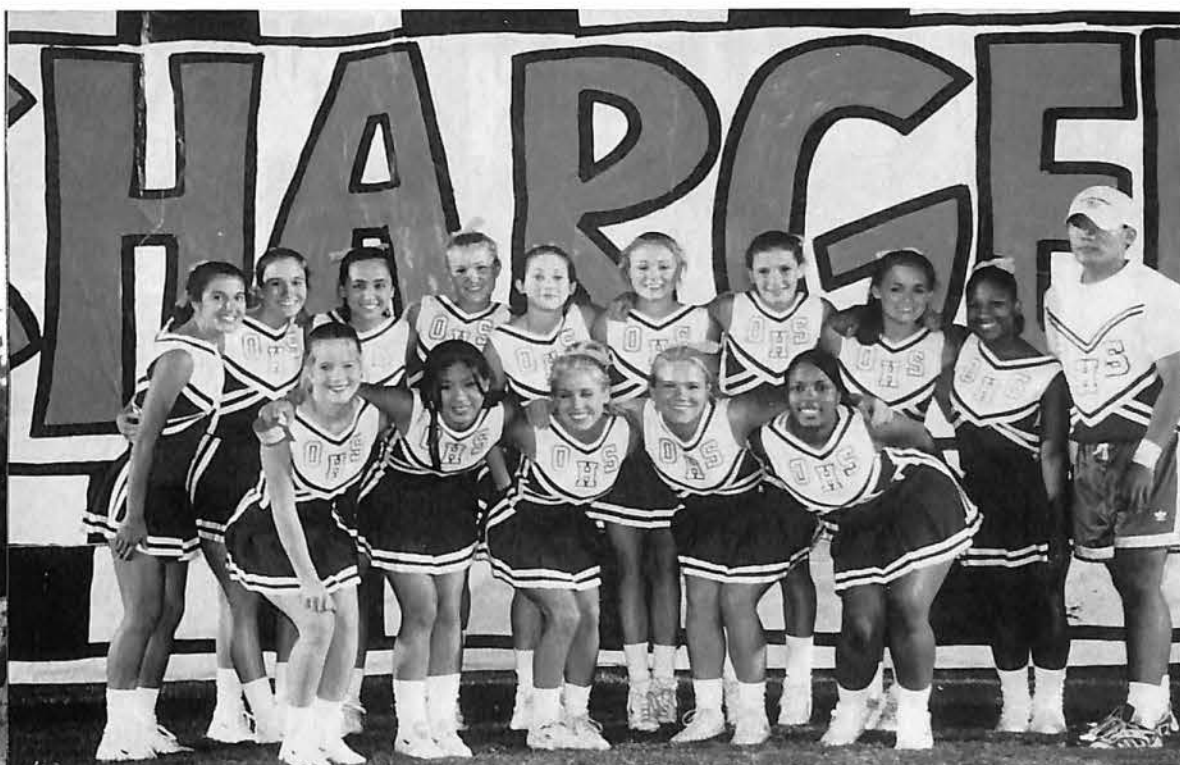
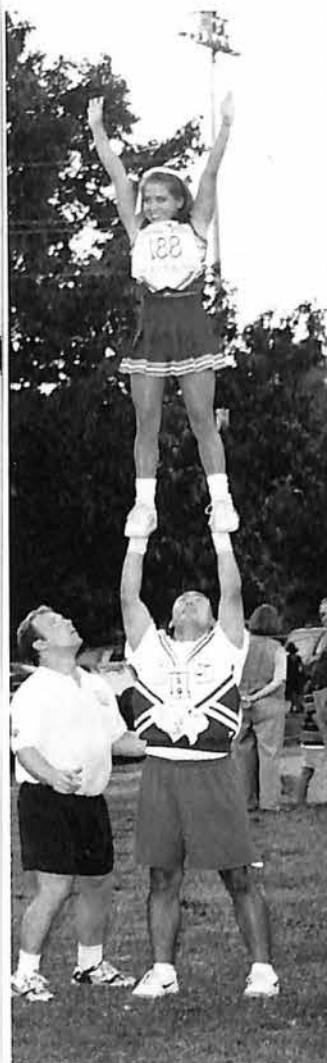
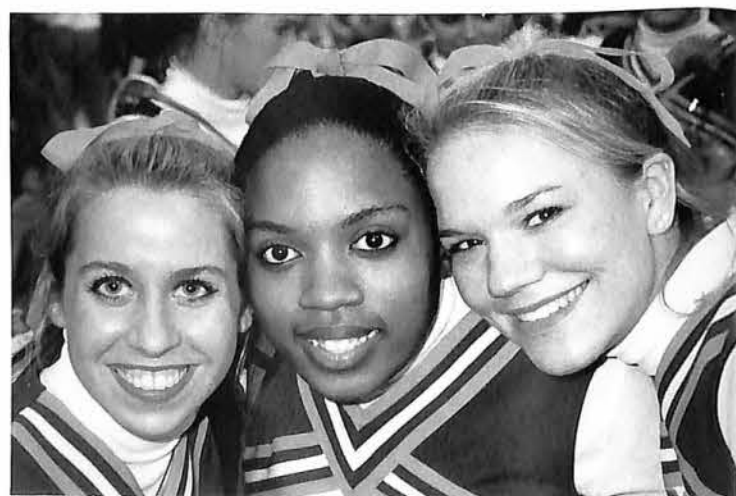
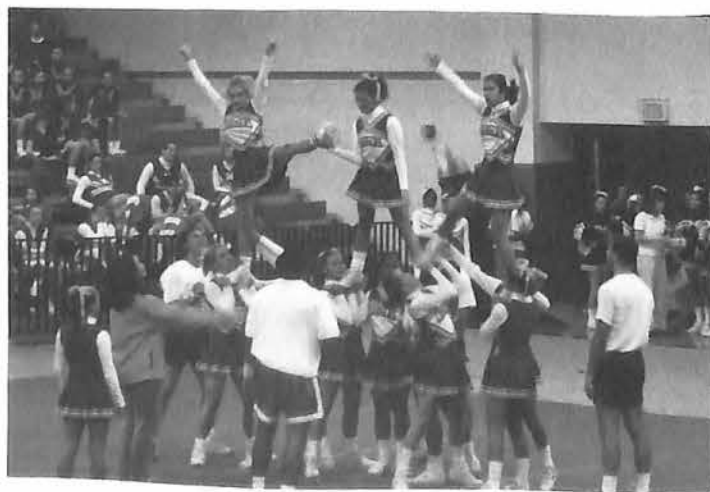
